- II. The Progressive Force of Faith

A. Introductory thoughts

- 1. Faith is progressive
 - a. Faith begins with a freely given measure distributed to every man by God himself. (Romans 12:3)
 - b. Faith grows with a progressive revelation of God's Word.
 - c. Faith must go through progressive doors prior to arriving at its destination.
 - d. Our faith progresses daily by gaining revelation from God's Word and pushing against the opposition of the adversity of our faith.
 - e. We aggressively obtain the promises with a force of faith that is fueled by revelation from God's Word and Spirit.
 - f. "A progressive faith-life is fueled by spiritual hunger, focused attention, and a strong desire to Know God and His Word." –
 Pastor Debbie Eberly¹
 - g. The more we get to know God, the easier it becomes to receive from Him.
 - Get to know Him as mercy and compassion it is easy to receive forgiveness.
 - Get to know Him as healer, it is easy to receive healing.
 - Get to know Him as provider, it is easy to receive provision.
 - Job 22:21 (NKJV) Now acquaint yourself with Him and be at peace; thereby good will come to you.
- 2. Everything that we receive from our covenant of health will be received by faith.

a. If I am not receiving, the issue is not with the covenant.

b. When I am not receiving, I need to check my faith levels. Where is my faith regarding the healing I desire to receive? Have I researched the healing scriptures to build my faith? Have I really meditated upon Healing scriptures?

B. How the progression of faith works

- 1. <u>Mark 4:26-32 (KJV)</u> ²⁶ And he said, So is the kingdom of God, as if a man should cast seed into the ground; ²⁷and should sleep, and rise night and day, and the seed should spring and grow up, he knoweth not how. ²⁸For the earth bringeth forth fruit of herself; first the blade, then the ear, after that the full corn in the ear. ²⁹But when the fruit is brought forth, immediately he putteth in the sickle, because the harvest is come ³⁰And he said, "Whereunto shall we liken the kingdom of God? or with what comparison shall we compare it? ³¹It is like a grain of mustard seed, which, **when it is sown** in the earth, is less than all the seeds that be in the earth: ³²but when it is sown, it groweth up, and becometh greater than all herbs, and shooteth out great branches; so that the fowls of the air may lodge under the shadow of it."
 - a. Faith works like a seed! We could say faith is a seed.
 - b. **Seeds must be planted before they can produce a harvest.** *Faith must be sown into the heart before it can produce a harvest.*
 - c. **Seeds do not produce a harvest overnight.** *Faith does not produce a harvest overnight.*
 - d. The harvest that comes from seeds is progressive. The harvest of our faith will be progressive.
- 2. <u>Mark 4:28 (KJV)</u> For the earth bringeth forth fruit of herself; first the blade, then the ear, after that the full corn in the ear.

<u>Mark 4:28 (Lamsa Bible)</u> – For the earth causes it to yield fruit; and yet first it becomes a blade of grass, then an ear, and at last a full grain in the ear



- a. Notice the progression
 - Blade
 - Ear
 - Full corn HARVEST
- b. You cannot attempt to harvest corn from the BLADE or the EAR prior to the development of the corn.
- 3. You cannot reap the harvest of your faith when it is only at blade level or ear level yet still undeveloped at harvest level.
 - a. Many are trying to reap a harvest where no seed has been sown. No Seed – No Sowing – No harvest.
 - b. Many are trying to reap a harvest of faith from someone else's faith.
 - c. Many are trying to reap a FULL harvest of faith when their faith is still at BLADE level.
 - Be happy that your faith has been sown.
 - Celebrate when you begin to see the BLADE/BEGINNING level of your faith come into manifestation.
 - Celebrate as you watch your faith grow.
 - DO NOT ATTEMPT to HARVEST your faith from the blade or early development levels.
- C. How to navigate our faith forward to harvest.
 - 1. Continue to Sow to your faith. Build and develop your faith by meditating upon your covenant promises which make up your foundation of faith.
 - a. Build your knowledge base. The progression of faith begins with knowledge.
 - b. Add to your healing scripture lists.
 - c. Keep them in your eyes, ears, and heart.
 - d. As you meditate upon God's promises, revelation knowledge will come to your spirit regarding what belongs to you.
 - e. One of the greatest signs of development in faith is confidence. Become confident and assured of the promises you have been given.


- *Full confidence in the Greek: full conviction, entire confidence, or complete understanding.*
- This is what occurred in Abraham's progression of faith. He became FULLY PERSUADED that what God said, He would do, He was fully able to do it.
- 2. Stay in an atmosphere conducive for your faith to grow.
 - a. Stay with a local church that teaches the principles of faith.
 - b. Be submitted to a Pastor who imparts things relating to faith.

"By hearing the powerful Word from an anointed pastor, the Christian will further be able to see or attain to a thorough revelation knowledge of the scriptures that specifically cover their redemptive promises."

The believer MUST be in the right places where they can hear the truth's of God's Word....**Pastor Debbie Eberly**

- 3. Navigate through the opposition that always comes in to challenge our faith.
 - a. Faith will always face opposition.
 - b. Faith will face progressive doors that <u>have increased levels of</u> <u>adversarial opposition</u>. *Do not be moved by the faith's opposing forces*.
 - c. The woman with the issue of blood no doubt face great opposition before her faith ever placed her in proximity of Jesus.
 - d. Remember, faith is a fight: "The Good Fight of Faith." 1 Tim 6:12 If your faith is not up for a fight – your faith is not up for harvest yet".

"TEST" – Is my faith up for this fight? If not – it may only be a BLADE level – Keep developing it to HARVEST level.



- 4. Rely on the aid of our great navigator the Holy Spirit.
 - a. John 16:13 (NKJV) However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come.
 - b. The Holy Spirit will guide us in our faith battles.
 He will show us things to come that we need to be aware of.
 He will give us a warfare strategy.
 He will guide you to the right physician.
 He will guide you in treatment options and procedures.
- 5. Only those who "Prepare Themselves," to flow with this progressive force of faith will receive the promises.
 - a. We must feed constantly upon the living Word of God.
 - b. We must be faithful to build ourselves up spiritually through knowledge and understanding and the wisdom God if we are going to be PROGRESSIVE in our faith journey.
 - c. We must possess an aggressive resolve to have God's best and perfect will for our lives *This includes healing and divine health. Passive faith doesn't obtain the promises.*

<u>Matthew 11:12 (NKJV)</u> – And from the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven suffers violence, and the violent take it by force

<u>Matthew 11:12 (AMP)</u> – From the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven suffers violent assault, and violent men seize it by force [as a precious prize]

Audrey Mack calls this Tenacious Faith!

Tenacious – Not readily relinquishing a position – DETERMINED!
