Given

2 Corinthians 8:1 (NKJV)

1 Moreover, brethren, we make known to you the grace of God bestowed on the churches of Macedonia:

The Apostle Paul speaks of the grace of God given to the churches in Macedonia. The grace bestowed or given to these churches was the grace to be generous or to give liberally. Giving is a grace that we must learn how to access because it is more blessed to give than to receive.

Pray:

1. For the grace to give generously
2. That generosity would become a lifestyle
3. For wisdom to access the grace to give more.

Riches

2 Corinthians 8:2 (NKJV)

2 that in a great trial of affliction the abundance of their joy and their deep poverty abounded in the riches of their liberality.

The churches in Macedonia faced much trials and afflictions but this did not stop them from abounding in their giving. We must receive grace to give even in the midst of our afflictions and poverty because we know that God looks upon our sacrifices.

Pray:

1. That our afflictions and trials would not hinder us from being generous
2. For grace to give even in challenging times
3. That we would abound in riches of liberality

Ability

2 Corinthians 8:3 (NKJV)

3 For I bear witness that according to their ability, yes, and beyond their ability, they were freely willing,

Ability is what is within our power but to go beyond our ability is what is not within your power. This is where the grace to give begins to work in our lives. Giving beyond our measure is a grace that will enable us to access what is impossible in the natural.

Pray:

1. That we would give beyond our ability
2. For grace to give super abundantly
3. That we would access what is impossible in the natural when we give beyond our ability

Consecrated

2 Corinthians 8:5 (NKJV)

5 And not only as we had hoped, but they first gave themselves to the Lord, and then to us by the will of God.

The churches in Macedonia were given to the Lord. They had consecrated their lives to God as their Father. We receive the grace to give when we give ourselves to the Lord first. They also gave themselves to the apostles. We must give ourselves to God first and then to His representatives.

Pray:

1. That we would give ourselves to the Lord completely
2. For a willingness to be consecrated to the Lord even in our giving
3. That we would give ourselves to God's servants

Execute

2 Corinthians 8:6 (NKJV)

6 So we urged Titus, that as he had begun, so he would also complete this grace in you as well.

There are those in the Body of Christ that dispense grace so that we become generous. Titus was sent to the Corinthian church to complete or bring to fullness the grace of generosity in the Corinthian believers. We must receive the grace to become generous in our giving.

Pray:

1. That we would receive the grace from others to become generous givers.
2. For the grace to give to be made complete in us
3. That we would not procrastinate like the Corinthian church.

Super abound

2 Corinthians 8:7 (NKJV)

7 But as you abound in everything—in faith, in speech, in knowledge, in all diligence, and in your love for us—see that you abound in this grace also.

We can abound in several aspects of our spiritual life but giving is something that requires sacrifice. This is an area that we must super abound because it is more blessed to give than to receive.

Pray:

1. That we would abound in our giving
2. For grace to start giving today
3. That all fear and doubt would be cast out of lives when it comes to giving generously.
