Deuteronomy 11:8-21 (NKJV) — 8"Therefore you shall keep every commandment which I command you today, that you may be strong, and go in and possess the land which you cross over to possess, 9 and that you may prolong your days in the land which the Lord swore to give your fathers, to them and their descendants, 'a land flowing with milk and honey.' 10 For the land which you go to possess is not like the land of Egypt from which you have come, where you sowed your seed and watered it by foot, as a vegetable garden; 11 but the land which you cross over to possess is a land of hills and valleys, which drinks water from the rain of heaven, 12 a land for which the Lord your God cares; the eyes of the Lord your God are always on it, from the beginning of the year to the very end of the year.

SKIP to vs 18 – ¹⁸"Therefore you shall lay up these words of mine in your heart and in your soul, and bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. ¹⁹You shall teach them to your children, speaking of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up. ²⁰And you shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates, ²¹that your days and the days of your children may be multiplied in the land of which the LORD swore to your fathers to give them, **like the days of the heavens above the earth.**

III. The Voice of Heaven

A. Whenever God moves, He does it through His Word.

Creation

- **1.** Genesis 1:3 (NKJV) And God said, let there by light
- 2. <u>Genesis 1:5(NKJV)</u> God called the light day and the darkness, he called light

Called = He wasn't just calling it what it was, He was CALLING IT – proclaiming it to be – appointing the light to be day and the darkness to be night.

- 3. God doesn't carry on with casual conversation. His VOICE/WORDs are authority, power, moving, creating, re-creating, organizing, fixing.
- 4. In creation, nothing moved until God said.
- 5. The flow of heaven is established by the voice of heaven/ God's voice His word.
- B. When God created the earth, He established it to hear and respond to the voice of heaven.
 - 1. Things on the earth are created to respond to His Words.



2. He put His words in the mouth of Adam

Genesis 1:26-28 (NKJV) – ²⁶Then God said, "Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth." ²⁷So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them. ²⁸Then God blessed them, and God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it; have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth.

Gensis 1:26-28 (CEV) – ²⁶God said, "Now we will make humans, and they will be like us. We will let them rule the fish, the birds, and all other living creatures." ²⁷So God created humans to be like himself; he made men and women. ²⁸God gave them his blessing and said: "Have a lot of children! Fill the earth with people and bring it under your control. Rule over the fish in the ocean, the birds in the sky, and every animal on the earth."

How did God subdue and exercise dominion when creating the earth? He used His voice – He did so by saying.

If Adam would be able to exercise dominion on the earth, he would have to use his voice – By WORDS!

Adam's assignment was to ESTABLISH and PROTECT the flow of heaven – to the earth.

- If anything were to get out of line, He was to be God's voice on earth.
- If anything needed correction...
- If anything needed attention...
- The Flow of heaven operates by VOICE/ WORDS.
 A voice with the right Words released through it.



- C. How did Jesus establish the flow of heaven on earth? His Voice/Words
 - 1. When a storm came "Peace Be Still"!
 - 2. When Lazarus needed to come out of the tomb "Lazarus Come Forth"
- D. The #1 priority of God when overcoming the FALL of the human race was to RE-ESTABLISH His VOICE in the earth.
 - 1. In the beginning God had said...and earth responded.
 - 2. Once God had given authority to mankind, and they sinned God needed to find a MAN in the earth who would be His voice.

 Someone would have to SAY what God wanted said if the flow of heaven would ever be re-established.
 - a. This is why whenever God began to deal with a person about a particular assignment, He had to get them to SPEAK in alignment with HIS plan.
 - Abraham could not bring forth Issaac, until he began to CALL HIMSELF the father of multitudes. This is why God changed His name. It wasn't just a name change GOD WAS USING ABRAHAM'S VOICE TO establish a flow in the earth.
 - b. God is always looking for someone to use their voice.

 Someone who will put HIS Word in their mouth. Whenever a person puts GODS word in their mouth they become the voice



- of heaven establishing and re-establishing the flow of heaven on earth.
- c. The first generation of Israelites who should have entered the promised land FAILED because they did not put HIS word in their mouth. They gave their VOICE to the wrong flow.

 Do not give your voice away!

 Do not allow the enemy to use your voice to establish His flow.

 Give your voice to God and establish the flow of heaven.
- **E.** Psalm 8:1-2 (NKJV) ¹O LORD, our Lord, How excellent is Your name in all the earth, who have set Your glory above the heavens! ²Out of the mouth of babes and nursing infants You have ordained strength, because of Your enemies, that You may silence the enemy and the avenger

<u>Psalm 8:1 (AMPC)</u> – Out of the mouths of babes and unweaned infants You have established strength because of Your foes, that You might silence the enemy and the avenger.

