Election

Psalms 65:4 (NKJV) 4 Blessed is the man You choose, And cause to approach You, That he may dwell in Your courts. We shall be satisfied with the goodness of Your house, Of Your holy temple.

We have been chosen in Christ before the foundations of the world. As the elect of God, we did not choose Him but He chose us. We are chosen to dwell in the Body of Christ which is the holy temple. This is how we remain in Him. The Body is where we are satisfied with His goodness.

Pray:

Actions

Creation

Psalms 65:6-7 (NKJV) 6 Who established the mountains by His strength, Being clothed with power; 7 You who still the noise of the seas, The noise of their waves, And the tumult of the peoples.

Creation is a clear indication of God's goodness to us. God by His mighty hand established the mountains and the seas. When we look at creation, we see God's wisdom and His power. Job understood the goodness of God despite his many trials when God revealed creation to him.

Pray:

- 1. That we would see God's goodness in creation
- 2. For a more wise approach as to how we treat our environment.
- 3. That we would take care of the planet so we can experience His goodness everyday.

Provision

Psalms 65:9 (NKJV) 9 You visit the earth and water it, You greatly enrich it; The river of God is full of water; You provide their grain, For so You have prepared it.

God's provision is seen in the rain and the grain. The rain waters the earth so that the grain can grow to provide food for us. The river of God in Ezekiel 47 brings healing to the nations and causes the trees to bear fruit. Rain is vital for the flourishing of the earth and God is good when He waters the earth.

Pray:

- 1. Thank God for His daily provision
- 2. That we would see His goodness when we see the rain
- **3.** For the river of God which is now the Body of Christ to bring healing to the nations

Profusion

Psalms 65:11 (NKJV) 11 You crown the year with Your goodness, And Your paths drip with abundance.

To crown is to surround or encompass. God's goodness surrounds our entire year and He fills our paths with abundance. The overflow of God is to manifest the goodness of God to others. We serve a God of more then enough who wants us to be an expression of His abundant life in us. His goodness is seen in His abundance.

Pray:

- 1. That we would have an abundance so that we can reveal the goodness of God
- 2. That our year would be surrounded by His goodness
- **3.** For our lives to reflect the abundant life of God

Jubilation

Psalms 65:13 (NKJV) 13 The pastures are clothed with flocks; The valleys also are covered with grain; They shout for joy, they also sing.

We shout or sing for joy because God is good. When there is an abundance of flocks and grain we know that God is good. However such joy is limited only to having an abundance. We are a joyful, happy and a jubilant people because God is good despite our circumstances. We have a sustained joy because we have received an abundant life in Christ.

Pray:

- **1.** That we will remain joyful in all things
- 2. For God's abundant life to make us a jubilant people
- **3.** That the joy of the Lord will be our strength
