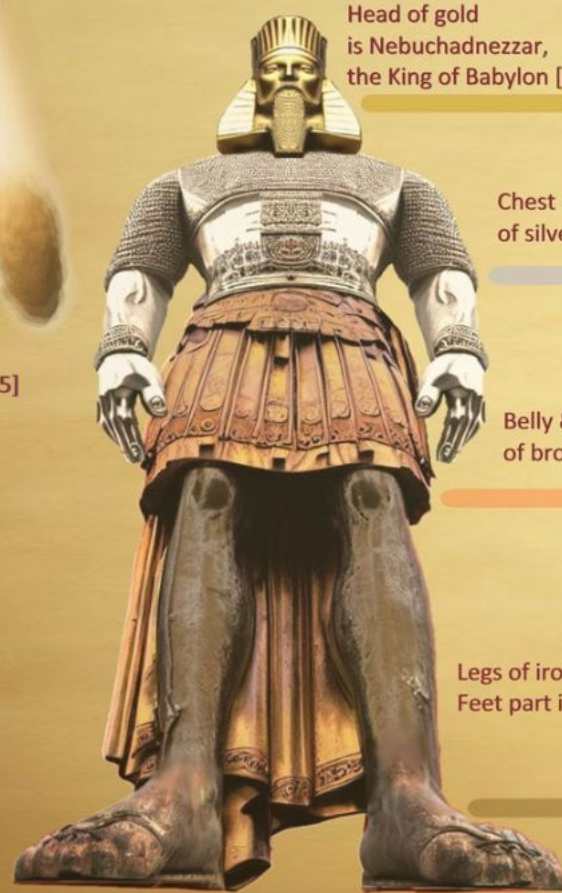

Bear raised up on one side
with three ribs in its mouth



Leopard with four heads
and four wings like a bird



Beast with iron teeth, bronze claws, and ten horns
A little horn came up and three horns were uprooted



Ram with two horns,
with one longer, are the kings
of Media and Persia [8:20]



Shaggy goat is the king of Greece [8:21]
The large horn is the first king [8:21]
The four horns that replaced the broken
horn are four kingdoms from his nation [8:22]



The serpent of old, the dragon with seven heads and
ten horns, on the shore by the sea is Satan [12,13,20]



Beast with seven heads and ten horns,
like a leopard, feet like a bear, mouth like a lion,
one head seemed fatally wounded but healed [13,17]

