

YOU ADULTERESSES!!!

Spiritual infidelity is in view here. The OT often saw that Israel's idol worship was adultery, since it was showing covenantal loyalty to something of this creation instead of to the Creator, who was the husband of Israel (e.g., Jer. 3:9; Ezek. 16; 23:37; Hos. 4:13; cf. Rev. 2:20–22). This is illicit spiritual intercourse and thus adultery. To be "a friend of the world" is to be more committed to the "world" than to God and thus to align oneself with the evil world system against God and His people. There is no spiritual neutrality.



BUT...God gives a <u>greater</u> grace
God's grace overcomes unfaithfulness



The only ray of hope in man's spiritual darkness is the sovereign grace of God, which alone can rescue man from his propensity to lust for evil things. That God gives "greater grace" shows that His grace is greater than the power of sin, the flesh, the world, and Satan (cf. Rom 5:20). The OT quote (from Pr 3:34; cf. 1 Pet 5:5) reveals who obtains God's grace -the humble, not the proud enemies of God.
