

In honor of <u>Constitution Day</u>, I thought I'd share a free printable of **Ben Franklin's request for prayer at the Constitutional Convention back in 1787**. Addressing the President, he wisely observed:

I have lived, Sir, a long time, and the longer I live, the more convincing proofs I see of this truth — that God Governs in the affairs of men. And if a sparrow cannot fall to the ground without his notice, is it probable that an empire can rise without his aid? We have been assured, Sir, in the sacred writings, that "except the Lord build the House they labour in vain that build it." I firmly believe this; and I also believe that without his concurring aid we shall succeed in this political building no better, than the Builders of Babel: We shall be divided by our little partial local interests; our projects will be confounded, and we ourselves shall become a reproach and bye word down to future ages. And what is worse, mankind may hereafter from this unfortunate instance, despair of establishing Governments by Human wisdom and leave it to chance, war and conquest.

I therefore beg leave to move — that henceforth prayers imploring the assistance of Heaven, and its blessings on our deliberations, be held in this Assembly every morning before we proceed to business, and that one or more of the Clergy of this City be requested to officiate in that Service. 2 Kings 4:1-7 -- The Provision of Oil and the Widows' Sons Elisha asked for a double portion and then performed what many count (14/28) as exactly twice as many miracles, what does this mean?

The Miracles performed say something too? But what?

How does this text answer some other deep-seated questions?


What was the miracle in this passage <u>2 Kings 4:1</u>-7 How is it similar/different to a miracle by Elijah? <u>1Kings 17:9</u>-16, <u>Luke 4:26</u>

God has miraculously answered prayers but in almost always different ways, is there a lesson to this?

Does oil represent anything in the Bible?

Was there something specific about this family that invited the blessing? Is there a symbolic point to the 'empty vessels'?

Has God ever done a miracle(s) for you? How did it impact you? Others? Do you see any connection to Jesus and His miracles here?



Miracle men!

- Elijah and Elisha were similar but different! 14/28
 - Miracles that instantly killed opponents!
 - Miracles that gave grace and help to desperate individuals
 - Both raised the Dead, Confronted Kings/Queens and ...
- Elijah's were *more* corporate, public and National, and Elisha's were *more* personal, private and local

Miracle men! Where do we all go when were desperate? When we need divine help?! Men of God

We can't cover ALL their miracles, Elijah had 14, Elisha 28!

<u>Miracles are always about the message</u>! The Prophets were authenticated by God, through miracles!

While Elisha was used of God to accomplish twice the miracles, it doesn't mean he was twice as good or important! Elijah is the one who has a seat waiting for him at passover Elijah is anticipated in the Lords return! Elijah Was with Christ on Mt. of Transfiguration Mt.17, representing the Prophets!

Perhaps it simply shows that Elijah was meant to do a LOT more, until he resigned Yet, Elishah raised a dead boy AND a Dead man! When he was dead!

[Heb 2:4 ESV] 4 while God also bore witness by signs and wonders and

various miracles and by gifts of the Holy Spirit distributed according to his will.

[Mar 16:17-18 ESV] 17 And these signs will accompany those who believe: in my name they will cast out demons; they will speak in new tongues; 18 they will pick up serpents with their hands; and if they drink any deadly poison, it will not hurt them; they will lay their hands on the sick, and they will recover."

[Jhn 14:12 ESV] 12 "Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever believes in me will also do the works that I do; and greater works than these will he do, because I am going to the Father.



- Both parted the Jordan!
- Both pronounced drought/Famines! Ja.5! Effectual prayer of righteous men!
- Both cared for Widows!! 1Ki.17 Widow and son, Flour and Oil, 2Ki.4 Widow and 2 sons, Oil in borrowed jars!
- Both raised dead sons of the widows, Jesus raised widows son from Nain! <u>1Ki.17, 2Ki.4, Lk.7:11-17. 3 Res. From Elij and Elish, 3 by Jesus, 3 in NT,</u> <u>plus Jesus res. Total of 10</u>
- Both called down Gods wrath: Prophets of Baal and disrespectful youths
- Both cursed royalty to death! Jezebel and King
- · Both have mystery's around their 'death'?

