Gathered together

Acts 20:8 (NKJV)

8 There were many lamps in the upper room where they were gathered together.

There was a gathering where the Apostle Paul was addressing the disciples. In this gathering was a young man called Eutychus. Young people must be part of gatherings where sound doctrine is being delivered. Paul was known for sharing doctrine to establish believers in the faith. Young people need doctrine.

Pray:

1. For young people to be part of gatherings
2. That young people would desire more of God's word
3. For this generation to be established in sound doctrine

Fortunate

Acts 20:9 (NKJV)

9 And in a window sat a certain young man named Eutychus, who was sinking into a deep sleep. He was overcome by sleep;

Eutychus was part of the gathering where Paul was speaking but he fell asleep. The name Eutychus means fortunate. We are dealing with a generation that is fortunate yet falling asleep. Doctrine is not easy to listen and to process but it will save the lives of young people.

Pray:

1. For young people to realize how fortunate they are to be living in this time
2. That this generation would not fall asleep when doctrine is being taught.
3. For this generation to be awake to spiritual things

Third story

Acts 20:9 (NKJV)

9 And in a window sat a certain young man named Eutychus, who was sinking into a deep sleep. He was overcome by sleep; and as Paul continued speaking, he fell down from the third story and was taken up dead.

The young man fell from the third story. This is a metaphor of a resurrection life position. Christ rose on the third day so that we might have life and have it more abundantly. We need this generation to experience the life that comes from God.

Pray:

1. For young people to experience the life of God
2. That young people would not fall asleep spiritually
3. For the resurrection life of God to set young people free from bondage to this world

Went down

Acts 20:10 (NKJV)

10 But Paul went down, fell on him, and embracing him said, "Do not trouble yourselves, for his life is in him."

Paul left the meeting and went down to where the young man had fallen. Young people need to be met at where they are. Many of them are dealing with overwhelming situations that cause them to keep falling down. Grace can reach them where they are.

Pray:

1. That grace would reach young people in their fallen state
2. For young people to be part of gatherings where grace can lift them
3. That young people would receive grace

Fell on him

Acts 20:10 (NKJV)

10 But Paul went down, fell on him, and embracing him said, "Do not trouble yourselves, for his life is in him."

Paul fell on the young man who had fallen from the third story. Elisha laid himself upon a young boy who died and his life came back into him. This is called impartation. Young people need an impartation of grace to raise them up from the deadness in the spirit.

Pray:

1. For grace impartation to bring life to young people
2. That young people would desire impartation from authentic apostles
3. For young people to desire apostolic grace

Embracing him

Acts 20:10 (NKJV)

10 But Paul went down, fell on him, and embracing him said, "Do not trouble yourselves, for his life is in him."

Paul embraced Eutychus as a father would embrace a son who is fallen and dead. Many young people are dead in their trespasses and sin and are in need of a father's embrace to give them resurrection life. This generation needs the embrace of fathers to bring them back to life.

Pray:

1. For young people to receive the embrace of God the Father through representative fathers
2. For young people who are dead in sin to receive the love of God the Father
3. That this generation would not be spiritual orphans
