Blessings of goodness

Psalms 21:1 (NKJV) 1 The king shall have joy in Your strength, O LORD;...3 For You meet him with the blessings of goodness; In Christ we have been made kings and priests to God our Father. As kings God meets us with the blessings of goodness. This blessing of goodness is pronounced upon us because we are in Christ, the King of kings. As kings we have a duty to use the blessings of goodness to be a blessing to others just as Abraham was blessed to be a blessing.

Pray:

- 1. For our kingship to be seen by the blessing of goodness upon our lives
- That as kings in Christ we would reveal more of Christ 2. the King
- That we would be a blessing to others 3.

Crown

Psalms 21:3 (NKJV) 3 For You meet him with the blessings of goodness; You set a crown of pure gold upon his head.

A crown is a symbol of the honor. God's goodness to us is seen in that Christ wore a crown of thorns so that we could receive a crown of righteousness. A crown is placed on the head which is the seat of our thoughts and decisions. We have received the mind of Christ to make us discerning in our decision making on the earth.

Pray:

- 1. That we would live to express the righteousness of God
- For our minds to be renewed daily 2.
- 3. That His mind would become our mind

Long life Psalms 21:4 (NKJV)

4 He asked life from You, and You gave it to him— Length of days forever and ever.

God in His goodness sent His Son to die for us so that we could receive eternal life. This life is the abundant life. While we have life we must live an abundant life. Long life or length of days is just quantity of time but eternal life is quality of time. While we ask for long life, it is better to live an abundant life.

Pray:

- That we would live an abundant life in Christ 1.
- For our length of days to be filled with expressing 2. the abundant life that comes from God
- That we would be satisfied with long life 3.

Glory

Psalms 21:5 (NKJV)

5 His glory is great in Your salvation;

Honor and majesty You have placed upon him.

Glory is often associated with the weight of God's presence, but God's glory is also seen in His salvation. Salvation means His deliverance, His welfare, His prosperity. The weight of God is seen in His deliverance. This is His goodness towards us as His sons.

Pray:

- That God's glory would be seen in the way He delivers 1. us and prospers us
- For the goodness of God to be revealed to others when 2. He delivers us from our trials
- That we would become the glory of God to the earth 3.

Honor and majesty

Psalms 21:5 (NKJV)

5 His glory is great in Your salvation; Honor and majesty You have placed upon him.

As kings in Christ, honor and majesty have been bestowed upon us. This is the goodness of God to us the sons of God. Honor and majesty is the excellence and splendor of God. Our God is majestic and as his sons we have the right of representation of His honor and majesty.

Pray:

- 1. That we would be good representatives of the excellence and splendor of our God
- For our lives to be one of excellence 2.
- That in all we do, it would be to the glory of God 3.

Joy Psalms 21:6 (NKJV)

6 For You have made him most blessed forever; You have made him exceedingly glad with Your presence.

The goodness of God is revealed by His presence that makes us glad or joyful. We have received the Holy Spirit and we must grow the fruit of joy. We can be joyful when we reflect on His goodness in our lives. In His presence there is fullness of joy. His goodness makes us joyful.

Pray:

- That we would grow the fruit of joy in our lives 1.
- For our thoughts of God's goodness to fill our 2. lives with joy
- That in His presence we would experience joy 3.