<u>Lk.7 Jesus heals dead son of the widow and Lazarus a grown man who feared</u> <u>the Lord with sisters in need</u> [Luk 4:16, 21, 24-26 NLT] 16 When he came to the village of Nazareth, his boyhood home, he went as usual to the synagogue on the Sabbath and stood up to read the Scriptures. ... 21 Then he began to speak to them. "The Scripture you've just heard has been fulfilled this very day!" ... 24 But I tell you the truth, no prophet is accepted in his own hometown. 25 "Certainly there were many needy widows in Israel in Elijah's time, when the heavens were closed for three and a half years, and a severe famine devastated the land. 26 Yet Elijah was not sent to any of them. He was sent instead to a foreigner--a widow of Zarephath in the land of Sidon.

[Exo 4:5, 8-9 ESV] 5 "that they may believe that the LORD, the God of their fathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, has appeared to you." ... 8 "If they will not believe you," God said, "or listen to the first sign, they may believe the latter sign. 9 If they will not believe even these two signs or listen to your voice, you shall take some water from the Nile and pour it on the dry ground, and the water that you shall take from the Nile will become blood on the dry ground."

[Mat 11:4-5 ESV] 4 And Jesus answered them, "Go and tell John what you hear and see: 5 the blind receive their sight and the lame walk, lepers are cleansed and the deaf hear, and the dead are raised up, and the poor have good news preached to them.

[Mar 1:27 ESV] 27 And they were all amazed, so that they questioned among themselves, saying, "What is this? A new teaching with authority! He commands even the unclean spirits, and they obey him."

[Mat 13:54, 58 NLT] 54 He returned to Nazareth, his hometown. When he taught there in the synagogue, everyone was amazed and said, "Where does he get this wisdom and the power to do miracles?" ... 58 And so he did only a few miracles there because of their unbelief.

[Mat 14:2 NLT] 2 he said to his advisers, "This must be John the Baptist raised from the dead! That is why he can do such miracles."

[Mar 3:8 NLT] 8 Jerusalem, Idumea, from east of the Jordan River, and even from as far north as Tyre and Sidon. The news about his miracles had spread far and wide, and vast numbers of people came to see him.

[Mar 6:2 NLT] 2 The next Sabbath he began teaching in the synagogue, and many who heard him were amazed. They asked, "Where did he get all this wisdom and the power to perform such miracles?"

[Luk 10:13 NLT] 13 "What sorrow awaits you, Korazin and Bethsaida! For if the miracles I did in you had been done in wicked Tyre and Sidon, their people would have repented of their sins long ago, clothing themselves in burlap and throwing ashes on their heads to show their remorse.

[Luk 19:37 NLT] 37 When he reached the place where the road started down the Mount of Olives, all of his followers began to shout and sing as they walked along, praising God for all the wonderful miracles they had seen.

[Luk 24:19 NLT] 19 "What things?" Jesus asked. "The things that happened to

Jesus, the man from Nazareth," they said. "He was a prophet who did powerful miracles, and he was a mighty teacher in the eyes of God and all the people. [Jhn 5:36 NLT] 36 But I have a greater witness than John--my teachings and my miracles. The Father gave me these works to accomplish, and they prove that he sent me.

[Jhn 7:3 NLT] 3 and Jesus' brothers said to him, "Leave here and go to Judea, where your followers can see your miracles!

[Act 2:22 NLT] 22 "People of Israel, listen! God publicly endorsed Jesus the Nazarene by doing powerful miracles, wonders, and signs through him, as you well know.

