




Let's review

- A victim of Satan, he lost 10 kids, all his possessions and suffered extreme physical health issues
- His friends were wonderful & terrible
- · Job wrestles with his, and for his faith, thru suffering
- What should we detest even more than suffering?
- What is stronger than suffering? And what we detest?

Detest: to feel abhorrence of; hate; dislike intensely.

Love is stronger!



"Yet as for me",

- Nothing is more personal! Then Suffering!
- Why do we never truly appreciate something until ...
- Job's saying, he still trusts God when he is confused
- "I Know"! Stick with what / who we know!

YET!

Its not merely subjective, like its MY truth. Its personal in that If you don't know Him, you're hopeless

[Job 42:1-3 NASB20] 1 Then Job answered the LORD and said, 2 "I know that You can [do] all things, And that no plan is impossible for You. 3 'Who is this who conceals advice without knowledge?' Therefore I have declared that which I did not understand, Things too wonderful for me, which I do not know.

[2Ti 1:8-15 NASB20] 8 Therefore do not be ashamed of the testimony of our Lord or of me His prisoner, but join with [me] in suffering for the gospel according to the power of God, 9 who saved us and called us with a holy calling, not according to our works, but according to His own purpose and grace, which was granted to us in Christ Jesus from all eternity, 10 but has now been revealed by the appearing of our Savior Christ Jesus, who abolished death and brought life and immortality to light through the gospel, 11 for which I was appointed a preacher, an apostle, and a teacher. 12 For this reason I also suffer these things; but I am not ashamed, for I know whom I have believed, and I am convinced that He is able to protect what I have entrusted to Him until that day. 13 Hold on to the example of sound

words which you have heard from me, in [the] faith and love which are in Christ Jesus. 14 Protect, through the Holy Spirit who dwells in us, the treasure which has been entrusted to [you.] 15 You are aware of the fact that all who are in Asia turned away from me, among whom are Phygelus and Hermogenes.

- Job 1:5 "Perhaps, my sons have sinned and cursed God in their hearts." Job did so continually.



You may have seen Hillary Clinton's 'basket of deplorables' comments on the news or your social media feeds in recent days.



[Jhn 19:30 NASB20] 30 Therefore when Jesus had received the sour wine, He said, "It is finished!" And He bowed His head and gave up His spirit.

- 1. Job knows eventually he will suffer and DIE!
- 2. Job knows that he will get a new body!
- 3. Job knows he will be raised Physically, not metaphorically or just spiritually

I will see God - The same unique personality and person named Job! Not some jumbled karma absorption into "the force"

[Psa 17:15 NASB20] 15 As for me, I shall behold Your face in righteousness; I shall be satisfied with Your likeness when I awake.

[Mat 5:8 NASB20] 8 "Blessed are the pure in heart, for they will see God. [1Co 13:12 NASB20] 12 For now we see in a mirror dimly, but then face to face; now I know in part, but then I will know fully, just as I also have been fully known. [1Co 15:53 NASB20] 53 For this perishable must put on the imperishable, and this mortal [must] put on immortality.



- Within me = Bosom, loins
- Job either feels internal withering or a praise eruption

[Job 19:23-24 NASB20] 23 "Oh that my words were written! Oh that they were recorded in a book! 24 "That with an iron stylus and lead They were engraved in the rock forever!

[Exo 29:13 NASB20] 13 "And you shall take all the fat that covers the entrails, and the lobe of the liver, and the two kidneys[H3629] and the fat that is on them, and offer them up in smoke on the altar.



- Our hearts may faint, His love never fails! Romans 8



[Job 19:23-24 NASB20] 23 "Oh that my words were written! Oh that they were recorded in a book! 24 "That with an iron stylus and lead They were engraved in the rock forever!



Some suppose that the meaning of this place is this: the iron pen is the chisel by which the letters were to be deeply cut in the stone or rock; and the lead was melted into those cavities in order to preserve the engraving distinct.



But this is not so natural a supposition as what is stated above; that Job refers to the different kinds of writing or perpetuating public events, used in his time.

Job not only possessed a testimony of the Savior but also desired to write it down, preserve it, and share it with others




ABR researchers discover the oldest known proto-Hebrew inscription ever found.




Malachi 3:16-18

- 16 Then those who feared the LORD talked with each other, and the LORD listened and heard. A scroll of remembrance was written in his presence concerning those who feared the LORD and honored his name.






Job 19: 25-27 (Amplified Bible)
