Trinity =
The expression of the Trinity = The Father, The Son (Jesus Christ), and the Holy Spirit
The New Testament writers do not create the doctrine of the Trinity, they articulate what was already understood.
Despite the fact that the word "trinity" is not found in Scripture, we see strong evidence of the triune nature of God throughout Scripture:
The Trinity is present at creation (Genesis 1, John 1)
The Trinity is present or prophesied about in in the Old Testament
The Trinity is present in Jesus' birth narrative (Luke 1)
The Trinity is present at Jesus' baptism (Matt. 3:16-17)
The Trinity is present in Jesus' teaching (Luke 4:18-19)
The Trinity is present in Jesus' actions (i.e. Matt. 12:28)
The Trinity is present at the end of Jesus' life (John 13-17)
The Trinity is present in Jesus' instructions to His disciples (Matt. 28:19-20)
The Trinity is present at the beginning of the church (Acts 2:32-33, 38-39)
The Trinity is present in the teaching of the early church (1 Peter 1:1-2)
Implication: God is not a transformer - we reject
