Mar 1:14-20 Now after John was arrested, Jesus came into Galilee, proclaiming the gospel of God, 15 and saying, "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand; repent and believe in the gospel." 16 Passing alongside the Sea of Galilee, he saw Simon and Andrew the brother of Simon casting a net into the sea, for they were fishermen. 17 And Jesus said to them, "Follow me, and I will make you become fishers of men." 18 And immediately they left their nets and followed him. 19 And going on a little farther, he saw James the son of Zebedee and John his brother, who were in their boat mending the nets. 20 And immediately he called them, and they left their father Zebedee in the boat with the hired servants and followed him.

[Mat 6:9-10 ESV] 9 Pray then like this: "Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name. 10 Your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.

[Luk 10:9 ESV] 9 Heal the sick in it and say to them, 'The kingdom of God has come near to you.'

[Luk 11:20 ESV] 20 But if it is by the finger of God that I cast out demons, then the kingdom of God has come upon you.

[Luk 13:29 ESV] 29 And people will come from east and west, and from north and south, and

recline at table in the kingdom of God.



[Luk 23:42 ESV] 42 And he said, "Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom."


[Act 1:6 ESV] 6 So when they had come together, they asked him, "Lord, will you at this time restore the kingdom to Israel?"

[Mat 11:1-20 ESV] 1 When Jesus had finished instructing his twelve disciples, he went on from there to teach and preach in their cities. 2 Now when John heard in prison about the deeds of the Christ, he sent word by his disciples 3 and said to him, "Are you the one who is to come, or shall we look for another?" 4 And Jesus answered them, "Go and tell John what you hear and see: 5 the blind receive their sight and the lame walk, lepers are cleansed and the deaf hear, and the dead are raised up, and the poor have good news preached to them. 6 And blessed is the one who is not offended by me." 7 As they went away, Jesus began to speak to the crowds concerning John: "What did you go out into the wilderness to see? A reed shaken by the wind? 8 What then did you go out to see? A man dressed in soft clothing? Behold, those who wear soft clothing are in kings' houses. 9 What then did you go out to see? A prophet?

Yes, I tell you, and more than a prophet. 10 This is he of whom it is written, "Behold, I send my messenger before your face, who will prepare your way before you.' 11 Truly, I say to you, among those born of women there has arisen no one greater than John the Baptist. Yet the one who is least in the kingdom of heaven is greater than he. 12 From the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven has suffered violence, and the violent take it by force. 13 For all the Prophets and the Law prophesied until John, 14 and if you are willing to accept it, he is Elijah who is to come. 15 He who has ears to hear, let him hear. 16 "But to what shall I compare this generation? It is like children sitting in the marketplaces and calling to their playmates, 17 "We played the flute for you, and you did not dance; we sang a dirge, and you did not mourn.' 18 For John came neither eating nor drinking, and they say, 'He has a demon.' 19 The Son of Man came eating and drinking, and they say, 'Look at him! A glutton and a drunkard, a friend of tax collectors and sinners!' Yet wisdom is justified by her deeds." 20 Then he began to denounce the cities where most of his mighty works had been done, because they did not repent.

[Mar 6:14-29 ESV] 14 King Herod heard of it, for Jesus' name had become known. Some said, "John the Baptist has been raised from the dead. That is why these miraculous powers are at work in him." 15 But others said, "He is Elijah." And others said, "He is a prophet, like one of the prophets of old." 16 But when Herod heard of it, he said, "John, whom I beheaded, has been raised." 17 For it was Herod who had sent and seized John and bound him in prison for the sake of Herodias, his brother Philip's wife, because he had married her. 18 For John had been saying to Herod, "It is not lawful for you to have your brother's wife." 19 And Herodias had a grudge against him and wanted to put him to death. But she could not, 20 for Herod feared John, knowing that he was a righteous and holy man, and he kept him safe. When he heard him, he was greatly perplexed, and yet he heard him gladly. 21 But an opportunity came when Herod on his birthday gave a banquet for his nobles and military commanders and the leading men of Galilee. 22 For when Herodias's daughter came in and danced, she pleased Herod and his guests. And the king said to the girl, "Ask me for whatever you wish, and I will give it to you." 23 And he vowed to her, "Whatever you ask me, I will give you, up to half of my kingdom." 24 And she went out and said to her mother, "For