Some common agonizing questions here

- 1. The wife of one of the sons of the prophets cried
- My husband is dead, and you know that your servant feared the LORD
- 3. The creditor has come to take my two children
- 4. "What shall I do for you?"
- 1. Does God hear our cries? God healed the dead child, why Not my husband? We ALL suffer the curse of the Fall! Its inescapable!
- 2. Your servant feared the Lord! Serving God doesn't prevent trials and tribulations
- 3. the creditor has come _ Gods people are often Poor! In Debt! HWP gospel is a lie
- 4. "What shall I do for you?" Elisha is gracious. She was asking! God cares about our cries! Jesus wept.
- 5. What do you have? Israelites wore same clothes for 40 years! God gave Adam skins of a lamb, Jesus had his clothes gambled over as he hung naked! We will get robes of white!
- 6. Borrow vessels? Ever feel humbled to beg? God designed us to ened each other! Did this open doors to share the story of the miracle?
- 7. Go, sell, pay debts, live on rest. She still had to do her part and work.

[Psa 39:12 ESV] 12 "Hear my prayer, O LORD, and give ear to my cry; hold not your peace at my tears! For I am a sojourner with you, a guest, like all my fathers. [Psa 56:8 ESV] 8 You have kept count of my tossings; put my tears in your bottle. Are they not in your book?

[Psa 116:8 ESV] 8 For you have delivered my soul from death, my eyes from tears,

my feet from stumbling;

- 7. "Go, sell the oil and pay your debts, and you and your son can live on the rest."



Hey by the way!

IF God could/would fill the Oil Jar, Could He not also fill the widows empty heart as she missed her husband??!

Miracles

- Water God often works in different ways
 - Noah's Ark, above water
 - Moses walked through parted water, Stand Still and see!
 - · Joshua walked through parted water as they stepped
 - Jonah's Great Fish, Below Water
 - Jesus walked on the water and then calmed the sea!

God fed Elijah with Ravens Fed prophets with Obadiah who hid them in caves Fed widow with endless jars of flour and Oil Fed the widow with Elisha with Oil, borrowed jars and seeling it

[1Ki 17:9-16 ESV] 9 "Arise, go to Zarephath, which belongs to Sidon, and dwell there. Behold, I have commanded a widow there to feed you." 10 So he arose and went to Zarephath. And when he came to the gate of the city, behold, a widow was there gathering sticks. And he called to her and said, "Bring me a little water in a vessel, that I may drink." 11 And as she was going to bring it, he called to her and said, "Bring me a morsel of bread in your hand." 12 And she said, "As the LORD your God lives, I have nothing baked, only a handful of flour in a jar and a little oil in a jug. And now I am gathering a couple of sticks that I may go in and prepare it for myself and my son, that we may eat it and die." 13 And Elijah said to her, "Do not fear; go and do as you have said. But first make me a little cake of it and bring it to me, and afterward make something for yourself and your son. 14 For thus says the LORD, the God of Israel, 'The jar of flour shall not be spent, and the jug of oil shall not be empty, until the day that the LORD sends rain upon the earth.'" 15 And she went and did as Elijah said. And she and he and her household ate for many days. 16 The jar of flour was not spent, neither did the jug of oil become empty, according

to the word of the LORD that he spoke by Elijah.

The Widow wasn't a Jew, She didn't seek the prophet or ASK for help, though desperate. She had a little flour and the Lord just filled the empty vessels daily

Elisha. 2Ki.4

The Widow was a Jew, sought the Prophet, Asked for help and borrowed vessels, and filled them once and had money extra for the rest of their lives

[Exo 14:13 ESV] 13 And Moses said to the people, "Fear not, stand firm, and see the salvation of the LORD, which he will work for you today. For the Egyptians whom you see today, you shall never see again.

Miracles

- Elijah ate the cake 1 Kings 17:9-16
- Elisha told the widow to borrow vessels, fill once/sell

Jesus also provided for needs, in his 1st miracle!

Instead of filling empty jars by pouring them out, He changed the very nature of the contents!

With Elijah and Elisha God made MCUH of Little! Jesus changed the very Nature of what was! Net Testament!

Empty 'Vessels'

- Romans 9-21 Has the potter no right over the clay, to make out of the same lump one <u>vessel for</u> <u>honorable use</u> and another for dishonorable use?
- 2 Timothy 2:21 Therefore, <u>if anyone cleanses</u> <u>himself from what is dishonorable, he will be a</u> <u>vessel for honorable use, set apart as holy, useful</u> <u>to the master of the house, ready for every good</u> <u>work</u>.

