# The High Priestly prayer! It is by far the longest prayer of Jesus in any of the gospels.

First, Jesus prays for Himself, then He prays for His disciples, and He closes the prayer by praying for all believers. This intercessory prayer is commonly called Jesus' High Priestly Prayer.


The King ruled but the Prophets spoke to him from God and the priests spoke for him, and the people to God!

[Mar 2:26 how he entered **the house of God in the time of Abiathar [the] high priest**, and ate the consecrated bread, which is not lawful for [anyone] to eat except the priests, and he also gave it to those who were with him?"

One priest was selected as the high priest who would enter the <u>Holy of Holies</u> on the <u>Day of Atonement</u> to offer the sacrifice that would temporarily cover the sins of the people (<u>Hebrews 9:7</u>). When Jesus came, He offered His life as the ultimate sacrifice that would not only cover the sins of the people but completely cleanse His people and save them. Jesus is the ultimate <u>High Priest</u>, and His intercession for us in <u>John 17</u> is a wonderful, multilayered example of His love.

Robert Traill, a seventeenth-century Scots divine, wrote, "<u>The best sermon that was ever preached in the world was followed by the best prayer that was ever offered up in it.</u>" Matthew Henry said that it was "a prayer after sermon, after sacrament, a family prayer, a parting prayer, a preface to his sacrifice... [and] a specimen of his intercession."

#### What many call the Lords prayer was a sample for us

[Mat 6:5-15 NASB20] 5 "And when you pray, you are not to be like the hypocrites; for they love to stand and pray in the synagogues and on the street corners so that they will be seen by people. Truly I say to you, they have their reward in full. 6 "But as for you, when you pray, go into your inner room, close your door, and pray to your Father who is in secret; and your Father who sees [what is done] in secret will reward you. 7 "And when you are praying, do not use thoughtless repetition as the Gentiles do, for they think that they will be heard because of their many words. 8 "So do not be like them; for your Father knows what you need before you ask Him.

9 "Pray, then, in this way: 'Our Father, who is in heaven, Hallowed be Your name. 10 "may" 'Your kingdom come. Your will be done, On earth as it is in heaven. 11 'Give us this day our daily bread. 12 'And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. 13 'And do not lead us into temptation, but deliver us from evil.' 14 "For if you forgive [other] people for their offenses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. 15 "But if you do not forgive [other] people, then your Father will not forgive your offenses.

# The High Priestly Prayer John 17: 1-26 I will remain in the world no longer, but they are still in the world, and I am coming to you. Holy Father, protect them by the power of your name--the name you gave me--so that they may be one as we are one. While I was with them, I protected them and kept them safe by that name you gave me. None has been lost except the one doomed to destruction so that Scripture would be fulfilled. I am coming to you now, but I say these things while I am still in the world, so that they may have the fulf measure of my joy within them. I have given them your word and the world has hated them, for they are not of the world any more than I am of the world. My prayer is not that you take them out of the world but that your word in struck.



[Jhn 11:41 NASB20] 41 So they removed the stone. And Jesus raised His eyes, and said, "Father, I thank You that You have heard Me.

[Psa 121:1-2 NASB20] **1 A Song of Ascents. I will raise my eyes to the mountains;** From where will my help come? **2 My help [comes] from the LORD, Who made heaven and earth.**

John largely replaces Jesus' prayer Mt.26 after the last supper to the corporate prayer (ch.17), before they cross the Kidron

#### The hour

[Jhn 7:30 NASB20] 30 So they were seeking to arrest Him; and [yet] no one laid a hand on Him, because His hour had not yet come.

[Jhn 8:20 NASB20] 20 These words He spoke in the treasury, as He taught in the temple [area;] and **no one arrested Him, because His hour had not yet come**.