what should I ask?" And she said, "The head of John the Baptist." 25 And she came in immediately with haste to the king and asked, saying, "I want you to give me at once the head of John the Baptist on a platter." 26 And the king was exceedingly sorry, but because of his oaths and his guests he did not want to break his word to her. 27 And immediately the king sent an executioner with orders to bring John's head. He went and beheaded him in the prison 28 and brought his head on a platter and gave it to the girl, and the girl gave it to her mother. 29 When his disciples heard of it, they came and took his body and laid it in a tomb.

[Mal 3:1 NASB20] 1 "Behold, I am sending My messenger, and he will clear a way before Me. And the Lord, whom you are seeking, will suddenly come to His temple; and the messenger of the covenant, in whom you delight, behold, He is coming," says the LORD of armies.

[Mal 4:5-6 NASB20] 5 "Behold, I am going to send you Elijah the prophet before the coming of the great and terrible day of the LORD. 6 "He will turn the hearts of the fathers back to [their] children and the hearts of the children to their fathers, so that I will not come and strike the land with complete destruction."

To repent is to change ones mind/attitude:

- Toward Self Its NOT about Me!
- 2. \sin We hate the sin we once loved, hate sin, not just the consequences!
- 3. God Our view of God is changed! We See Him High, lifted up, Loving and Good
- 4. Christ! More than a mere good teacher





GODLY REPENTANCE	Worldly Repentance
Willingly confesses sin and acknowledges guilt	Is defensive and argumentative; won't acknowledge guilt
Is angry about his own sin	Is angry at the one who exposes his sin
Fears the wrath and discipline of God	Fears exposure, shame, and loss of reputation
Longs to restore relationships broken by sin	Is apathetic about lost relationships
Is dedicated to and zealous for holiness	Has no interest in holiness; is attracted to the world
Is willing to make restitution for his sin	Is uncaring about the consequences of his sin and unwilling to make restitution
Is pure in all subsequent actions	His subsequent life is impure and ungodly

Fishermen – Disciples – Apostles

- Jesus didn't choose professional Rabbi's, Priests ...
- He chose uneducated, blue-collar rednecks! Acts 4:13
- The followed, learned, served, preached, then Led!
- We are both Fishers of Men and Shepherds of Sheep!

Jesus didn't pick Rabbis, Priests, Scribes, or even consult the High Priest!

Uneducated doesn't mean stupid! It means Unindoctrinated, like in today's schools!

Jn.21 We see them fishing, Jesus' miracle to catch fish, then Feed my Sheep!

One thing both Fishermen and Shepherds have in common, They often end up stinking as a result of their occupations. One catches, one feeds and protects. Nets and Staffs

A "redneck" is a term with shifting meanings, originally referring to people with sunburned necks from working outdoors, but later becoming a derogatory label for rural, white working-class individuals, particularly in the American South, associated with traits like perceived ignorance, racism, or conservatism. The term has also been used historically to identify striking coal miners and revolutionary Scottish Presbyterians.

[Act 4:13 ESV] 13 Now when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, and perceived that **they were uneducated, common men**, they were astonished. And they recognized that they had been with Jesus.

[Act 2:7-8 ESV] 7 And they were amazed and astonished, saying, "Are not all these who are speaking Galileans? 8 And how is it that we hear, each of us in his own native

language?

