

Prayer

Acts 12:5 (NKJV)

5 Peter was therefore kept in prison, but constant prayer was offered to God for him by the church.

The Apostle Peter was imprisoned for preaching the gospel of the kingdom. He was destined to be executed but constant prayer was being made for his release. In this prayer meeting was a young girl by the name of Rhoda. We must have a generation that is part of corporate prayer that learn how to seek the Lord.

Pray:

- 1. That young people would be part of corporate prayer
- 2. For young people to value the importance of seeking God personally and corporately
- **3.** For our generation to receive impartation in corporate gatherings

House of Mary Acts 12:12 (NKIV)

12 So, when he had considered this, he came to the house of Mary, the mother of John whose surname was Mark, where many were gathered together praying. Rhoda was serving in the house of Mary whose was the mother of John Mark. John Mark would later travel with Paul and Barnabas and later become useful to Paul. Young people must be associated with and be part of an apostolic company that is influencing cities and nations. Their involvement would lead to their purpose.

Pray:

- 1. That young people would be associated with apostolic work in nations
- **2.** For young people to desire kingdom advancement in cities
- **3.** That this generation would be useful to apostles

Recognize the voice

Acts 12:14 (NKJV)

14 When she recognized Peter's voice

Peter was the voice of a new season that had dawned upon the world. Rhoda immediately recognized his voice. We must have a generation that is able to perceive, discern and connect with the present demand of God. They must recognize the voice of God in the voice of the one sent by God. Young people must discern between the false and the true so that they can grow in the Lord.

Pray:

- 1. For this generation to recognize the voice of God
- 2. That young people would connect with authentic voices that pronounce the present demand of God
- 3. That young people would be more discening

Open the gate

Acts 12:14 (NKJV)

14 When she recognized Peter's voice, because of her gladness she did not open the gate, but ran in and announced that Peter stood before the gate.

Rhoda was so excited when she recognized Peters voice that she did not open the gate to let Peter come inside. There are many that get excited when the hear the voice of one sent by God but they don't open the gate. Young people must not only get excited about what they hear but must open up their hearts.

Pray:

- 1. For young people to go past excitement and learn to open their hearts
- **2.** For this generation to be open to new things in the spirit
- 3. That young people would be open to the word of God

Insistent

Acts 12:15 (NKJV)

15 But they said to her, "You are beside yourself!" Yet she kept insisting that it was so. So they said, "It is his angel."

When Rhoda told the the gathering that Peter was outside they did not believe and also did not believe that their prayers were answered. Rhoda was insistent and determined for them to believe her. Young people must be determined and insistent on what they hear and whom they recognize.

Pray:

- 1. That young people would be convinced by what they hear
- **2.** For a generation that is insistent upon the new things that God is saying and doing
- **3.** That this generation would not be swayed by the unbelief of others

Astonished

Acts 12:16 (NKJV)

16 Now Peter continued knocking; and when they opened the door and saw him, they were astonished.

When everyone saw Peter they were astonished at his miraculous release from prison. We must have a generation that experiences the miraculous in God. We need a generation that is astonished at how God answers strategic corporate prayers that bring a release from prison situations.

Pray:

- 1. That young people would experience the miraculous nature of God
- **2.** For a generation that would be astonished
- 3. That God would answer prayers that would shift cities
