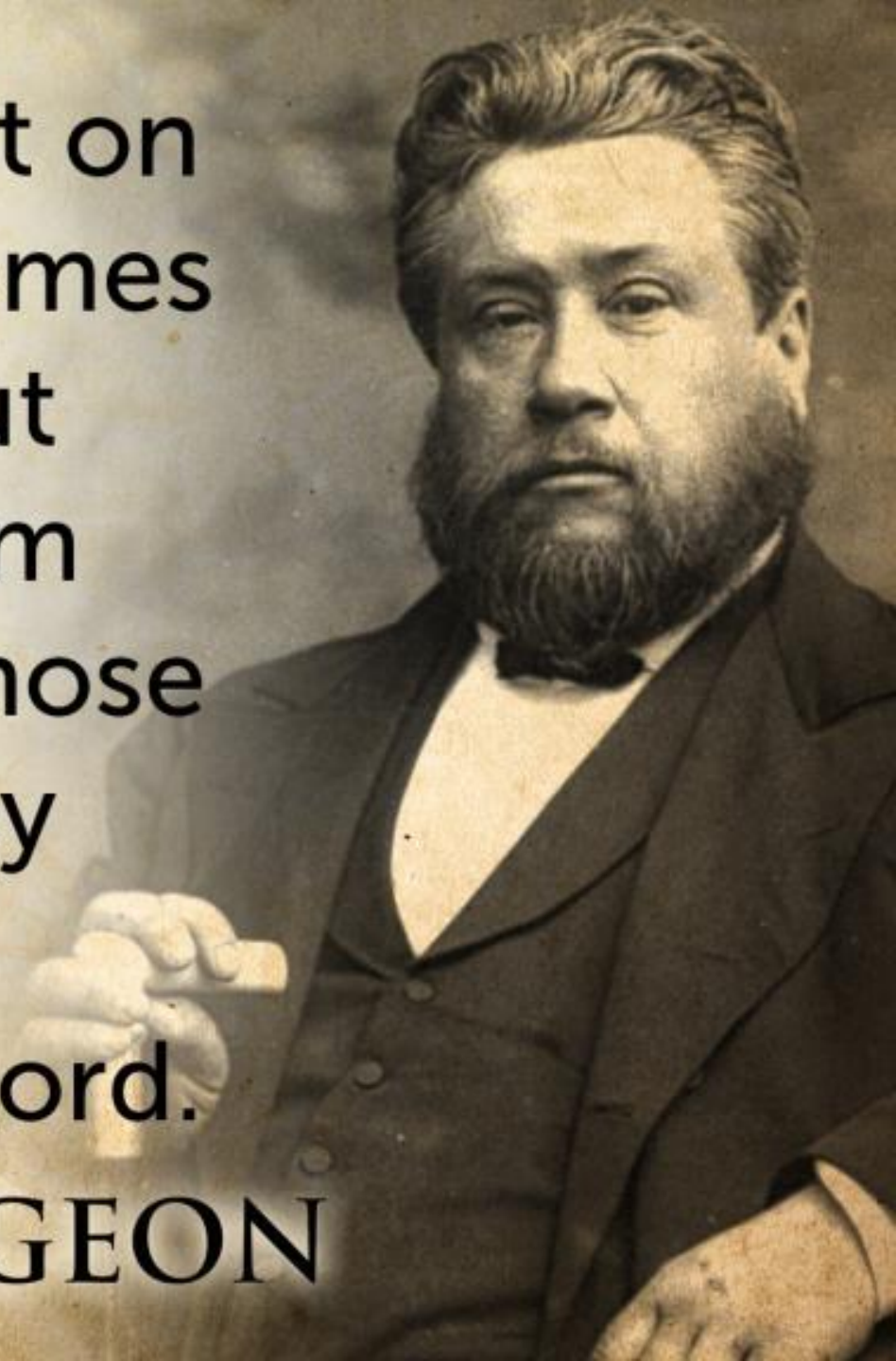
True Joy Made Complete
