the form Yahweh is now accepted almost universally, though the vocalization Jehovah continues to have wide usage.[3][4][5]


most scholars point to YHWH first appearing in the Bible when God manifests Himself to Moses in the burning bush (Exodus 3). 33:19, 34:5

Prior to Exodus 3, the Israelites called their god Elohim or El – is a title, not a personal name – or "El Shaddai," often translated as God Almighty.

ELOHIM [el-oh-heem]: God "Creator, Mighty and Strong" (Genesis 17:7; Jeremiah 31:33) – the plural form of Eloah. Being plural, Elohim which accommodates the doctrine of the Trinity. From the Bible's first sentence, the superlative nature of God's power is evident as God (Elohim) speaks the world into existence (Genesis 1:1).

Theological anthropomorphisms

- Genesis 6:6 So the LORD was <u>sorry</u>, that He had made mankind on the earth, and He was <u>grieved in His heart</u>.
- "And it <u>repented</u> the Lord" (KJV), <u>regretted</u> (NIV)

Does God really suffer? Does He have a box of Tissues on his desk?

Some translations say God repents? Really? Did He sin or make a bad decision? Does He change His mind? Ever?

Some people refer to ships as Her, She or women, Disney uses anthropomorphisms all the time

We use these anthropomorphisms to help us relate to God, make Him a little more understandable

God doesn't Have a heart per se, but we sadden Him. and we cannot cause God to cry a tear or become depressed. He doesn't literally forget our sins BUT He will not bring them up to us and as far as HE is concerned He considers them paid for/resolved...

These verses are there to remind us we have offended the Almighty! The Sovereign of the Universe! God Knew we would sin, His longsuffering has been exhausted and our rebellion leaves Him with no choice but to dela with us as we deserve!

We know that God is "spirit," meaning that God doesn't have a physical body as we do. And yet God Himself speaks of redeeming His people "with outstretched arm." Scripture also speaks of God's "hand," His "face," His "eyes," His "ears"—and even refers to His feet.

Scripture also anthropomorphizes God when it talks about Him "remembering" Rachel or "relenting" from bringing judgment when Moses implores Him to do so.

How can an all-knowing God "remember" Rachel if it was impossible for Him to forget her in the first place? And how can an all-knowing God "change his mind" about bringing judgment, as if Moses had presented some new information to Him He didn't already know? Similarly, why would an all-seeing God have to ask "Where are you?" as He does of Adam in Genesis chapter 1?

The answer to these questions is that God is relating to His people by describing Himself with anthropomorphic language. He does so because, knowing the limitations of our minds and imaginations, He nevertheless wants us to know Him, so He speaks in terms which are intuitive and natural to us.

The word anthropomorphism comes from the Greek anthrō, meaning "human," and morphē, meaning "form": human form. Both those words appear in Philippians chapter 2, verses 6 and 7, which describe—if I can put it this way—the ultimate anthropomorphism. It says:

Though [Christ] was in the form [morphē] of God, [He] did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied Himself, by taking the form [morphē] of a servant, being born in the likeness of men [anthrōpos].

In several places in the Bible, God is described as having the physical attributes of man. He "sets [his] face" against evil (Leviticus 20:6); the Lord will make "His face" to shine on you (Numbers 6:25); He "stretched out his hand" (Exodus 7:5; Isaiah 23:11), and God scattered enemies with His strong arm (Psalm 89:10). He "stoops

down to look on the heavens and the earth" (Psalm 113:6). He "keeps his eye" on the land (Deuteronomy 11:12), the "eyes of the Lord" are on the righteous (Psalm 34:15), and the earth is His "footstool" (Isaiah 66:1). Do all these verses mean that God literally has eyes, a face, hands and feet? Not necessarily. God is spirit, not flesh and blood, but because we are not spirit, these anthropomorphisms help us to understand God's nature and actions.

Human emotions are also ascribed to God: He was "sorry" (Genesis 6:6), "jealous" (Exodus 20:5), "moved to pity" (Judges 2:18), and "grieved" over making Saul Israel's first king (1 Samuel 15:35). We read that the Lord "changed His mind" (Exodus 32:14), "relented" (2 Samuel 24:16), and will "remember" when He sees a rainbow in the sky (Genesis 9:16). God is "angry with the wicked every day" (Psalm 7:11), and He "burned with anger" against Job's friends (Job 32:5). Most precious to us is God's love, in which He predestines us to salvation (Ephesians 1:4-5) and because of which He gave His only Son in order to save the world (John 3:16).

[1Sa 15:11, 29, 35 NASB20] 11 "I regret[H5162] that I have made Saul king, because he has turned back from following Me and has not carried out My commands." 





