Certain man

Luke 10:30

30 Then Jesus answered and said: "A CERTAIN MAN went down from Jerusalem to Jericho, and fell among thieves, who stripped him of his clothing, wounded him, and departed, leaving him half dead.

A certain man can be viewed from different angles. This man is a representation of mankind that is stripped and half dead in trespasses and sin. This man is the unregenerate man or an unsaved man. We are called to witness to such a man.

Fallen System of the world

Luke 10:30

30 Then Jesus answered and said: "A certain man went down from Jerusalem to Jericho, and FELL among thieves, who stripped him of his clothing, wounded him, and departed, leaving him half dead. The man became a victim of thieves who stripped him of his clothes, wounded him and left him half dead. The system of the world is under the sway of the wicked one to steal, kill and destroy. We are not of this world.

Pray:

- 1. That mankind would be saved from the system of this world
- **2.** For the ruler of this world to be cast down
- **3.** That we would not be lovers of this world

Down

Luke 10:30

30 Then Jesus answered and said: "A certain man went DOWN from Jerusalem to Jericho, and fell among thieves, who stripped him of his clothing, wounded him, and departed, leaving him half dead.

This man was going down from Jerusalem to Jericho. These locations figuratively represent spirit and flesh. The man was moving from a God consciousness to man centered conscience. This is called humanism or reliance on self.

Pray:

- 1. That we would remain in a God conscience state
- **2.** For grace to overcome self reliance
- 3. That we would walk in the spirit and not the flesh

Priest

Luke 10:31

31 Now by chance a certain PRIEST came down that road. And when he saw him, he passed by on the other side.

The priest is a symbol of religious authority that presides over traditional and ritualistic practices. When he saw the man in his fallen state he walked on the other side. Fallen man cannot be saved or helped by religious practices. Religion preys on the mystical and mythical mind but it cannot save.

Pray:

- **1.** For a shift from a religious mindset
- 2. That fallen man would realize that religion cannot save
- **3.** For Christ the High Priest to visit fallen man

Levite

Luke 10:32

32 Likewise a LEVITE, when he arrived at the place, came and looked, and passed by on the other side.

The Levite served in the tabernacle under the priesthood. Their functions was based on duties that was carried out in the tabernacle. This is religion that is bound by duty that enslaves. Christ came to set us free so that we can serve God as sons and not as slaves. Religion enslaves mankind but relationship with God sets them free.

Pray:

- 1. That we would not be enslaved to religion
- 2. For freedom in serving God as our Father
- 3. That mankind would know God as Father

Samaritan

Luke 10:33

33 But a certain SAMARITAN, as he journeyed, came where he was. And when he saw him, he had compassion.

The Samaritans were a mixed breed and a rejected people. Christ came in the form of man as a Jew but His own did not receive Him. They rejected Him because He was a neighbor to the outcast and the despised. He had compassion because He could identify with the pain of the wounded man.

Pray:

- 1. That like the Samaritan we would come to where people are
- 2. For a willingness to identify with mans fallen state
- **3.** That we would be filled with compassion for this world