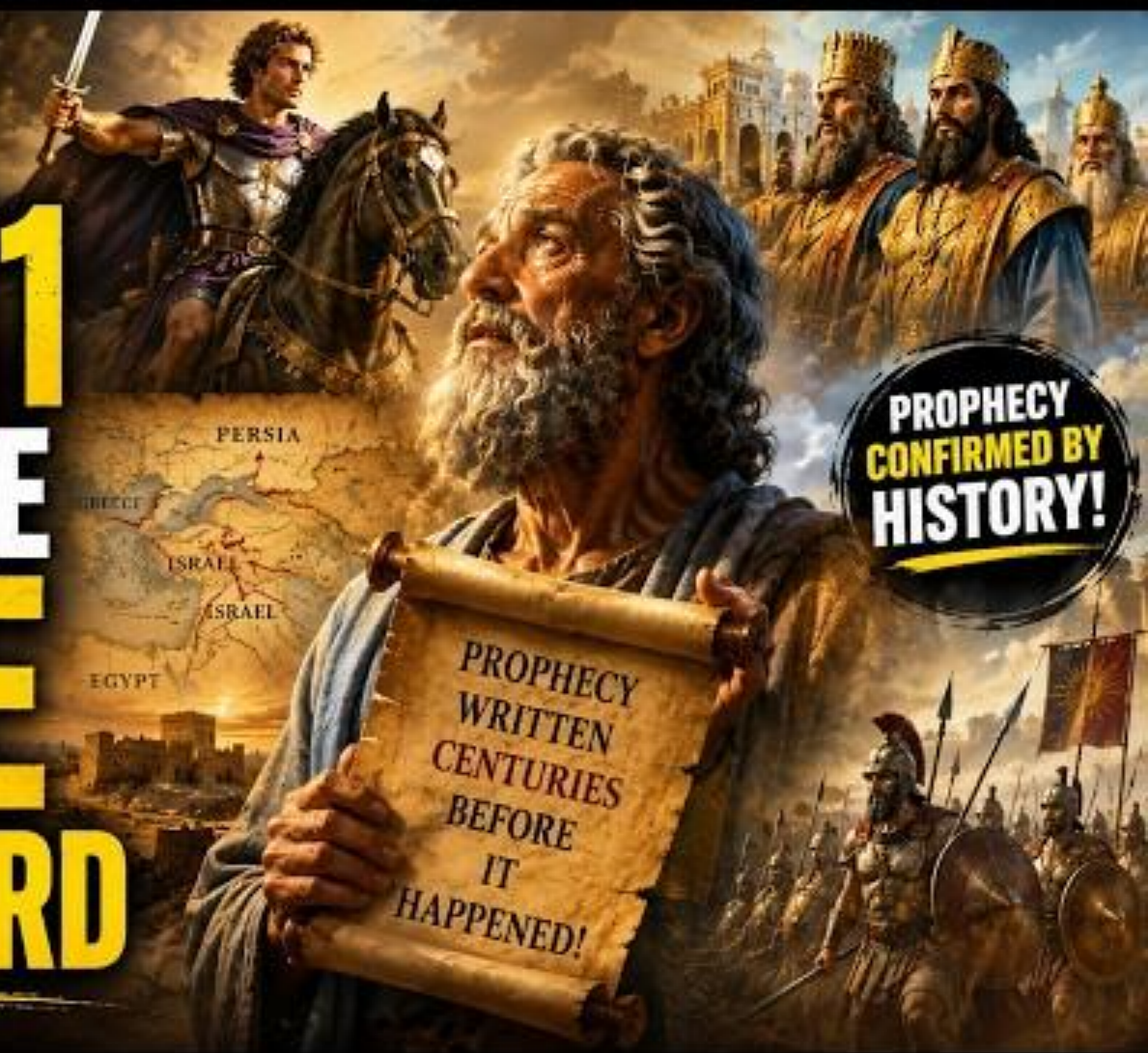


Beast with two horns like a lamb,
spoke like a dragon [13]

