Worship

Genesis 22:3 (NKJV)

3 So Abraham rose early in the morning and saddled his donkey, and took two of his young men with him, and Isaac his son

Isaac went with his father Abraham to go and worship the Lord. Isaac would become Abraham's successor. Succession is determined by a passionate pursuit for God. Isaac pursued God by following in the footsteps of his father. Parents must set an example of godly pursuit for their children.

Pray:

1. For young people to pursue God passionately
2. That parents would set a good example of godly pursuit in all things
3. For a generation that would follow goodly examples

Genesis 22:4 (NKJV)

Then on the third day Abraham lifted his eyes and saw the place afar off.

Isaac saw what his father saw. Succession is determined by seeing what the father sees. Solomon saw the plans that his father had to build a temple and he was able to complete it. We must have a generation that can see what the father sees. Sight and perspective is needed to see the fulfillment of what is in the plan of God. We must have a generation that can lift up their eyes.

Pray:

1. For young people to see through the eyes of their ascendants.
2. That this generation would not be blinded by problems but lift up their eyes to see
3. For a generation sees as fathers see

Burden bearer

Genesis 22:6 (NKJV)

6 So Abraham took the wood of the burnt offering and laid it on Isaac his son;

Isaac carried the wood on his shoulders and his back. Sons who will succeed must bear weight on his shoulders. He must carry his cross (self denial, he must carry the ark of the covenant (presence of the Lord), he must carry government (rulership), he must carry the burden of the word of the Lord. A son who gives his shoulder is a son of promise..

Pray:

1. For this generation to be burden bearers
2. That young people would die to themselves and live for others
3. For young people to carry the weight of God's presence

Believe

Genesis 22:8 (NKJV)

8 And Abraham said, "My son, God will provide for Himself the lamb for a burnt offering." So the two of them went together.

Even though Isaac did not see the lamb he believed his father that God will provide. A successor believes what his father says. He had faith that what his father said will come to pass. Many die in the wilderness because of unbelief. We must have a generation that believes God's prophets so they will prosper

Pray:

1. That young people would believe what is spoken
2. That unbelief and doubt would not keep young people in the wilderness
3. For young people to know God as provider

Submission

Genesis 22:9 (NKJV)

9 Then they came to the place of which God had told him. And Abraham built an altar there and placed the wood in order; and he bound Isaac his son and laid him on the altar, upon the wood.

Isaac submitted to the process of being tied to the altar and becoming the sacrifice. This is a son who presented his body as a living sacrifice. He did not make sacrifice he became the sacrifice. We must have such a generation.

Pray:

1. For young people to submit to the process
2. That young people would learn to be sacrificial just as Christ became our sacrifice
3. For this generation to be lifted up as Christ was lifted up

See the provision

Genesis 22:13-14 (NKJV)

13 Then Abraham lifted his eyes and looked, and there behind him was a ram caught in a thicket by its horns.

Isaac saw the fruit of belief. As a successor he witnessed that what his father said had come to pass. One who will become a successor must witness the provision of God. They must carry the same faith that was in their father so they can do more than what their predecessors have done.

Pray:

1. That like Isaac this generation would see the fruit of belief.
2. For young people to exercise their faith just as their fathers have done
3. For a generation that would not doubt but be full of faith
