

**I. Opening**

**A. Lester Sumrall – “80% of people receive their healing while sitting under the Word.**

**B. My Experience – *Soak in the WORD***

**Proverbs 4:20-22 (NKJV)** – <sup>20</sup>*My son, give attention to my words; incline your ear to my sayings. <sup>21</sup>Do not let them depart from your eyes; keep them in the midst of your heart; <sup>22</sup>for they are life to those who find them, and health to all their flesh.*

**Proverbs 4:20-22 (NIV)** – <sup>20</sup>*My son, pay attention to what I say; turn your ear to my words. <sup>21</sup>Do not let them out of your sight, keep them within your heart; <sup>22</sup>for they are life to those who find them and health to one’s whole body.*

**Proverbs 4:22 (GWT)** – *because they are life to those who find them and they heal the whole body.*

**II. The Healing/Word Connection**

**A. Luke 5:17 (NKJV)** – *Now it happened on a certain day, as He was teaching, that there were Pharisees and teachers of the law sitting by, who had come out of every town of Galilee, Judea, and Jerusalem. And the power of the Lord was present to heal them.*

**B. Luke 6:17 (NKJV)** – *And He came down with them and stood on a level place with a crowd of His disciples and a great multitude of people from all Judea and Jerusalem, and from the seacoast of Tyre and Sidon, who came to hear Him and be healed of their diseases,*

**C. The Woman with the issue of blood; *Her faith began by hearing.***

**Mark 5:27 (NKJV)** – *When she heard about Jesus, she came behind Him in the crowd and touched His garment.*

**D. Act 14:8-10 (NKJV)** – <sup>8</sup>*And in Lystra a certain man without strength in his feet was sitting, a cripple from his mother's womb, who had never walked. <sup>9</sup>This man heard Paul speaking. Paul, observing him intently and seeing that he had faith to be healed, <sup>10</sup>said with a loud voice, "Stand up straight on your feet!" And he leaped and walked.*

**E. There is a connection to the healing flow of heaven as we soak in the Word of God.**

**John 15:7 (NKJV)** – *If you abide in me and my words abide in you, you will ask what you desire and it shall be done for you.*

1. There is no replacement for spending time in the Word of God.
2. The flow of healing will be connected to the Healing Word.
3. No one is so spiritual that they do not need a consistent supply of the Word of God.
4. The healing word sets us up for healing.
5. The word has the power to release healing into our bodies.
6. The Word has the power to drive out sickness and pain.
7. The Word of God will uproot sickness in our life.
8. The Word of God will sustain the healing that we have received.
9. Hearing the Word consistently is giving place to the supernatural flow of heaven that will produce life and health.