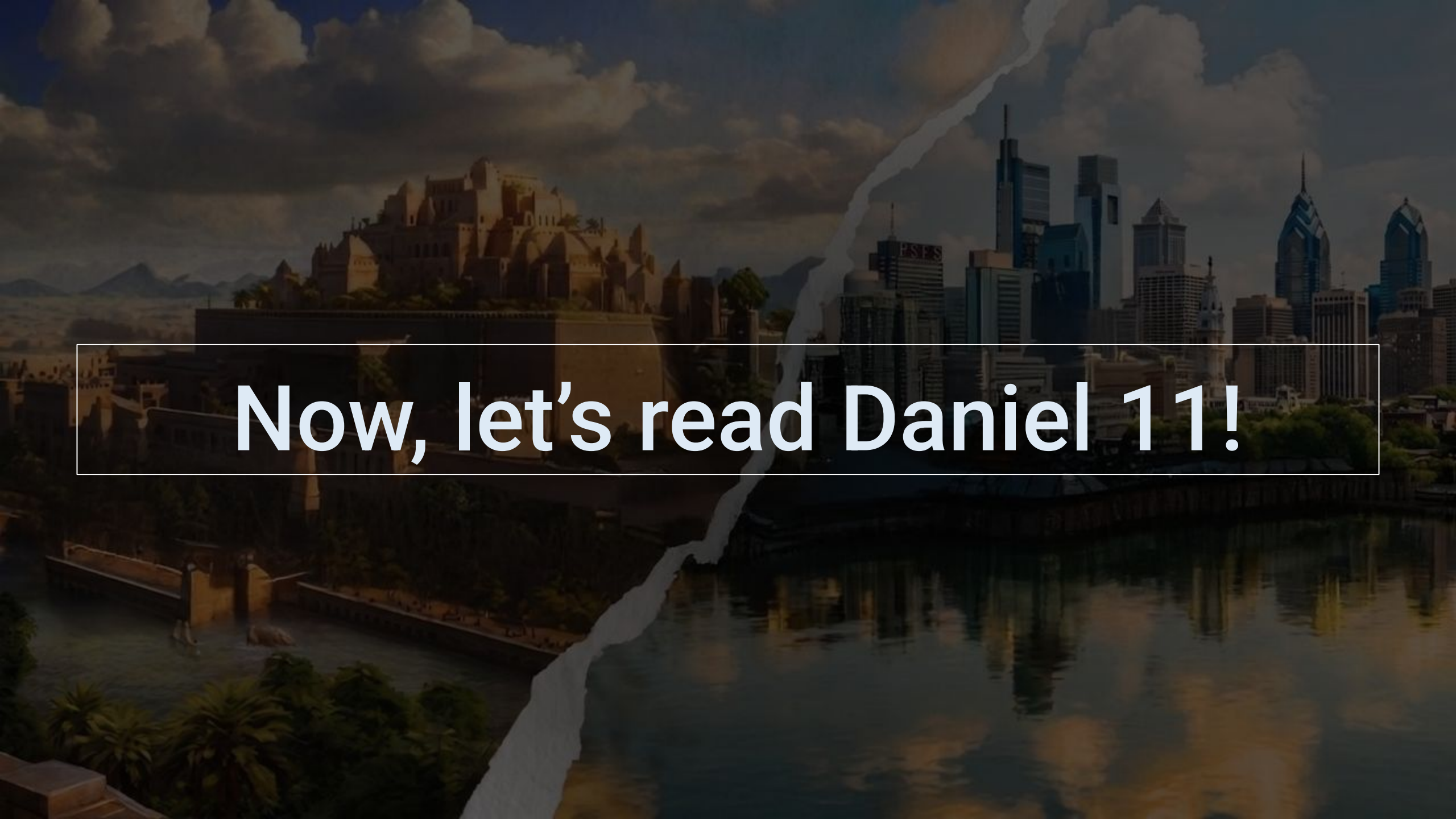
II. God Rules Over History

- 1. God is sovereign over all of history – past, present and future.**
- 2. Daniel's prophecies leading to this point already showed that, but what he sees in Daniel 11 is another level of detail.**
- 3. Recorded history confirms God's sovereignty!**
- 4. King of the North vs King of the South**
 - a. Daniel 11 covers 100s of years**
 - i. These terms refer to many different people (typology)**

Historical Breakdown

- Daniel 11:1-20 → Medo-Persia to Greece (Alexander the Great), split into 4, Seleucis takes North (Selucid dynasty), Ptolemy takes South (Ptolemaic dynasty)
- Daniel 11:21-28 → Antiochus IV Epiphanes (Epimanes)
- Daniel 11:29-35 → Abomination of Desolation
- Daniel 11:36-39 → Rise of the Antichrist
- Daniel 11:40-45 → Time of Tribulation

III. The Rise of the Antichrist

1. Abomination of Desolation

- a. Daniel 11:31 – 31 Forces from him shall appear and profane the temple and fortress, and shall take away the regular burnt offering. And they shall set up the abomination that makes desolate.
 - i. Unholy worship!
 - ii. Antiochus Epiphanes sacrifices pigs to Zeus!