[Jhn 12:23, 27-28 NASB20] 23 But Jesus answered them by saying, "The hour has come for the Son of Man to be glorified. ... 27 "Now My soul has become troubled; and what am I to say? 'Father, save Me from this hour'? But for this purpose I came to this hour. 28 "Father, glorify Your name." Then a voice came out of heaven: "I have both glorified [it,] and will glorify [it] again."

[Jhn 13:1 NASB20] 1 Now before the Feast of the Passover, Jesus, knowing that His hour had come that He would depart from this world to the Father, having loved

His own who were in the world, He loved them to the end.

[Jhn 16:32 NASB20] 32 "Behold, an hour is coming, and has [already] come, for you to be scattered, each to his own [home,] and to leave Me alone; and [yet] I am not alone, because the Father is with Me.

[Mar 14:41 NASB20] 41 And He came the third time, and said to them, "Are you still sleeping and resting? That is enough. **The hour has come; behold, the Son of Man is being betrayed into the hands of sinners**.

[Luk 22:53 NASB20] 53 "While I was with you daily in the temple, you did not lay hands on Me; but this hour and the power of darkness are yours."


Time and again during his earthly life, Jesus had been aware that this hour had not come. Twice he resisted family pressure on the matter (2:4; 7:1–8), and twice he was protected from the evil intention of his foes because of that fact (7:30; 8:20). But two harbingers of it had just crossed his path, and each was a portent of death and glory to him. On the one hand, some Greek-speaking Jews had come to the Passover from Galilee and wanted to see him—a foretaste of the Gentile harvest (12:20–33) that would result from his death. On the other hand, the traitor Judas Iscariot had left the Upper Room to bring it about (13:31). Both events convinced him of the imminence of the hour, and he spoke accordingly to his disciples. It was at one and the same time the hour of glory and of "the power of darkness" (Luke 22:53). It coincided with "the cup" of the cross (Mark 14:35) on the way to the crown. So he said, "Now is the Son of man glorified, and God is glorified in him" (13:31). "The hour" is therefore fraught with great significance and consequences—on earth and in heaven, for the world and for hell.

[Mat 26:36-46 NASB20] 36 Then Jesus came with them to a place called Gethsemane, and told His disciples, "Sit here while I go over there and pray." 37 And He took Peter and the two sons of Zebedee with Him, and began to be grieved and distressed. 38 Then He said to them, "My soul is deeply grieved, to the point of death; remain here and keep watch with Me." 39 And He went a little beyond [them,] and fell on His face and prayed, saying, "My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from Me; yet not as I will, but as You [will.]" 40 And He came to the disciples and found them sleeping, and He said to Peter, "So, you [men] could not keep watch with Me for one hour? 41 "Keep watching and praying, so that you do not come into temptation; the spirit is willing, but the flesh is weak." 42 He went away again a second time and prayed, saying, "My Father, if this [cup] cannot pass away unless I drink [from] it, Your will be done." 43 Again He came and found them sleeping, for their eyes were heavy. 44 And He left them again, and went away and prayed a third time, saying the same thing once more. 45 Then He came to the disciples and said to them, "Are you still sleeping and resting? Behold, the hour is at hand and the Son of Man is being betrayed into the hands of

sinners. 46 "Get up, let's go; behold, the one who is betraying Me is near!"

Disciple's were warned to watch and pray, 3x!!! Each time Jesus found them sleeping when HE returned!

Darkness gets an Hour The Lord gets a Day! Which will never end!!



[Jhn 17:3 NASB20] 3 "And this is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent.

His love, the party will never end! Imagine the very best moment of your life...and it never ends1

Eternal life is not merely length of time, which under most circumstances would become monotonous and torturous

[1Co 15:34 NASB20] 34 Sober up morally and stop sinning, for some have no knowledge of God. I say [this] to your shame.

[Psa 63:3 ESV] 3 <u>Because your steadfast love is better than life</u>, my lips will praise you.

[Psa 4:6 NASB20] 6 Many are saying, "Who will show us [anything] good?" Lift up the light of Your face upon us, LORD!

