Parables were used because Many, incl religious leaders were hypercritical, just looking for faults. This shielded truth from them, to some degree but the HS used them to open the eyes of those being saved

- They made you think, ask questions
- They were relatable to their culture and helped give understanding from theory to practical, words to pictures/visuals, rich Imagery
- People prefer stories, Narratives to Laws and Didactic
- Earthly stories with Heavenly meanings
- Our problem is we are SO blessed, most of us have lost touch with agrarian principles in America, most of the world still knows

Teaching them many things in parables

- Again, he began to teach
- "Listen! Behold", Attention grabbing
- Why parables to reveal and conceal
- Near 40-50 parables of Jesus!
- Don't overanalyze them, usually a simple main lesson

Be careful, Don't Mix Metaphors!

Para ballo =

The Greek for "parable" — $parabol\acute{e}$ — <u>literally means to compare things by</u> throwing or placing things along side each other. The technical definition of a parable is that it's an extended simile. The comparison is expressed clearly in "the kingdom of heaven is like . . ." which is a story or prolonged comparison, not a simple simile. The Hebrew word for it, $masal\ [mah\text{-}shal]$), means "to be like."



Rocky ground – Mushroom growth, quick but short lived growth. *Persecution and tribulation. Mans life under the Sun!*

Rototiller – You must be broken to come to Christ!

Hot Sun beating down mushrooms and other short-lived growth. Desert! Climate!Weeds! Sucking away the life and choking out the good seed



The Seed is Special!

The Seed was the same in each Soil! But was only productive (long term) in the right soil!

The Enemy fears the Word!, he try's to take it away.

The Word of God = is Gods Breath! Adam and the 2nd Adam! 2Tim.3:16-17

Jesus is the Word! The written word is the lingering voice of the Living Word! Seeds, are miraculous, They are technically dead and come to life when planted! [1Co 15:36 ESV] 36 You foolish person! What you sow does not come to life unless it dies." (Dormant?)

Farmers aim the seed to best soil, some falls elsewhere, Generous distribution

Back then a yield of 10 to 1 was considered a fine crop. The Mystery of the productiveness of the Produce!





Thinking of Parables - Some modern day people want to argue the literalness of whether seeds are Dead or dormant?

Hannah was sprouted from a 2,000 year-old seed, and pollinated by another Ancient Judean date tree. Dr. Elaine Solowey, director of the Center for Sustainable Agriculture of the Arava Institute, and Dr. Sarah Sallon, director of the Louis L. Borick Natural Medicine Research Center of Hadassah Hospital, harvested these ancient dates in the culmination of an ambitious, decades-long experiment to raise the biblical-era Phoenix dactylifera – date palm – from the dead.


In phase two the sower appears but is not active. After planting the seed, he leaves it and goes about his duties night and day without anxious thought for the seed. Meanwhile it germinates, sprouts, and grows in a way he did not know and cannot explain.

The soil (lit., "the earth") produces grain which develops to maturity in successive stages. The soil does this all by itself (automatē; cf. the Eng. "automatic"). This key Greek word (emphatic by position) could be translated "without visible cause" implying "without human agency," and thus refers to work done by God (cf. similar situations in Josh. 6:5; Job 24:24; Acts 12:10). God works in the life-bearing seed which, when planted in good soil, grows stage by stage and produces grain without human intervention.

It is like a grain of mustard seed 30-34

- When sown...is the smallest of all the seeds on earth,
- Yet when...it grows up and becomes larger than all the garden plants (herbs, seasoning)
- So that the birds of the air can make nests in its shade.
- Galatians 6:7 Do not be deceived: God is not mocked, for whatever one sows, that will he also reap.

This time the parable of the birds, Birds aren't doing something Bad!, But enjoying good!

[Mar 4:30-34 ESV] 30 And he said, "With what can we compare the kingdom of God, or what parable shall we use for it? 31 It is like a grain of mustard seed, which, when sown on the ground, is the smallest of all the seeds on earth, 32 yet when it is sown it grows up and becomes larger than all the garden plants and puts out large branches, so that the birds of the air can make nests in its shade." 33 With many such parables he spoke the word to them, as they were able to hear it. 34 He did not speak to them without a parable, but privately to his own disciples he explained everything.

Remember Nebuchadnezzar tree where the world came and found rest

In Jewish thinking, its small size was proverbial since it was the smallest of all the seeds sown in the field. It took 725-760 mustard seeds to weigh a gram (28 grams equal one ounce). The mustard shrub is an annual plant which, growing from seed, becomes the largest of all garden plants (ta lachana, "large, fast-growing annual shrubs") in Palestine, reaching a height of 10–12 feet in a few weeks. Birds of the air (undomesticated fowl) are attracted by its seed and the shade of its large branches (cf. tdnt, s.v. "sinapi," 7:287–91).

[Mat 13:31-33 ESV] 31 He put another parable before them, saying, "The kingdom of heaven is like a grain of mustard seed that a man took and sowed in his field. 32 It is the smallest of all seeds, but when it has grown it is larger than all the garden plants and becomes a tree, so that the birds of the air come and make nests in its branches." 33 He told them another parable. "The kingdom of heaven is like leaven that a woman took and hid in three measures of flour, till it was all leavened."

[Mat 16:6, 11-12 ESV] 6 Jesus said to them, "Watch and beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and Sadducees." ... 11 How is it that you fail to understand that I did not speak about bread? Jesus Coming Was ALWAYS the Plan!!

The basic "secret," common to all the kingdom parables, is that in Jesus, God's rule (kingdom) has come into human experience in a new spiritual form. The disciples had believed in Jesus. God had already given (dedotai, perf. pass.) them this "secret," though so far they understood little of its full impact.

Imagine the Earth/Eden before the rebellion! Everything was Good! Very Good!



The Greek for "parable" — $parabol\acute{e}$ — <u>literally means to compare things by</u> throwing or placing things along side each other. The technical definition of a parable is that it's an extended simile. The comparison is expressed clearly in "the kingdom of heaven is like . . ." which is a story or prolonged comparison, not a simple simile. The Hebrew word for it, masal [mah-shal]), means "to be like."
