Speak in faith

Genesis 22:5 (NKJV)

5 And Abraham said to his young men, “Stay here with the donkey; the lad and I will go yonder and worship, and we will come back to you.”

Abraham spoke in faith when he said "we will come back to you. Abraham obeyed God in faith and also spoke in faith. The Shunammite woman said "it is well" even when her son was dead. Paul and Silas began singing and praising in faith while they were in prison. The fear of the Lord stirs our faith.

Pray:

1. For our faith confession to negate our fears.
2. That we will speak in faith despite our circumstances.
3. That like Abraham we will believe that God will provide in due time.

Act in faith

Mark 2:5 (NKJV)

5 When Jesus saw their faith, He said to the paralytic, “Son, your sins are forgiven you.”

Four men carried a paralytic and acted in faith when they opened the roof and placed him before Jesus. Jesus saw their faith which was their actions that placed the man before the Lord. Our act of faith is demonstrated by risks that causes God to take notice.

Pray:

1. For our acts of faith to heal our paralysis
2. That we would not let fear limit our faith actions
3. That God would take notice of our faith actions

Reach out for oneness

Mark 5:34 (NKJV)

34 And He said to her, “Daughter, your faith has made you well. Go in peace, and be healed of your affliction.”

The faith of the woman who had a blood disorder was to grab the hem of Jesus. The hem of Jesus had a tassel symbolizing the oneness of His Body. When we reach out to grab the hem we are reaching out for oneness in the Body. We do this in faith so that the Body will not be hemorrhaging.

Pray:

1. For a greater passion for the oneness of the Body
2. That we will demonstrate our faith by being committed to the gathering of the Body of Christ.
3. That the woman which is the church will not be weak in faith

Know who is worthy

Luke 7:9 (NKJV)

9 When Jesus heard these things, He marveled at him, and turned around and said to the crowd that followed Him, “I say to you, I have not found such great faith, not even in Israel!”

The great faith of the centurion was recognizing that Jesus had more authority than he had. He bestowed greater honor on the Lord than the Jews and it was called great faith. Those who fear the Lord recognize authority.

Pray:

1. That we would discern those who are worthy of double honor.
2. For our faith to be demonstrated by the honor we show to the Lord.
3. That our faith will increase to great faith.

Gratefulness

Luke 17:17-19 (NKJV) **17 So Jesus answered and said, “Were there not ten cleansed? But where are the nine? 18 Were there not any found who returned to give glory to God except this foreigner?” 19 And He said to him, “Arise, go your way. Your faith has made you well.”**

The faith of the leper was gratefulness. When we thank God in faith like Jonah who was in the belly of the fish we will see deliverance.

Pray:

1. For a thankful attitude to bring deliverance.
2. That we wont let our trials diminish our thanks.
3. That in all things we would remain grateful.

Gift of God

Ephesians 2:8 (NKJV)

8 For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God,

The fear of the Lord reminds us that it is not our faith but it is the gift of faith that releases grace to enable us to act in faith. The faith we have is not our own it is the gift of faith. One of the gifts of the Spirit is the gift of faith. Such faith makes us radical and gives us divine ability.

Pray:

1. For the gift of faith
2. That we would not be deceived into thinking it is our faith.
3. That we will let faith arise and so that we can live a life of faith in Christ.
