

The Implied rhetorical question!

[Mar 8:27-30 ESV] 27 And Jesus went on with his disciples to the villages of Caesarea Philippi. 

According to the 2020 American Worldview Inventory from Arizona Christian University, half
of Americans believe that "if a person is generally good, or does enough good things
during their life, they will "earn" a place in Heaven.

Earlier this week, while explaining his efforts to end the war between Russia and Ukraine, <u>President Trump said</u>:

I want to try to get to heaven, if possible. I'm hearing that I'm not doing well. I really hit the bottom of the totem pole. But if I can get to heaven, this will be one of the reasons.

According to the <u>annual "State of Theology" survey</u> conducted by Ligonier Ministries and LifeWay Research, 65% of evangelicals agreed that everyone is "born innocent in the eyes of God," a position that denies <u>the doctrine of original sin</u> and the reason people *need* salvation in the first place. 56% of evangelicals agreed with the statement, "God accepts the worship of all religions, including Christianity, Judaism, and Islam," https://theaquilareport.com/president-trump-and-the-hope-of-heaven/

It is the common default position of every newly deceased loved one that they automatically went to Heaven, unless they did something really Bad!

In the beginning,

- Mark 1:1 "The beginning of the gospel of Jesus Christ, the Son of God." The beginning??
 - Mark 10:6 But from the beginning of creation, 'God made them male and female.'
 - John 1:1-2 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. (Genesis 1:1)
 - Acts 1:1 In the first book, O Theophilus, I have dealt with all that Jesus began to do and teach

The same Greek word for beginning in Mk.1 is the same as the beginning of creation! See other uses below

The gospel begins with justification/redemption but isn't finished until sanctification and glorification! His kingdom come!

Interestingly many people think their salvation was complete with a simple prayer and then go off to live as they please

It is finished = Justification. Jn.19:30

Being saved = Sanctification. 1Cor.1:18, 2Cor.2:15

He will glorify = Rom.8:17, 30



The beginning of the gospel = Gospel describes the body of faith, and also the individualized transforming work of justification...

2, 1, 3, 4 + When written and published, Many Conservative theologians believe <u>Mark was</u> <u>written 1st</u>!, the others filled in more details and new material, notice Mark has only 3% unique info!

Matthew and John were original disciples, Mark was scribe for Peter! Luke for Paul? A Gentile, Drops sweat/blood, So only half gospel writers were original disciples, only 1 of them was a fisherman out of 6! Matthew was outsider

Jesus as King, Jesus as Servant/King, Jesus as Man (Luke the Physician), Jesus as God!

Written for Jews, **for Romans**, for Greeks, for all mankind

Marks gospel, was 1st/premise for others, Shortest, Fastest/most direct

Luke, the name Luke is a Gentile name, of Greek/roman background. Possibly a Hellenized

Jew? Highly educated (White Collar)

Col 4:10-11, 14 Aristarchus my fellow prisoner greets you, and <u>Mark the cousin</u> of Barnabas (concerning whom you have received instructions--if he comes to you, welcome him), 11 and Jesus who is called Justus. These are the only men of the circumcision among my fellow workers for the kingdom of God, and they have been a comfort to me. ...14 <u>Luke the beloved physician</u> greets you, as does Demas.

Mark

[Act 12:12 ESV] 12 When he realized this, he went to the house of Mary, **the** mother of John whose other name was Mark, where many were gathered together and were praying.

[Act 13:5, 13 ESV] 5 When they arrived at Salamis, they proclaimed the word of God in the synagogues of the Jews. And they had John to assist them. ... 13 Now Paul and his companions set sail from Paphos and came to Perga in Pamphylia. And John left them and returned to Jerusalem,

[Act 15:37-39 ESV] 37 Now Barnabas wanted to take with them John called Mark. 38 But Paul thought best not to take with them one who had withdrawn from them in Pamphylia and had not gone with them to the work. 39 And there arose a sharp disagreement, so that they separated from each other. Barnabas took Mark with him and sailed away to Cyprus,

[2Ti 4:11 ESV] 11 Luke alone is with me. Get Mark and bring him with you, for he is very useful to me for ministry.

[1Pe 5:13 ESV] 13 She who is at Babylon, who is likewise chosen, **sends you** greetings, and so does Mark, my son.

