A. Everyone Needs a Reset

1. God's personal word to me, "You need a Reset"!
2. Reset has become a trend in present day society.
3. Reset Definition – A series of actions to restore back to order. To make necessary adjustments. To restore back to initial or proper position.
4. There are times in my life that I need a reset.
 - a. Priorities
 - b. Goals
 - c. Vision
 - d. Relationships
 - e. Purpose
5. The Video
 - a. Satan is trying to invade our space.
 - b. He is trying to work his agenda to steal, kill and destroy.
 - c. We want to send him a clear message, "ACCESS DENIED!"
 - Access denied in my mind
 - Access denied in my marriage
 - Access denied in my kids
 - Access denied in my career and finances
 - Access denied in my health
 - d. To Deny Access may require a RESET.
 - e. The computer example – factory reset
If you don't reset you will crash!
 - f. Avoid a crash by performing an intentional reset.

B. Isaiah 54:11-14 (GWT) – ¹¹*You suffering, comfortless, storm-ravaged city! I will rebuild your city with precious stones. I will reset your foundations with sapphires. ¹²I will rebuild your towers with rubies, your gates with sparkling stones, and all your walls with precious stones."*

¹³All your children will be taught by the LORD, and your children will have unlimited peace. ¹⁴You will be established in righteousness. You will be far from oppression, so you will not be afraid. You will be far from destruction, so it won't come near you

- 1. God says, I want to bring you to a place where you and your children will be blessed. A place where you will be far from oppression, where you will not be afraid, and you will be far from destruction.**
- 2. For this to occur, “Your Foundations will have to be reset”.**
- 3. The indication is:**
 - a. Your foundation has shifted.
 - b. Something has moved off course.
 - c. Something needs to be adjusted.
 - d. You need a course correction.
 - e. If your foundations are reset, you will be back on course for the blessing of God to flow in your life.
- 4. There are times in everyone's life that they need a reset.**
No one is excluded – even the most spiritual person in the world.

C. Different Types of Resets

- 1. Reset in our mind**
 - a. When our thoughts become out of alignment with God's thoughts (How He thinks)
 - b. Everything around us is making an attempt to shape our thinking. It is easy to allow our minds to be shifted away from the truth of God's word. *Romans 12:2 – Be not conformed but transformed by the renewing of your mind.*
- 2. Actions**
 - a. When our actions are out of alignment with God's plan.

- b. When are actions are unhealthy.
Over extending oneself beyond our own strength is a set up for the enemy.
- c. Priorities are important
Know what is essential and what is not essential

3. Relationships

Relationships that add to our life vs relationships that rob us of our strength, peace and joy.

D. Reset and Repentance

2 Chronicles 7:14 (KJV) – *“If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.*

- a. Turn = return, to turn back, to restore/refresh, to put back.
It actually could mean to reset.
- b. We need to stop thinking of repentance in a religious manner.
A repentance that only refers to the person who has fallen into one of the big sin categories.
- c. Repentance is a change of mind/change of action *change your thinking – change the way you are acting!*
- d. True repentance is always to restore alignment with God’s way of thinking and doing – so we can have the abundant life that He has planned for us.
- e. **Revelation 3:19 (NKJV)** – *As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten. Therefore be zealous and repent*

Revelations 3:19 (GWT) – *I correct and discipline everyone I love. Take this seriously, and change the way you think and act.*

- f. Repentance is Good!
- g. Repentance the 180 degree turn vs 360!
180 degree turn – is doing the opposite of what one was doing!
Military – About Face
- h. Sometimes a Reset requires a little course correction.

- i. Sometimes a Reset requires a 180 degree turn.
 - j. The important thing is that we recognize those times in our life when we need a reset.
 - *If it is a little adjustment.*
 - *If it is a major adjustment.*
 - *If it is repentance.*
 - *If it is correction or discipline.*
- We recognize whatever it is that needs to be RESET, so we can get back in on course for the great plan God has for us.

II. Closing

A. Things to consider as we approach this series.

1. We all will need resets in our future.
2. Resets require us to honestly assess where we are.
3. Resets require us to be willing to change what needs to be changed.
4. Resets must be intentional, they are not automatic.
5. Without the needed resets of our life, we will veer off course and may crash.
6. Examples of People resets in the Bible.
 - a. **Elijah the great prophet** – depressed
 - b. **Moses** – given up on his future
 - c. **David** – When he allowed himself to Sin

 - e. **John the Baptist** – Do I need to look for another
 - f. **Timothy** – Stir up the gift that is in you. God didn't give you a spirit of Fear.
