

Blessed is everyone

Psalms 128:1 (NKIV)

1 Blessed is every one who fears the LORD, Who walks in His ways.

Everyone is looking to be blessed or to receive a blessing. One who fears the Lord is blessed. Joseph feared God, Abraham feared God, Jacob feared God, David feared God, Cornelius feared God and all of them were blessed. Reverential fear is an antenna for the blessings of God

Pray:

- That our fear for the Lord will result in blessings
- For the faith of the patriarchs to be in us 2.
- That we would analyze why we are not 3. being blessed

Walk in His ways

Psalms 128:1 (NKJV)

1 Blessed is every one who fears the LORD, Who walks in His ways.

The ways of the Lord are higher or superior to our ways. His ways are found in His commands. In order for us to be blessed we have to walk in His ways. Jesus Christ is the way and His lifestyle on the earth was giving a way of living so that we could be blessed. Way is a manner of life, culture and a distinct pattern of living that attracts the blessing of God.

Pray:

- For His ways to become our ways 1.
- That we would follow the example that Jesus left 2. us and walk in His footsteps
- That we would remain blessed as we walk in the 3. ways of the Lord.

Eat the labor of your hands Psalms 128:2 (NKJV)

2 When you eat the labor of your hands,

You shall be happy, and it shall be well with you.

The labor of our hands is our occupation, profession, vocation, business or careers. Many people find themselves under a burden because of their occupation. When we fear the Lord we do not see our vocation as work but we see it as worship and this brings happiness into our lives.

Pray:

- 1. That we will see work as worship to the Lord
- For work to be an opportunity of expressing the ways of 2. God
- 3. That reverential fear would bring joy into our lives

It shall be well with you

Psalms 128:2 (NKJV)

2 When you eat the labor of your hands,

You shall be happy, and it shall be well with you.

Our work or labor should bring us prosperity however we find ourselves in debt and being overwhelmed. It is promised to those that fear the Lord that "it shall be well with you". We labor under the fear of man therefore we do not see the benefits of our hard labor.

Prav:

- That we would labor in the fear of the Lord and not the fear of man
- For our labor to bring us prosperity and not 2. anxiety
- That we would see the promise of wellness as 3. we walk in reverential fear

Fruitful vine

Psalms 128:3 (NKJV)

3 Your wife shall be like a fruitful vine In the very heart of your house,

The wife in a home is at the heart of its functionality and hospitality. It is promised to those who walk in reverential fear that the wife would be a fruitful vine that would cause the house to be a home. Family life is dependent on wives and mothers being respected.

Pray:

- 1. For our wives and mothers who are pivotal to our homes being fruitful
- That women in general will be respected for 2. their roles both in the home and society
- For marriages to be filled with reverential fear 3.

Olive plants

Psalms 128:3 (NKJV)

3 Your wife shall be like a fruitful vine In the very heart of your house, Your children like olive plants All around your table.

Olive plants symbolized beauty, prosperity and sovereignty. For our children to live in prosperity and become the beauty of the Lord they must understand the fear of the Lord. We must craft environments of reverential fear so that our children will walk in generational blessings.

Pray:

- 1. For grace to construct environments of reverential
- That children would grow up fearing the Lord 2.
- For our home to be filled with godly fear 3.