Philemon 1:23-24

Epaphras, my fellow prisoner in Christ Jesus, greets you, as do <u>Mark</u>, Aristarchus, Demas, <u>Luke</u>, my fellow laborers.

Before **Matthew** became a disciple of Christ, he was a tax collector or "<u>publican</u>" in the town of Capernaum (<u>Matthew 9:9</u>; <u>10:3</u>). Matthew is also called Levi, the son of Alphaeus, by Luke and Mark (<u>Mark 2:14</u>; <u>Luke 5:27</u>).

Luke was a companion of the Apostle Paul, and the traditional view is that he was Paul's scribe or secretary, which explains the "we" passages in Acts and his access to information about Paul's life. He accompanied Paul during his missionary journeys and his Roman imprisonment, even being the only one with Paul near the end of the apostle's life.

So 4 gospels

- 3 Jews, 1 Gentile?
- 2 Original disciples, 2 2nd degree disciples, disciples of disciples
- 1 White collar educated professional, 1 fisherman (blue collar), 1 former collaborator with Rome (Publican/tax collector) 1 fearful/deserter/frail follower Mark

Who is Mark?

- His Mom gave hospitality to early church! Acts 12:12
- John Mark, served with Paul/Barnabas Acts 12:12, 25
- John is likely the scribe for Apostle Peter
- John Mark fled in hard times! In Garden??
 - Mark 14:51-52
- Humble confession of cowardice to bold confessor!

John Mark wrote the gospel that bears his name **sometime between AD 55 and 59**. There could be a veiled reference to <u>John Mark</u> in <u>Mark 14:51–52</u>. In that passage a young man, roused from sleep on the night that Jesus was arrested, attempts to follow the Lord, and the mob who had Jesus in custody attempts to seize him. The young man escapes and flees into the night. The fact that this incident is only recorded in Mark's gospel—and the fact that the young man is anonymous—has led some scholars to surmise that the fleeing young man is actually John Mark.

Mark is the only gospel writer who mentions the streaking disciple who fled the Garden of Gethsemane! Many view this as a late MEA culpa, confession

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
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Clement also speaks of Mark when he writes, "Peter was publicly preaching the gospel at Rome in the presence of some of Caesar's knights and uttering many testimonies about Christ, [and] on their asking him to let them have a record of the things that had been said, wrote the gospel that is called the Gospel of Mark from the things said by Peter."

Of the gospel • Εὐαγγέλιον – euangelion – evangelical • "Go into all the world and proclaim the gospel" – Mark 16:15 • Good News! Contrasted with Dire News! • Obey the Gospel! – Romans 10:16, 2 Thessalonians 1:8, 1 Peter 4:17

[Act 13:46 ESV] 46 And Paul and Barnabas spoke out boldly, saying, "It was necessary that the word of God be spoken first to you. Since you thrust it aside and judge yourselves unworthy of eternal life, behold, we are turning to the Gentiles.

[Mar 1:1, 14-15 ESV] 1 The beginning of the gospel of Jesus Christ, the Son of God. ...

14 Now after John was arrested, Jesus came into Galilee, proclaiming the gospel of God, 15 and saying, "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand; repent and believe in the gospel."

Luke and John don't use the word – gospel?

Obey the Gospel- its an Ultimatum! Surrender to the true King or Die!

[Rom 1:16 ESV] 16 For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek.

[Rom 10:16 ESV] 16 But they have not all obeyed the gospel. For Isaiah says, "Lord, who has believed what he has heard from us?"

[1Co 15:1 ESV] 1 Now I would remind you, brothers, of the gospel I preached to you, which you received, in which you stand,

[2Co 11:4 ESV] 4 For if someone comes and proclaims another Jesus than the one we proclaimed, or if you receive a different spirit from the one you received, or if you accept a different gospel from the one you accepted, you put up with it readily enough.

[Gal 1:6-7, 11 ESV] 6 I am astonished that you are so quickly deserting him who called you in the grace of Christ and are turning to a different gospel-- 7 not that there is another one, but there are some who trouble you and want to distort the gospel of Christ. ... 11 For I would have you know, brothers, that the gospel that was preached by me is not man's gospel.

[Gal 2:14 ESV] 14 But when I saw that their conduct was not in step with the truth of the gospel, I said to Cephas before them all, "If you, though a Jew, live like a Gentile and not like a Jew, how can you force the Gentiles to live like Jews?"

