Study Go for More Pt 2 – Draw More from the Well Pastor Dale Campbell

I. Introduction

In Part 1 we discussed the potential of the seed. Some are receiving 30%, 60% and 100% potential of the seed.

A. Thoughts from Part 1.

- 1. We can increase the potential of the soil allowing the seed to produce a greater harvest.
- 2. God works through progression.
 - a. Thirty increased to sixty increased to one hundred fold.
 - b. The vision of Ezekiel: waters to the ankle, waters to the knee, waters to the waist, waters to swim in.
- 3. God doesn't want us to plateau and stand still in in journey of faith. It is His desire that we increase, advance and continue to move forward into the greater harvest He has prepared for us.
- II. Draw more from the well.
 - A. Isaiah 12:1-3 (NKJV) ¹And in that day you will say: "O Lord, I will praise You; though You were angry with me, Your anger is turned away, and You comfort me. ²Behold, God is my salvation, I will trust and not be afraid; 'For Yah, the Lord, is my strength and song; <u>He also has become my salvation</u>." ³Therefore with joy you will draw water from the wells of salvation.

NOTE: We are to DRAW from the WELLS of salvation Salvation is like a well – filled with everything you need You must DRAW from those wells. God put the substance in the well You do the DRAWING!

B. What's in the wells of salvation?

We need to know what's in the well?

- Psalm 103:1-5 (NKJV) ¹Bless the Lord, O my soul; and all that is within me, bless His holy name! ²Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all His benefits: ³Who forgives all your iniquities, who heals all your diseases, ⁴Who redeems your life from destruction, who crowns you with lovingkindness and tender mercies, ⁵Who satisfies your mouth with good things, so that your youth is renewed like the eagle's.
- John 7:38-39 (NKJV) ³⁸He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will flow rivers of living water." ³⁹But this He spoke concerning the Spirit, whom those believing in Him would receive; for the Holy Spirit was not yet given, because Jesus was not yet glorified.

<u>John 7:38 (AMP)</u> – He who believes in Me [who adheres to, trusts in, and relies on Me], as the Scripture has said, 'From his innermost being will flow continually rivers of living water.'"

3. <u>**2 Peter 1:3 (NIV)**</u> – *His divine power has given us everything we need for a godly life through our knowledge of him who called us by his own glory and goodness.*

NOTE: Whatever I need – It's In the Well!

- C. Draw it out!
 - Isaiah 12:4-6 (NKJV) ⁴And in that day you will say: "Praise the Lord, call upon His name; declare His deeds among the peoples, make mention that His name is exalted. ⁵Sing to the Lord, for He has done excellent things; this is known in all the earth. ⁶Cry out and shout, O inhabitant of Zion, for great is the Holy One of Israel in your midst!
 - a. **"In that day you will say"** Saying draws out of the well. Profession – The great confession – You must use your voice.

b. Praise & Prayer

Paul and Silas engaged in prayer and worship to draw a supernatural flow of power that would shake the foundations of their prison causing doors to open and chains to break lose. **NOTE: Although prayer is not specifically mentioned in Isaiah, it is a major tool for drawing out of the wells of salvation.** <u>Jude 1:20 (NKJV)</u> – But you, beloved, building yourselves up on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Spirit,

c. Declare

Paul declared victory while on a sinking ship, declaring that no one would lose their life if they stayed with the ship because He had heard from the Lord.

Paul had to declare it.

<u>Job 22:28 (NKJV)</u> – You will also declare a thing, and it will be established for you; So light will shine on your ways. <u>Job 22:28 (Aramaic)</u> – And you will speak a word and it will

happen to you, and upon your ways the light will dawn

d. Make mention

Talking of faith, victory, and everything made available to us draws things MORE out.

Talking of past victories and testimonies – not only revisits the moments but draws the power of that victory back to the surface allowing it to manifest again.

Make mention of what God has already done. Make mention of His promises/blessings/victories past.

e. Sing

Singing was used to draw victory out for Jehoshaphat's army. <u>Colossians 3:16 (KJV)</u> – Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom; teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.

<u>Colossians 3:16 (NIV)</u> – Let the message of Christ dwell among you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom through psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit, singing to God with gratitude in your hearts.

f. Cry aloud and shout

The shout at the walls of Jericho – drew the power needed to bring the walls down.

- g. Joy draws out of the well.
 <u>Isaiah 12:3 (NKJV)</u> Therefore with joy you will draw water from the wells of salvation.
 Stirring up JOY will draw on the wells of salvation.
 As we draw out of the wells JOY will be increased.
 The Joy of the Lord is our strength.
- 2. Too many are settling for a "Lower Flow"! You need to draw a little deeper from the well.
 - a. There is more available than you are drawing on.
 - b. There's another level of blessing/glory/revelation/strength/ health/etc.
 - c. Whatever you need It's In the WELL! God already put it in the FLOW. Use your faith and DRAW it OUT. What have you drawn out of your well? What have you left beneath the surface that you need to draw out?
