<u>Psalms 119:50 (NLT)</u> – Your promise revives me; it comforts me in all my troubles.

<u>Psalms 3:1-3 (KJV)</u> - ¹A Psalms of David, when he fled from Absalom his son. LORD, how are they increased that trouble me! many are they that rise up against me. ²Many there be which say of my soul, There is no help for him in God. Selah. ³But thou, O LORD, art a shield for me; my glory, and the lifter up of mine head.

<u>Psalms 18:17-18 (KJV)</u> - ¹⁷He delivered me from my strong enemy, and from them which hated me: for they were too strong for me. ¹⁸They prevented me in the day of my calamity: but the LORD was my stay.

<u>Psalms 27:1-6 (KJV)</u> - ¹A Psalms of David. The LORD is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? the LORD is the strength of my life; of

whom shall I be afraid? ²When the wicked, even mine enemies and my foes, came upon me to eat up my flesh, they stumbled and fell. ³Though an host should encamp against me, my heart shall not fear: though war should rise against me, in this will I be confident. ⁴One thing have I desired of the LORD, that will I seek after; that I may dwell in the house of the LORD all the days of my life, to behold the beauty of the LORD, and to enquire in his temple. ⁵For in the time of trouble he shall hide me in his pavilion: in the secret of his tabernacle shall he hide me; he shall set me up upon a rock. ⁶And now shall mine head be lifted up above mine enemies round about me: therefore will I offer in his tabernacle sacrifices of joy; I will sing, yea, I will sing praises unto the LORD.

<u>Psalms 55:16-18 (KJV)</u> - ¹⁶As for me, I will call upon God; and the LORD shall save me. ¹⁷Evening, and morning, and at noon, will I pray, and cry aloud: and he shall hear my voice. ¹⁸He hath delivered my soul in peace from the battle that was against me: for there were many with me.

<u>Psalms 55:22 (KJV)</u> – Cast thy burden upon the LORD, and he shall sustain thee: he shall never suffer the righteous to be moved

<u>Psalms 56:9 (KJV)</u> – When I cry unto thee, then shall mine enemies turn back: this I know; for God is for me.

<u>Psalms 62:5-7 (KJV)</u> – ⁵My soul, wait thou only upon God; for my expectation is from him. ⁶He only is my rock and my salvation: he is my defence; I shall not be moved. ⁷In God is my salvation and my glory: the rock of my strength, and my refuge, is in God.

<u>Psalms 63:7-8 (KJV)</u> - ⁷Because thou hast been my help, therefore in the shadow of thy wings will I rejoice. ⁸My soul followeth hard after thee: thy right hand upholdeth me.

<u>Psalms 71:8 (KJV)</u> – Let my mouth be filled with thy praise and with thy honour all the day

<u>Psalms 71:16 (KJV)</u> – I will go in the strength of the LORD God: I will make mention of thy righteousness, even of thine only.

<u>Psalms 71:24 (KJV)</u> – My tongue also shall talk of thy righteousness all the day long: for they are confounded, for they are brought unto shame, that seek my hurt.

<u>Psalms 77:12 (KJV)</u> – I will meditate also of all thy work, and talk of thy doings.

<u>Psalms 118:5-6 (KJV)</u> - ⁵I called upon the LORD in distress: the LORD answered me, and set me in a large place. ⁶The LORD is on my side; I will not fear: what can man do unto me?

Psalms 121:1-8 (KJV) — ¹A Song of degrees. I will lift up mine eyes unto the hills, from whence cometh my help. ²My help cometh from the LORD, which made heaven and earth. ³He will not suffer thy foot to be moved: he that keepeth thee will not slumber. ⁴Behold, he that keepeth Israel shall neither slumber nor sleep. ⁵The LORD is thy keeper: the LORD is thy shade upon thy right hand. ⁶The sun shall not smite thee by day, nor the moon by night. ⁷The LORD shall preserve thee from all evil: he shall preserve thy soul. ⁸The LORD shall preserve thy going out and thy coming in from this time forth, and even for evermore.