[Eph 6:15, 19 ESV] 15 and, as shoes for your feet, having put on the readiness given by the gospel of peace. ... 19 and also for me, that words may be given to me in opening my mouth boldly to proclaim the mystery of the gospel,

[Phl 4:15 ESV] 15 And you Philippians yourselves know **that in the beginning of the gospel**, when I left Macedonia, no church entered into partnership with me in giving and receiving, except you only.

[2Th 1:8 ESV] 8 in flaming fire, inflicting vengeance on those who do not know God and on those who do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus.

[2Ti 2:8 ESV] 8 Remember Jesus Christ, risen from the dead, the offspring of

David, as preached in my gospel,

[1Pe 4:17 ESV] 17 For it is time for judgment to begin at the household of God; and if it begins with us, what will be the outcome for those who do not obey the gospel of God?

[Rev 14:6 ESV] 6 Then I saw another angel flying directly overhead, with an eternal gospel to proclaim to those who dwell on earth, to every nation and tribe and language and people.

Hiroo Onoda was a Japanese intelligence officer who hid in the jungle of <u>Lubang Island</u>, <u>Philippines</u>, for 29 years after World War II ended, continuing his military mission until 1974. Believing the war was still ongoing and that reports of Japan's surrender were enemy propaganda, Onoda lived in isolation, foraging for food and engaging in guerrilla warfare. He finally surrendered only after his former commanding officer, <u>Yoshimi Taniguchi</u>, personally traveled to the island to issue the order to stand down.

Onoda initially held out with three other soldiers: one surrendered in 1950, and two were killed, one in 1954 and one in 1972.

[Luk 14:31-33 ESV] 31 Or what king, going out to encounter another king in war, will not sit down first and deliberate whether he is able with ten thousand to meet him who comes against him with twenty thousand? 32 And if not, while the other is yet a great way off, he sends a delegation and asks for terms of peace. 33 So therefore, any one of you who does not renounce all that he has cannot be my disciple.

Hiroo and Shoichi never went back to their caves! They Did regret and lost out on a full life they could've had!

Its about Surrender!! The Empire of Japan/Imperial Japan was long dead and never worthy of such devotion! Emperor Hirohito was considered a god! And

renounced his divinity!

The gospel of Jesus Christ, it's about Him!

- Jesus is sinless, perfect, Holy

Christ was NOT His last Name - Its His descriptor. He is the Messiah!

[Mat 1:1, 16 ESV] 1 The book of the genealogy of Jesus Christ, the son of David, the son of Abraham. ... 16 and Jacob the father of Joseph the husband of <u>Mary</u>, of whom Jesus was <u>born</u>, who is called <u>Christ</u>.

[Mat 16:16, 20 ESV] 16 Simon Peter replied, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." ... 20 Then he strictly charged the disciples to tell no one that he was the Christ.

[Mat 22:42 ESV] 42 saying, "What do you think about the Christ? Whose son is he?" They said to him, "The son of David."

[Mat 23:10 ESV] 10 Neither be called instructors, for <u>you have one instructor</u>, the Christ.

[Jhn 11:27 ESV] 27 She said to him, "Yes, Lord; I believe that you are the Christ, the Son of God, who is coming into the world."

to them, "Then what shall I do with Jesus who is called Christ?" They all said, "Let him be crucified!"

[Mar 8:29 ESV] 29 And he asked them, "But who do you say that I am?" Peter answered him, "You are the Christ."

[Mar 12:35 ESV] 35 And as Jesus taught in the temple, he said, "How can the scribes say that the Christ is the son of David?



Its like Shoichi Yokoi, A Japanese Warrior who surrendered 20+ yrs later

Its like Harry Colcord and Charles Blondin!

The most famous Japanese soldier who hid for years after surrender is Shoichi Yokoi, a sergeant who remained in a cave in Guam for 27 years, finally discovered in 1972. Another prominent soldier was <u>Hiroo Onoda</u>, who refused to surrender and continued fighting in the Philippines for almost 30 years until 1974. Both soldiers were motivated by the Japanese military code of <u>Bushido</u>, which held that death was preferable to the shame of being captured alive.



Look up, Harry ... You are no longer Colcord you are Blondin ... be a part of me, mind, body and soul. If I sway, sway with me. Do not attempt to do any balancing yourself. If you do we will both go to our death.

Blondin died from complications of <u>diabetes</u>
