

BIBLICAL PROSPERITY Session 1 – God's Will for Prosperity

I. The world's definition of PROSPERITY

- A. Merriam Webster the condition of being successful or thriving
- B. Dictionary.com a successful, flourishing, thriving condition, especially in financial respects; good fortune
- C. Cambridge English Dictionary
 - 1) the state of being successful and having a lot of money
 - 2) a situation in which people are successful and have a lot of money

II. The bible definition of PROSPERITY

- A. Scriptures using the term prosper (Prosper is a bible term) The Word PROSPER/PROSPEROUS is used 96 times in the KJV
 - The first use of the word PROSPEROUS when Abraham's servant sought a wife for Isaac

Genesis 24:21 (KJV) – And the man wondering at her held his peace, to wit whether the LORD had made his journey <u>prosperous</u> or not

- **Prosperous definition** to advance, to prosper, to make progress, to succeed, to be profitable
- The Servant prayed for prosperity Genesis 24:12 (KJV) "I pray, send me good speed this day and shew kindness unto my master Abraham.
- This servant expected the Lord to prosper him in his search.



- 2. Various other scriptures using the term PROSPER/PROSPEROUS
 - Joseph

Genesis 39:2-3 (**KJV**) – ²And the LORD was with Joseph, and he was a <u>prosperous man</u>; and he was in the house of his master the Egyptian. ³And his master saw that the LORD was with him, and that the LORD made all that he did to <u>prosper</u> in his hand.

Genesis 39:23 (KJV) – The keeper of the prison looked not to any thing that was under his hand; because the LORD was with him, and that which he did, the LORD made it to prosper.

• The Old Covenant

Deuteronomy 29:9 – Carefully follow the terms of this covenant, so that you may <u>prosper</u> in everything you do.

- Prosper here refers to gaining insight, wisdom and understanding that will give you success!
- Joshua

Joshua 1:7-8 (KJV) – ⁷Only be thou strong and very courageous, that thou mayest observe to do according to all the law, which Moses my servant commanded thee: turn not from it to the right hand or to the left, that thou mayest <u>prosper</u> withersoever thou goest. ⁸This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way <u>prosperous</u>, and then <u>thou shalt have good</u> <u>success</u>.

- It was God's Will for them to have success
- The Old Covenant provided success through complete obedience



• Solomon

1 Kings 10:7 (KJV) – Howbeit I believed not the words, until I came, and mine eyes had seen it: and, behold, the half was not told me: thy <u>wisdom and prosperity</u> exceedeth the fame which I heard.

- Prosperity here is pleasant, good, excellent, rich, valuable, happy, good benefit, good things
- Wisdom and prosperity go together
- Hezekiah

2 Kings 18:7 (KJV) – And the LORD was with him; and he prospered whithersoever he went forth: and he rebelled against the king of Assyria, and served him not.

Nehemiah

Nehemiah 1:11 (KJV) – O LORD, I beseech thee, let now thine ear be attentive to the prayer of thy servant, and to the prayer of thy servants, who desire to fear thy name: and <u>prosper</u>, I pray thee, thy servant this day, and grant him mercy in the sight of this man. For I was the king's cupbearer

- Nehemiah we desire to succeed and prosper
- Psalms

Psalm 1:1-3 (KJV) – ¹<u>Blessed is the man</u> that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful. ²But his delight is in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate day and night. ³And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth <u>shall prosper</u>.

Psalm 35:27 (KJV) – Let them shout for joy, and be glad, that favour my righteous cause: yea, let them say continually, Let the LORD be magnified, <u>which hath</u> <u>pleasure in the prosperity of his servant.</u>

Psalm 118:25 (KJV) – Save now, I beseech thee, O LORD: O LORD, I beseech thee, send now prosperity.

Psalm 118:25 (NIV) – LORD, save us! LORD, grant us success!

- It's ok to pray for success/ prosperity
- New Testament Scriptures on prosperity

Romans 1:9-10 (KJV) – ⁹For God is my witness, whom I serve with my spirit in the gospel of his Son, that without ceasing I make mention of you always in my prayers; ¹⁰Making request, if by any means now at length I might have a prosperous journey by the will of God to come unto you.

- Paul prayed for a prosperous and successful journey

1 Corinthians 16:2 (KJV) – Upon the first day of the week let every one of you lay by him in store, as God hath prospered him, that there be no gatherings when I come.

- Paul indicated that God prospered believers financially to be able to give in offerings

3 John 1:2 (KJV) – Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.

- John writes that believers should prosper in natural things and spiritual things.
- Prosper here is to have success be successful succeed.
