Deuteronomy 8:2 And you shall remember that the LORD your God LED YOU all the way these forty years in the WILDERNESS, to humble you and test you, to know what was in your heart, whether you would keep His commandments or not.

The wilderness is a place of formation. God leads through the wilderness for specific reasons. Jesus was led into the wilderness by the Spirit and He was tempted by the devil. God is leading us all through our formation.

Pray:

1. That we would let our wilderness have its perfect work done in our lives
2. For faith to believe that God is leading us in our wilderness
3. That we would not rebel but yield to God's will

Humble

Deuteronomy 8:2 And you shall remember that the LORD your God LED YOU all the way these forty years in the WILDERNESS, to HUMBLE you and test you, to know what was in your heart, whether you would keep His commandments or not.

God leads us through the wilderness to humble us or bring us to a place of submitting to His will. Egypt makes us proud and lofty but the wilderness humbles us.

Pray:

1. That our wilderness will remove pride from us
2. For humility and brokenness to bring deliverance from our wilderness
3. That as we humble ourselves God will lift us up

Test

Deuteronomy 8:2 And you shall remember that the LORD your God LED YOU all the way these forty years in the WILDERNESS, to HUMBLE you and TEST you, to know what was in your heart, whether you would keep His commandments or not.

We have written tests on many occasions to qualify or be approved academically and practically. The test of the wilderness approves our faith in the Lord. It proves the genuineness of our faith.

Pray:

1. That the test of the wilderness will approve our faith in the Lord
2. For grace to handle the test of faith
3. That the test of faith will mature us in Christ

Heart

Deuteronomy 8:2 And you shall remember that the LORD your God LED YOU all the way these forty years in the WILDERNESS, to HUMBLE you and TEST you, to know what was in your HEART, whether you would keep His commandments or not.

The heart is deceitful above all things. Like King Amaziah, we can do the right thing yet not with loyal heart (2 Chron 25:2). God tests what is in our hearts by putting us through the wilderness.

Pray:

1. That we will do what is right but with a loyal heart
2. For our heart to remain pure before the Lord
3. That the test of faith will remove impurities in our heart

Obedience

Deuteronomy 8:2 And you shall remember that the LORD your God LED YOU all the way these forty years in the WILDERNESS, to HUMBLE you and TEST you, to know what was in your HEART, whether you would KEEP His commandments or not.

The wilderness tests if we can remain obedient to the word of God. When we are betrayed can we forgive, can we love unconditionally, can we love our enemies and bless those who curse us? Do we still tithe in the time of financial wilderness?

Pray:

1. That we would remain obedient to the word even in our wilderness
2. For the word of God to bring us through our wilderness
3. That our obedience will turn our wilderness into springs of water

Proceeding word

Deuteronomy 8:3 So He humbled you, allowed you to hunger, and fed you with manna which you did not know nor did your fathers know, that He might make you know that man shall not live by bread alone; but man lives by every word that PROCEEDS from the mouth of the LORD.

The wilderness teaches us what to live on. While we need earthly provision, our divine provision is found in the proceeding word. It is the proceeding word that determines our earthly provision.

Pray:

1. That we will learn to live by the the proceeding word
2. That our earthly provision will be determined by the divine provision of manna from heaven
3. That our wilderness will cause us to rely more on God's word