Legends have been reported from nations such as China, Babylon, Mexico, Egypt, Sudan, Syria, Persia, India, Norway, Wales, Ireland, Indonesia, Romania, etc.—composing a list that could go on for many pages (see Perloff, 1999, p. 167). Although the vast number of such legends is surprising, the similarity between much of their content is equally amazing. James Perloff noted:

In 95 percent of the more than two hundred flood legends, the flood was worldwide; in 88 percent, a certain family was favored; in 70 percent, survival was by means of a boat; in 67 percent, animals were also saved; in 66 percent, the flood was due to the wickedness of man; in 66 percent, the survivors had been forewarned; in 57 percent, they ended up on a mountain; in 35 percent, birds were sent out from the boat; and in 9 percent, exactly eight people were spared (p. 168).





Lesson One

The volcanic blast of May 18, 1980, traveling at an initial speed of over 650 miles per hour (300 m/sec.), destroyed the forests in at least the surrounding 150 square miles (390 sq. km) within six minutes!2,3,4,5 Douglas firs as tall as 200 feet (61 m) were instantly stripped of their branches and snapped like toothpicks.

As the side of the volcano slid into the nearby Spirit Lake, it pushed a wave of water from the lake into the nearby forest, dragging many logs back into the lake as the surge returned. By late afternoon over one million logs were floating on the lake. Many were floating upright. Even though the roots were broken off, the bases were still thicker and denser, causing the logs to float this way.

Many logs subsequently sank to the floor of the lake, still upright but rootless. Indeed, it was estimated that about 20,000 upright, fully submerged logs were sitting on the floor of the lake by August 1985. They looked like a forest of trees buried in mud. Radar and scuba divers found that many logs had become buried

by more than 3 feet (1 m) of sediment, while others were still resting on the floor of the lake.6,7

The rock was a mere ten years old, but the potassium-argon "clock" dated the rock at 350,000 years old, and minerals within the rock dated at up to 2.4 million years old.14



EVIDENCE FOR A WORLD WIDE FLOOD



Fossil of Fish Swallowing Fish. Burial and fossilization must have been quite rapid to have preserved a fish in the act of swallowing another fish. Thousands of such fossils have been found.

Rapid Burial

Fossils all over the world show evidence of rapid burial. Many fossils, such as fossilized jellyfish, show by the details of their soft, fleshy portions that they were buried rapidly, before they could decay. (Normally, dead animals and plants quickly decompose.) The presence of fossilized remains of many other animals, buried in mass graves and lying in twisted and contorted positions, suggests violent and rapid burials over large areas. These observations, together with the occurrence of compressed fossils and fossils that cut across two or more layers of sedimentary rock, are strong evidence that the sediments encasing these fossils were deposited rapidly—not over hundreds of millions of years. Furthermore, almost all sediments that formed today's rocks were sorted by water. The worldwide fossil record is, therefore, evidence of rapid death and burial of animal and plant life by a worldwide, catastrophic flood. The fossil record is not evidence of slow change



The researchers discovered 38 tracks, some of which were four feet long (now that's one big dinosaur!), 166–168 million years old.





Similarly, why would Noah need to take animals on board the ark from his local area, when other representatives of those same animal kinds would surely have survived in other, unflooded areas?

Naoh could've traveled – he had 120 years!

Abraham traversed hundreds of miles to promised land

Moses and all Israel traversed from Egypt to promised land

Think of the size of the Ark! 300 cubits long, 50 cubits wide, and 30 cubits high, or approximately 450 feet long, 75 feet wide, and 45 feet high? With these dimensions, the total volume of the ark would have been approximately 1.45 million cubic feet, and with three decks it would have had a total deck area of approximately 98,800 square feet, equivalent to slightly more than the area of 20 standard basketball courts! The gross tonnage of the ark would have been about 14,500 tons, well within the category of large metal ocean-going vessels today

The early church, before Darwin, took the scripture literally and pretty much all believed in the Literal creation and Flood

Even the renowned and theologically liberal Hebrew scholar James Barr, then Oriel Professor of the Interpretation of Holy Scripture at Oxford University in England, was prepared to admit in a letter to David C.C. Watson dated April 23, 1984:

... so far as I know, there is no Professor of Hebrew or Old Testament at any world-class university who does not believe that the writer(s) of Genesis 1–11 intended to convey to their readers the ideas that ... Noah's Flood was understood to be world-wide and extinguish all human and animal life except for those in the Ark. Or to put it negatively, the apologetic arguments which suppose ... the flood to be a merely local Mesopotamian flood are not taken seriously by any such Professors, as far as I know.6

The landslide took rock and debris "uncorking" the top of the shallow lava dome releasing the pressurized body of magma allowing it to explode violently to the north. The lateral blast caused a horizontally directed explosion of incredible magnitude. The expanding cloud of rock, ash and gases moved hundred miles per hour destroying 230 square miles, killing every living thing and destroying hundreds of acres of virgin forest. The landslide temporarily displaced all the water in Spirit Lake sending 600-foot-high waves crashing into a ridge north of the lake, adding 295 feet of new avalanche debris above the old lakebed, and raising its surface level by about 200 feet.








Figure 2a and 2e from Vannier et al., 2019 showing linear clusters of raphiophorid trilobites.