[Mat 11:25 ESV] 25 At that time Jesus declared, "I thank you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that you have hidden these things from the wise and understanding and revealed them to little children;




[1Co 1:27 ESV] 27 But God chose what is foolish in the world to shame the wise; God chose what is weak in the world to shame the strong;

1Co 1:22-31 For Jews demand signs and Greeks seek wisdom, 23 but we preach Christ crucified, a stumbling block to Jews and folly to Gentiles, 24 but to those who are called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power of God and the wisdom of God. 25 For the foolishness of God is wiser than men, and the weakness of God is stronger than men. 26 For consider your calling, brothers: not many of you were wise according to worldly standards, not many were powerful, not many were of noble birth. 27 But God chose what is foolish in the world to shame the wise; God chose what is weak in the world to shame the strong; 28 God chose what is low and despised in the world, even things that are not, to bring to nothing things that are, 29 so that no human being might boast in the presence of God. 30 And because of him you are in Christ Jesus, who became to us wisdom from God, righteousness and sanctification and redemption, 31 so that, as it is written, "Let the one who boasts, boast in the Lord."

[Act 6:7 ESV] 7 And the word of God continued to increase, and the number of the disciples multiplied greatly in Jerusalem, and <u>a great many of the priests became obedient to the faith</u>.

- Immediately = Action, serving, Obedience, convinced
- Mark 1:18 And immediately they left their nets and followed him.

The Word Immediately is an interesting one and Mark uses it often! It denotes Activity, motivated response, Obedience, urgency

12x in chapter 1 alone!



4 Components of a Kingdom

A King

the "Kingdom of Heaven" is a phrase used almost exclusively in the Gospel of Matthew 31x. Matthew writing of Millennial Kingdom? KOG is Universal Kingdom

The phrase "kingdom of God" occurs 68 times in 10 different New Testament books

While some interpretations suggest distinct future aspects (like a heavenly kingdom versus an earthly one), the general consensus among scholars and biblical context is that the terms are interchangeable and refer to the same spiritual realm where God reigns

For example, speaking to the rich young ruler, Christ uses "kingdom of heaven" and "kingdom of God" interchangeably. "Then Jesus said to his disciples, 'I tell you the truth, it is hard for a rich man to enter the kingdom of heaven" (Matthew 19:23). In the very next verse, Christ proclaims, "Again I tell you, it is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for a rich man to enter the kingdom of God" (verse 24). Jesus makes no distinction between the two terms but seems to consider them synonymous.

Mark and Luke used "kingdom of God" where Matthew used "kingdom of heaven" frequently in parallel accounts of the same parable. Compare <u>Matthew 11:11-12</u> with <u>Luke 7:28</u>; <u>Matthew 13:11</u>with <u>Mark 4:11</u> and <u>Luke 8:10</u>; <u>Matthew 13:24</u> with <u>Mark 4:26</u>; <u>Matthew 13:31</u> with <u>Mark 4:30</u> and <u>Luke 13:18</u>; <u>Matthew 13:33</u> with <u>Luke 13:20</u>; <u>Matthew 18:3</u> with <u>Mark 10:14</u> and <u>Luke 18:16</u>; and <u>Matthew 22:2</u> with <u>Luke 13:29</u>. In each instance, Matthew used the phrase "kingdom of heaven" while Mark and/or Luke used "kingdom of God." Clearly, the two phrases refer to the same thing. https://www.gotquestions.org/kingdom-heaven-God.html




SEVENTY WEEKS OF DANIEL

Messiah's Salvation, Deliverance, & Eternal Kingdom

Daniel 9:24-27



Decree to Rebuild Jerusalem = The 69 weeks started with the issuing of a decree to restore and rebuild Jerusalem.

Presentation of Messiah = The day that Jesus was presented to His people as the Messiah as He rode on a donkey into Jerusalem.

Death of Messiah = Christ was cut off and had nothing (literally "no one"). But he was pierced for our transgressions (Isaiah 53:5).

Destruction of Jerusalem = The "people of the prince (Antichrist) who is to come" ransacked Jerusalem & destroyed the temple (70 A.D.)

Interlude = There is an interlude between the 69th week & the beginning of the 70th week. It's been almost 2,000 years & still waiting.


Antichrist Makes Covenant = Antichrist will make some type of agreement with the Jewish people.


