

Discern the day Genesis 22:4 (NKJV)

4 Then on the third day Abraham lifted his eyes and saw the place afar off.

Abraham feared the Lord and lifted up his eyes to see the place that God had chosen for his offering on the third day. Those who have the fear of the Lord discern the times and the seasons of God. The third day speaks of a time and a season or an appointed day and time. This is a "kairos" or a an opportune time in God. We must not miss God's opportune or set time.

Pray:

- 1. For discernment to perceive the seasons of God
- That our eyes would be lifted up to see God's time for our lives
- 3. That we would not let the distractions of our earthly existence cause us to miss God's set time

Discern the messenger

John 1:6-7 (NKJV) 6 There was a man sent from God, whose name was John. 7 This man came for a witness, to bear witness of the Light, that all through him might believe.

New seasons in God are announced by messengers that God sends. They bring a message of God's present demands for His kingdom to be established. Messengers prepare the way for our entrance into a new season. We must be discerning of those whom God sends.

Pray:

- 1. That we would discern messengers that are sent from God.
- **2.** For entrance into God's new season when we hear and obey the word of God
- 3. That we would not see messengers naturally but spiritually

Discern the environment

John 1:51 - 2:1 (NKJV) 1 On the third day there was a wedding in Cana of Galilee, and the mother of Jesus was there.

On the third day Jesus and His disciples were in a wedding environment. This is an environment of covenant and dwelling together. The fear of the Lord makes us discerning of environments that are built on strong covenants. Such a place becomes a command center for God's blessing which is "life forever more" (Ps 133). We must stay or dwell in such environments.

Pray:

- **1.** For discernment of covenant environments
- **2.** That we would not be led astray through immaturity
- **3.** For godly fear to govern where we stay and dwell

Discern the culture

Acts 2:42-43 (NKJV) 42 And they continued steadfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, in the breaking of bread, and in prayers. 43 Then fear came upon every soul, and many wonders and signs were done through the apostles.

A new season is established upon a certain culture. The early church entered the kingdom of God and was established on a culture of doctrine, fellowship, breaking of bread and prayers. Such a culture brings reverential fear.

Pray:

- For apostolic culture to establish us in the faith
- 2. That we would let the culture craft an environment of godly fear.
- 3. That we would be steadfast in keeping the culture of the kingdom in our homes.

Discern the economy

Acts 2:45 (NKJV) 45 and sold their possessions and goods, and divided them among all, as anyone had need.

The early church had entered a new season which led to a new economy. They became selfless and generous so that no one had any needs among them. A new season brings a new economy that would bring us to a place having no lack but having abundance. We must discern God's economy in His set time.

Pray:

- 1. That we would discern the economy of God
- **2.** For grace to become a generous giver
- 3. That we would not fear times of hardship but fear God and hold onto the principles of His economy

Discern His Body

Acts 2:44 (NKJV)

44 Now all who believed were together, and had all things in common,

The Body of Christ is universal. We must be discerning of those who believe and be together with such people. In a new season our eyes open to those who are not a part of the Body of Christ but are just crowd mongers and god haters. The fear of the Lord makes us discerning of those who have perceived God's set time.

Pray:

- 1. That we would discern the lawless in the Body of Christ
- **2.** For greater awareness of the god hater whose eyes have been shut to God's set time
- 3. That we would come together and join those whose spirit has discerned the present demands of the Lord.
