

What is worship?

Genesis 22:5 (NKJV)

5 And Abraham said to his young men, "Stay here with the donkey; the lad and I will go yonder and worship, and we will come back to you."

Those who fear the Lord, like Abraham know that worship is about total obedience to God. Abraham called his obedience worship. All of life is lived in the presence of God, under the sovereignty of God and is for the glory of God. Reverential fear creates a conscience for us to live this way.

Pray:

- That we would become more aware of living in 1. the presence of God
- For reverential fear to create a conscience of 2. doing all for the glory of God.
- That we would see worship as total obedience 3. to God

Obedience

John 14:15 (NKJV)

15 "If you love Me, keep My commandments.

Worship is obedience when we keep the commands of the Lord. Jesus gave us some commandments regarding baptism, communion, loving one another and making disciples. We cannot say that we worship God when we do not keep His commandments. He gave us a new commandment which is to love one another as He loved us. Such love becomes worship.

Pray:

Royal priesthood Revelation 1:6 (NKJV)

6 and has made us kings and priests to His God and Father, to Him be glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen.

Our function as kings and priests is worship to God. As priests we are called to preserve, reconcile, intercede, evangelize, teach and support. All of these functions in our priestly role is worship to God. We must be governed by reverential fear to carry out these functions daily.

Pray:

- That as we walk in the fear of the Lord we would accurately 2. represent Christ our High Priest.
- For godly fear to govern our roles as priests. 3.

Speech

Hebrews 13:15 (NKJV)

15 Therefore by Him let us continually offer the sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of our lips, giving thanks to His name.

We use our lips to offer a sacrifice of praise to the Lord. We use our mouths to make declarations, confer blessings and sing praises to God. Therefore we should be fearful of using our mouth to gossip, slander and speak evil of others. Our speech must be seasoned with salt and filled with wisdom.

Prav:

- For godly fear to put a guard on our mouth
- That we would use our lips to bring honor to the 2.
- For our words to transmit grace to others. 3.

Spirit and truth

John 4:24 (NKJV)

24 God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth."

To worship God in spirit and truth is to have a balance. We have the Holy Spirit that brings that manifest presence into our lives. The word of God is truth therefore we must love the word. As worshipers we must have this balance of the word and the spirit in our lives.

Pray:

- 1. For a deeper love for the word of God
- That we would love the truth that would set us free 2.
- For balance of the word and the spirit in our lives 3.

Posture

Genesis 22:5 (NKJV)

5 And Abraham said to his young men, "Stay here with the donkey; the lad and I will go yonder and worship, and we will come back to you."

One of the meanings of the word worship is to bow down or to pay homage. When we worship God there are several postures like, kneeling, dancing, raising hands etc. While we maintain these outward postures, we must also maintain a humble spirit before the Lord and have a contrite heart.

Prav:
