Approach

Luke 10:34

34 So he WENT to him and bandaged his wounds, pouring on oil and wine; and he set him on his own animal, brought him to an inn, and took care of him.

The Samaritan went to the man that was stripped and wounded. Just as Jesus came to us we must go into the world that is without God. We each have a responsibility to share our faith with those who are perishing in sin.

Pray:

- 1. That as good neighbors we would share the good news
- **2.** For friends and family that need Christ
- 3. That we would change our approach in how we share the gospel with others

Bandage the wounds

Luke 10:34

34 So he went to him and BANDAGED his wounds, pouring on oil and wine; and he set him on his own animal, brought him to an inn, and took care of him.

The man was already in a wounded state and there is no need to wound him more by pointing out his sins and failures. We bandage others by sharing the truth and showing them the love of Christ.

Pray:

- 1. That we would be merciful to the wounded
- **2.** For truth to set people free from sin
- **3.** That Christ's love would be seen in us

Pour oil and wine

Luke 10:34 (NKJV)

34 So he went to him and bandaged his wounds, POURING on oil and wine; and he set him on his own animal, brought him to an inn, and took care of him.

Oil and wine are both symbols of the Holy Spirit. We cannot witness to people, it the Holy Spirit within us that is poured from us that brings people to repentance. It is the Holy Spirit who teaches us what to say and what to do

Pray:

- 1. That the Holy Spirit would pour out of our lives
- **2.** For the Holy Spirit to convict the world of sin
- 3. That the Holy Spirit would lead us each day

Set him on his own animal

Luke 10:34

34 So he went to him and bandaged his wounds, pouring on oil and wine; and he SET him on his own animal, brought him to an inn, and took care of him.

The Samaritan used his own animal to transport the wounded man to safety. Resources are essential to display the love of God. We each have resources that can be used to be good neighbors to the unregenerate man.

Pray:

- **1.** For our resources to be a blessing to others
- **2.** That we would use our resources to display God's love
- 3. For our resources to reflect the kingdom of God

Took care

Luke 10:34

34 So he went to him and bandaged his wounds, pouring on oil and wine; and he set him on his own animal, brought him to an inn, and TOOK CARE of him.

Most people are interested in their own well being and safety. Good neighbors take care of one another. Under the law the Israelites were instructed to take care of the orphan, the widow and the stranger. The royal law of love requires the same of us, only to do it without any need for recognition.

Pray:

- 1. That we would do all for the glory of God
- **2.** For our care to flourish in seeing to the needs of others
- 3. That as we care for others Christ would be revealed to them

Paid the debt

Luke 10:35 On the next day, when he departed, he took out two denarii, gave them to the innkeeper, and said to him, 'Take care of him; and whatever more you spend, when I come again, I will repay you.'

The Samaritan paid the debt for the wounded man. Christ was wounded for our transgressions and gave Himself as ransom for sinful man (1 Tim2:5-6). The debt of sin was paid in full by Christ. As sons of God we must remind others of the price Jesus Christ paid for us

Pray:

- 1. That the world will know the price Christ has paid for them
- **2.** For Christs ransom to set us free from the debt of sin
- **3.** That we would be a testimony of Christ's sacrifice