III. The Rise of the Antichrist

2. Historical Abomination vs Future

a. Jesus points forward

- i. Matthew 24:15-16 – 15 *“So when you see the abomination of desolation spoken of by the prophet Daniel, standing in the holy place (let the reader understand), 16 then let those who are in Judea flee to the mountains.*

b. Future Abomination – The Antichrist himself

III. The Rise of the Antichrist

3. “The King” of Daniel 11:36

- a. Unopposed → does “as he wills”
- b. Exalts self, speaks against other gods
 - i. Daniel 7 “little horn” “speaks against the Most High”
 - ii. Daniel 9 “the prince who is to come” who destroys the city, “desolations are decreed”

III. The Rise of the Antichrist

4. Antichrist's actions here elaborated in NT

- a. Revelation 13:1-8 (10 horns, haughty blasphemous words, authority over every tribe and people)
- b. Revelation 17:12-13 (10 horns 10 kings, hand power to the beast)
- c. 2 Thessalonians 2:4 (opposes all religions, takes seat in the temple)
- d. Revelation 13:3 (Hollow imitation of Christ!)
- e. Revelation 13:11-15 (signs and miracles used to deceive!)
- f. Revelation 13:16-17 (seizes control of economy!)

III. The Rise of the Antichrist

5. The King Attacked!

- a. Daniel 11:40-43
 - i. Kings of the South and North simultaneously attack Israel
 - 1. During 1st half of 70th week (Daniel 9:27 – Antichrist and Israel in covenant)
 - ii. Antichrist retaliates, gaining ground until. . .
- b. Daniel 11:44 – Alarming reports from the east!
 - i. Revelation 9:16 – The number of mounted troops was twice ten thousand times ten thousand; I heard their number.
 - 1. 200 million soldiers from “the east”? China’s army?
 - ii. Antichrist becomes enraged, destroys many, sets up palace in Israel.

III. The Rise of the Antichrist

5. God destroys the Antichrist

- a. Daniel 11:45 – “...Yet he shall come to his end, with none to help him.”
- b. Antichrist sets up in Israel, pretending to be the Messiah, established in a one-world government with a one-world religion wherein he is worshiped as god, but then Jesus Christ returns.
 - i. Revelation 19:19-20 – *And I saw the beast and the kings of the earth with their armies gathered to make war against him who was sitting on the horse and against his army. And the beast was captured, and with it the false prophet who in its presence had done the signs by which he deceived those who had received the mark of the beast and those who worshiped its image. These two were thrown alive into the lake of fire that burns with sulfur.*

IV. Wrath of Man, Satan, and God

1. Humanity harbors and carries out wrath against one another.
 - a. James 1:20 – *For the wrath of man does not produce the righteousness of God.*
2. Satan is filled and blinded by his wrath.
 - a. Daniel 11:44 (Goes out in a fury to destroy!)
 - b. Revelation 12:7-12 (Loses against God, so comes down to take it out on His creation while he still can!)

IV. Wrath of Man, Satan, and God

3. The Wrath of God!

- a. John 3:36 *Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life; whoever does not obey the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God remains on him.*
- b. Romans 1:18 *For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who by their unrighteousness suppress the truth.*
- c. Romans 12:19 *Beloved, never avenge yourselves, but leave it to the wrath of God, for it is written, "Vengeance is mine, I will repay, says the Lord."*

IV. Wrath of Man, Satan, and God

3. The Wrath of God!

a. Deliverance

- i. 1Th 1:10 *and to wait for his Son from heaven, whom he raised from the dead, Jesus who delivers us from the wrath to come.*
- ii. 1Th 5:9 *For God has not destined us for wrath, but to obtain salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ,*

IV. Wrath of Man, Satan, and God

3. The Wrath of God!

a. Wrath vs Discipline

- i. *Rom 8:1-2 There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus. 2 For the law of the Spirit of life has set you free in Christ Jesus from the law of sin and death.*
- ii. *Hebrews 12:5-10 And have you forgotten the exhortation that addresses you as sons? "My son, do not regard lightly the discipline of the Lord, nor be weary when reproved by him. 6 For the Lord disciplines the one he loves, and chastises every son whom he receives." 7 It is for discipline that you have to endure. God is treating you as sons. For what son is there whom his father does not discipline?*