[Psa 21:6 NASB20] **6 For You make him most blessed forever; You make him joyful with the joy of Your presence**.

[Psa 30:5 NASB20] 5 For His anger is but for a moment, **His favor is for a lifetime**; Weeping may last for the night, But a shout of joy [comes] in the morning.


[Phl 1:23 NASB20] 23 But I am hard-pressed from both [directions,] having the desire to depart and be with Christ, for [that] is very much better;

Those born once will die twice! And those born twice (born again) will only die once!

[Rev 20:14 NASB20] 14 Then Death and Hades were thrown into the lake of fire. This is the second death, the lake of fire.

#### His love never ends!!!

[1Co 13:7 NASB20] 7 it keeps every confidence, it believes all things, hopes all things, **endures all things**.

### 3 specific things Jesus prayed for us!

Jhn 17:15, 17, 21 15 "I am not asking You to take them out of the world, but to keep them away from the evil one. ...

17 "Sanctify them in the truth; Your word is truth. ...

Jhn 17:21 **that they may all be one**; just as You, Father, [are] in Me and I in You, that they also may be in Us, so that the world may believe that You sent Me.

Jhn 17:22 "The glory which You have given Me I also have given to them, **so that they may be one, just as We are one**;


Jhn 17:23 <u>I in them and You in Me, that they may be perfected in unity</u>, so that the world may know that You sent Me, and You loved them, just as You loved Me.

Notice the 1<sup>st</sup> prayer includes not taking them out of the world! Paul must've been disappointed

Notice the 2<sup>nd</sup> is answered with the written word!, thy word is truth! Notice the 3<sup>rd</sup> mirrors the unhindered intimacy of the trinity!

[Jhn 17:20 NASB20] 20 "I am not asking on behalf of these alone, but also for those

who believe in Me through their word,

# The face of the Lord is against!

[1Pe 3:12 NASB20] 12 "FOR THE EYES OF THE LORD ARE TOWARD THE RIGHTEOUS, AND HIS EARS ATTEND TO THEIR PRAYER, BUT THE FACE OF THE LORD IS AGAINST EVILDOERS."

[<u>Pro 15:8, 29</u> NASB20] 8 The sacrifice of the wicked is an abomination to the LORD, But the prayer of the upright is His delight. ... 29 <u>The LORD is far from the wicked</u>, <u>But He hears the prayer of the righteous</u>.

[Jhn 9:31 NASB20] 31 "We know that God does not listen to sinners; but if someone is God-fearing and does His will, He listens to him.

[Jas 5:16 NASB20] 16 Therefore, confess your sins to one another, and pray for one another so that you may be healed. A prayer of a righteous person, when it is brought about, can accomplish much.

[Lev 17:10 NASB20] 10 'And anyone from the house of Israel, or from the strangers who reside among them, **who eats any blood**, **I will set My face against that person who eats the blood**, and will cut him off from among his people.

[Ihn 17:1] NASB20] 1 Jesus spoke these things; and raising His eyes to heaven, He said, "Father, the hour has come; glorify Your Son, so that the Son may glorify You, [Ihn 17:22, 24 NASB20] 22 "The glory which You have given Me I also have given to them, so that they may be one, just as We are one; ... 24 "Father, I desire that they also, whom You have given Me, be with Me where I am, so that they may see My glory which You have given Me, for You loved Me before the foundation of the world.

So what does this amount to with reference to his request? Jesus (the man) prays that through all the shame and horror of Gethsemane to Golgotha, the Father will reveal him magnificently in his true messianic divinity. As his ever-true incarnate Son who could not and would not think, speak, or act independently of him (see 5:19), Jesus declares that he is determined to reveal the Father as the only true God by accomplishing what he has been sent to do on earth—and in his mind and spirit, it is as good as done. On that basis, all that Jesus asks for in relation to himself is that the Father will be true to him, attesting him as his "Christ" to all the elect, and exalting him, now incarnate, to his immediate presence by way of resurrection and ascension.