[1Pe 3:7 ESV] 7 Likewise, husbands, live with your wives in an understanding way, showing honor to the woman as the weaker vessel, since they are heirs with you of the grace of life, so that your prayers may not be hindered.

[2Ki 4:2-5 ESV] 2 And Elisha said to her, "What shall I do for you? Tell me; what have you in the house?" And she said, "Your servant has nothing in the house except a jar of oil." 3 Then he said, "Go outside, borrow vessels from all your neighbors, empty vessels and not too few. 4 Then go in and shut the door behind yourself and your sons and pour into all these vessels. And when one is full, set it aside." 5 So she went from him and shut the door behind herself and her sons. And as she poured they brought the vessels to her.

[Lev 6:28 ESV] 28 And the earthenware vessel in which it is boiled shall be broken. But if it is boiled in a bronze vessel, that shall be scoured and rinsed in water. [Jos 6:19 ESV] 19 But all silver and gold, and every vessel of bronze and iron, are holy to the LORD; they shall go into the treasury of the LORD."

[1Ki 17:10 ESV] 10 So he arose and went to Zarephath. And when he came to the gate of the city, behold, a widow was there gathering sticks. And he called to her and said, "Bring me a little water in a vessel, that I may drink."

[2Ki 4:6 ESV] 6 When the vessels were full, she said to her son, "Bring me another

vessel." And he said to her, "There is not another." Then the oil stopped flowing. [Psa 2:9 ESV] 9 You shall break them with a rod of iron and dash them in pieces like a potter's vessel."

[Psa 31:12 ESV] 12 I have been forgotten like one who is dead; I have become like a broken vessel.

[Pro 26:23 ESV] 23 Like the glaze covering an earthen vessel are fervent lips with an evil heart.


[Isa 30:14 ESV] 14 and its breaking is like that of a potter's vessel that is smashed so ruthlessly that among its fragments not a shard is found with which to take fire from the hearth, or to dip up water out of the cistern."

[Jer 18:4 ESV] 4 And the vessel he was making of clay was spoiled in the potter's hand, and he reworked it into another vessel, as it seemed good to the potter to do. [Jer 19:11 ESV] 11 and shall say to them, 'Thus says the LORD of hosts: So will I break this people and this city, as one breaks a potter's vessel, so that it can never be mended. Men shall bury in Topheth because there will be no place else to bury. [Jer 32:14 ESV] 14 'Thus says the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel: Take these deeds, both this sealed deed of purchase and this open deed, and put them in an earthenware vessel, that they may last for a long time.

[Jer 51:34 ESV] 34 "Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon has devoured me; he has crushed me; he has made me an empty vessel; he has swallowed me like a monster; he has filled his stomach with my delicacies; he has rinsed me out.

Oil made Aaron holy – The Holy Spirit

- Anoint my head with Oil Psalm 23:5
- Symbolic of Unity, Aaron's beard Psalm 133:2
- Symbolic of sweet counsel of a friend Proverbs 27:9
- Oil of Joy for Mourning Isaiah 61:3

Oil is a Food, Medicine, Cosmetic, Illuminant,

[Exo 27:20 ESV] 20 "You shall command the people of Israel that they bring to you pure beaten olive oil for the light, that a lamp may regularly be set up to burn. [Exo 30:25, 31 ESV] 25 And you shall make of these a sacred anointing oil blended as by the perfumer; it shall be a holy anointing oil. ... 31 And you shall say to the people of Israel, 'This shall be my holy anointing oil throughout your generations. [Lev 8:12 ESV] 12 And he poured some of the anointing oil on Aaron's head and anointed him to consecrate him.

[Lev 24:2 KJV] 2 Command the children of Israel, that they bring unto thee pure oil olive beaten for the light, to cause the lamps to burn continually.

[Jer 49:11 ESV] 11 Leave your fatherless children; I will keep them alive; and let your widows trust in me."


