Ruth 2:2 (NKJV)

2 So Ruth the Moabite said to Naomi, "Please let me go to the field, and glean heads of grain after him in whose sight I may find favor." And she said to her, "GO, my daughter."

Ruth was a young widow in a foreign land. As a young woman she understood the need to be sent or to receive the blessing of her elder. Young people must understand the importance of being sent.

Pray:

1. For our generation to understand the importance of receiving the blessing of elders
2. That this generation would live by the principle of honor
3. For good success and long life to a generation that shows honor

Glean

Ruth 2:3 (NKJV)

3 Then she left, and went and GLEANED in the field after the reapers. And she happened to come to the part of the field belonging to Boaz, who was of the family of Elimelech.

Ruth went into the field to glean grain. This is to pick grain that has fallen. Young people must glean from reapers, meaning to learn, to gather or collect wisdom from experienced people. This is called walking with the wise.

Pray:

1. For young people to glean wisdom from others
2. That this generation would walk with the wise
3. For humility in wanting to learn from others

Work Ethic

Ruth 2:6-7 (NKJV)

7 And she said, 'Please let me glean and gather after the reapers among the sheaves.' So she came and has continued from morning until now, though she rested a little in the house."

Ruth had a high work ethic. She was gleaning from morning and only rested a little. We must raise a generation who have a high work ethic. A lazy and slothful generation only lives of the previous generation.

Pray:

1. That we would raise a generation of workers and thinkers
2. For parents to create a culture of work and not laziness
3. That young people would realize the need to have a high work ethic

Focused

Ruth 2:9 (NKJV)

9 Let your eyes be on the field which they reap, and go after them. Have I not commanded the young men not to touch you? And when you are thirsty, go to the vessels and drink from what the young men have drawn."

Boaz told Ruth to let her eyes be on the field. This is called staying focused. We must have a generation that is focused and not double minded. Many young people are wanderers because they are not focused.

Pray:

1. For this generation to be focused so that they can succeed
2. That the distractions of worldliness would not deter young people from their purpose
3. For this generation to focus on their divine mandate

Humility

Ruth 2:10 (NKJV)

10 So she fell on her face, bowed down to the ground, and said to him, "Why have I found favor in your eyes, that you should take notice of me, since I am a foreigner?"

Ruth bowed down before Boaz as a symbol of gratitude and humility. We must raise a generation that learns how to humble themselves. It is in brokenness and humility that one is exalted or lifted up. Jesus humbled Himself before John the Baptist and the heavens were opened over Him.

Pray:

1. For the fruit of humility to be grown in our young people
2. That as young people humble themselves, God would lift them up
3. For a contrite heart to be seen in this generation

Favor

Ruth 2:13 (NKJV)

13 Then she said, "Let me find favor in your sight, my lord; for you have comforted me, and have spoken kindly to your maidservant, though I am not like one of your maidservants."

This generation must understand how to attract favor into their lives. Favor is an unfair advantage that comes from God. We need a generation that values the grace of God and knows how to access and multiply grace in their lives.

Pray:

1. That young people would value and access grace
2. For a mindset to pursue grace
3. That favor would make this generation effective and productive
