



I. Introduction: The Right Flow

- A. How we move along in life's journey.
- B. Our course – the path by which we follow daily to accomplish our course.
- C. Involves my mental state of mind – mindsets – thought patterns.
- D. Involves my daily activities – routine – ability to adjust.
- E. Involves my intake and outflow.
- F. We set the flow – it's a choice!**

Deuteronomy 30:19 (NLT) – *“Today I have given you the choice between life and death, between blessings and curses. Now I call on heaven and earth to witness the choice you make. Oh, that you would choose life, so that you and your descendants might live!”*

- G. As believers, there is a different flow proceeding from our life.

John 7:38 (NKJV) – *He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will flow rivers of living water.*

John 7:38 (AMP) – *He who believes in Me [who adheres to, trusts in, and relies on Me], as the Scripture has said, “From his innermost being will flow continually rivers of living water.”*

H. Their life will be a continual flow of LIFE.

- I. **Living Waters** – not dead – active – blessed – endless in the kingdom of God – *fresh – strong – efficient – powerful* – **The Right flow is a flow of life!**
- J. **As Life Flows/Proceeds from us** – it shows up in many different streams – *streams of love – compassion – joy – peace – faith.*



II. The Flow of Worship

A. Our life should be one of continual worship.

1. **Worship** – reverence and adoration expressed through various actions.
2. **One of the first flows that should began to manifest in and through our life is the flow of worship – flow of great adoration for God – the flow of great honor and reverence.**
3. **Out of the flow of worship is also the flow of gratitude and thanksgiving.**
4. **Hebrews 13:15 (NLT)** – *Therefore, let us offer through Jesus a continual sacrifice of praise to God, proclaiming our allegiance to his name.*

B. The Missing Flow of Worship

1. **There is a missing flow of gratitude.**
Gratitude = A readiness to show appreciation – acknowledgment
 - a. It is a positive emotion that involves being thankful and appreciative. *It is associated with several mental and physical health benefits.*
 - b. Expressed appreciation
2. **Cooperate Worship**
 - a. Worship is a participation event, not a show or display of talent for the purpose of appealing to your flesh.
 - b. Worship involves expression
 - Singing
 - Speaking/shouting
 - Playing musical instruments
 - Lifting of hands
 - Dancing

- Weeping/laughing/kneeling/bowing
- Worship may take on many expressions, but it is NEVER expressionless.
- We should daily EXPRESS our worship – our gratitude, thanksgiving, adoration, appreciation to God – BUT MORE SO WHEN WE COME TOGETHER FOR COOPERATE WORSHIP.

3. When the flow of worship is absence from your life – there will be an absence of the things God has provided for you.

C. John 4:19-24 (NKJV) – ¹⁹The woman said to Him, “Sir, I perceive that You are a prophet. ²⁰Our fathers worshiped on this mountain, and you Jews say that in Jerusalem is the place where one ought to worship.” ²¹Jesus said to her, “Woman, believe Me, the hour is coming when you will neither on this mountain, nor in Jerusalem, worship the Father. ²²You worship what you do not know; we know what we worship, for salvation is of the Jews. ²³But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him. ²⁴God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth.”****

1. There is coming a day when worship will be different.
2. Jesus is speaking of what will take place when BORN-AGAIN people worship him.
3. Saved people – who have a flow of life (Living Water) – proceeding from their life – will worship different.
4. Their worship not only is different in expression, but IT RELEASES SOMETHING – BECAUSE IT IS A LIVING FLOW.
5. My worship is a living flow – there is LIFE in my worship.
6. Worship should be flowing from my life – EVERYDAY – Several times a day – OFTEN – it should be a part of my life – MY FLOW.



D. The flow of worship proceeding from my life – releases the supernatural into your life.

The Bible is filled with examples of how worship was connected to supernatural results

1. Jehoshaphat

a. **2 Chronicles 20:22 (NKJV)** – *Now when they began to sing and to praise, the LORD set ambushes against the people of Ammon, Moab, and Mount Seir, who had come against Judah; and they were defeated.*

b. **2 Chronicles 20:22 (CEV)** – *As soon as they began singing, the LORD confused the enemy camp.*

If you want to confuse your enemy – let him see the FLOW of praise proceeding from your life.

c. **2 Chronicles 20:22 (GNT)** – *When they began to sing, the LORD threw the invading armies into a panic.*

Satan panics when God's people begin to praise in the midst of trials.

2. Paul and Silas

a. **Acts 16:25-26 (CEV)** – ²⁵*About midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing praises to God, while the other prisoners listened.* ²⁶*Suddenly a strong earthquake shook the jail to its foundations. The doors opened, and the chains fell from all the prisoners.*

b. **Notice, supernatural things occurred while they prayed and sang praises.**

c. **The passage doesn't denote that Paul and Silas had trouble stirring up praise in their lives.**

d. **Prayer and Praise were their flow!**

Since they had been praying and praising along their journeys, they just continued to let it FLOW regardless of the fact they had been beaten and were in jail.

e. **We need to cultivate such a flow of praise, that praise just FLOWS no matter our circumstances.**

Philippians 4:4 (NKJV) – *Rejoice in the Lord always. Again I will say, rejoice!*

3. **1 Samuel 16:23 (Brenton Septuagint Translation)** – *And it came to pass when the evil spirit was upon Saul, that David took his harp, and played with his hand: and Saul was refreshed, and it was well with him, and the evil spirit departed from him*
- Notice – in the presence of David’s worship, Saul was refreshed.
 - The evil spirit departed.
Evil spirits don’t like worship.
Evil spirits don’t hang around while you worship.
Evil spirits can’t work while you worship.

E. **Isaiah 61:3**

Paraphrased partial verse – The Lord says He will give them the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness.

Literal Standard – A covering of praise for a faded spirit

The Lord says – Putting on praise – should be like putting on a garment – clothes – REPLACE THE SPIRIT OF HEAVINESS!

- 1. Some people are always wearing the spirit of heaviness.**
- 2. The GARMENT of praise does away with the spirit of heaviness.**
- 3. Heaviness – Spirit of despair, disheartened spirit – spirit of fainting.**
The remedy – change your garment – change your flow.
If your flow is a continual flow of despair, fainting – PUT ON the garment of praise.
- 4. A garment is a covering.**
When I get up in the morning, I want to put on my covering of praise!
 - I am covered on the way to work.
 - I am covered at work.
 - I am covered at school.
 - I am covered if circumstances arise.

e. I am covered by the garment of praise.

F. Psalm 67:5-7 (NKJV) – ⁵*Let the peoples praise You, O God; Let all the peoples praise You.* ⁶*Then the earth shall yield her increase; God, our own God, shall bless us.* ⁷*God shall bless us, and all the ends of the earth shall fear Him.*

1. Praise causes increase – supernatural increase.

2. If you need some increase in your life – release the flow of worship.

III. Closing

A. My personal experience with worship and the supernatural. Worship and faith – worship and healing.

B. How do I cultivate the flow of worship in my life?

1. Start by increasing the flow in corporate worship: *Participation.*

2. Take your daily worship to a different level.

a. Start your day with simple thanksgiving

b. Do whatever necessary to praise the Lord often throughout your day.

- *Someone who was on the road all day, said they decided that every time they were stopped at a stoplight, they would worship.*

- *Others set a reminder on their phone – it's time to worship!*

- *Get creative!*

c. Once you get in the flow of daily worship, you will not have a problem remembering to worship. **IT WILL BECOME YOUR FLOW!**
It will bless your life!