- Silence or STILL the enemy
 To cause to cease to put to an end
 To exterminate destroy
 To cause to fail.
- **2.** Notice, the key to the enemy's demise is coming from the MOUTH the voice WORDS!
- **F.** The Voice of the Lord Psalm 29
 - Vs 3 The voice of the Lord is over the waters



- Vs 4 The voice of the Lord is powerful and the voice of the Lord is full of majesty.
- Vs 5 the Voice of the Lord breaks the cedars
- Vs 7 the voice of the Lord divides the flames of fire
- Vs 8 the voice of the Lord shakes the wilderness
- Vs 9 The voice of the Lord makes the deer give birth

THE VOICE OF THE LORD IS IN THE STORM

IV. The Flow of Heaven on Earth is only established by those who will yield their VOICE – to HIS voice!

- I put His Words in my mouth!
- His words in my mouth change/transform/stop enemies/move obstacles/deal with circumstances/drive demons out/release healing.

A. It is a dangerous thing to become the wrong voice!

Psalm 81:11-16 (AMPC) – ¹¹But My people would not hearken to My voice, and Israel would have none of Me. ¹²So I gave them up to their own hearts' lust and let them go after their own stubborn will, that they might follow their own counsels. ¹³Oh, that My people would listen to Me, that Israel would walk in My ways! ¹⁴Speedily then I would subdue their enemies and turn My hand against their adversaries. ¹⁵[Had Israel listened to Me in Egypt, then] those who hated the Lord would have come cringing before Him, and their defeat would have lasted forever. ¹⁶[God] would feed [Israel now] also with the finest of the wheat; and with honey out of the rock would I satisfy you

Numbers 14:26-28 (NKJV) - ²⁶And the LORD spoke to Moses and Aaron, saying, ²⁷"How long shall I bear with this evil congregation who complain against Me? I have heard the complaints which the children of Israel make against Me. ²⁸Say to them, 'As I live,' says the LORD, 'just as you have spoken in My hearing, so I will do to you:



Numbers 14:26-28 (NIV) - ²⁶The LORD said to Moses and Aaron: ²⁷"How long will this wicked community grumble against me? I have heard the complaints of these grumbling Israelites. ²⁸So tell them, 'As surely as I live, declares the LORD, I will do to you the very thing I heard you say

B. Yield your voice

Ezekiel 37:1-14 (NKJV) – ¹The hand of the Lord came upon me and brought me out in the Spirit of the Lord, and set me down in the midst of the valley; and it was full of bones. ²Then He caused me to pass by them all around, and behold, there were very many in the open valley; and indeed they were very dry. ³And He said to me, "Son of man, can these bones live?" So I answered, "O Lord God, You know." ⁴Again He said to me, "Prophesy to these bones, and say to them, 'O dry bones, hear the word of the Lord! 5Thus says the Lord God to these bones: "Surely I will cause breath to enter into you, and you shall live. ⁶I will put sinews on you and bring flesh upon you, cover you with skin and put breath in you; and you shall live. Then you shall know that I am the LORD."" ⁷So I prophesied as I was commanded; and as I prophesied, there was a noise, and suddenly a rattling; and the bones came together, bone to bone. ⁸Indeed, as I looked, the sinews and the flesh came upon them, and the skin covered them over; but there was no breath in them. ⁹Also He said to me, "Prophesy to the breath, prophesy, son of man, and say to the breath, 'Thus says the Lord God: "Come from the four winds, O breath, and breathe on these slain, that they may live." So I prophesied as He commanded me, and [b]breath came into them, and they lived, and stood upon their feet, an exceedingly great army. 11 Then He said to me, "Son of man, these bones are the whole house of Israel. They indeed say, 'Our bones are dry, our hope is lost, and we ourselves are cut off!' ¹²Therefore prophesy and say to them, 'Thus says the Lord God: "Behold, O My people, I will open your graves and cause you to come up from your graves, and bring you into the land of Israel. ¹³Then you shall know that I am the Lord, when I have opened your graves, O My people, and brought you up from your graves. ¹⁴I will put My Spirit in you, and you



shall live, and I will place you in your own land. Then you shall know that I, the Lord, have spoken it and performed it," says the Lord.'"

NIV – speak a prophetic message

CEV – He then told me to say: Dry bones, listen to what the LORD is saying to you

Prophecy = speak or sing by inspiration

Numbers 11:25 (NKJV) – And the LORD came down in a cloud, and spake unto him, and took of the spirit that was upon him, and gave it unto the seventy elders: and it came to pass, that, when the spirit rested upon them, they prophesied, and did not cease

C. John's voice

Isaiah 40:-8 (NKJV) — 1"Comfort, yes, comfort My people!" says your God. 2"Speak [a]comfort to Jerusalem, and cry out to her, that her warfare is ended, that her iniquity is pardoned; for she has received from the Lord's hand double for all her sins." 3The voice of one crying in the wilderness: "Prepare the way of the Lord; make straight [b]in the desert a highway for our God. 4Every valley shall be exalted and every mountain and hill brought low; the crooked places shall be made straight and the rough places smooth; 5The glory of the Lord shall be revealed, and all flesh shall see it together; for the mouth of the Lord has spoken." 6The voice said, "Cry out!" and he said, "What shall I cry?" "All flesh is grass, and all its loveliness is like the flower of the field. 7The grass withers, the flower fades, because the breath of the Lord blows upon it; surely the people are grass. 8The grass withers, the flower fades, but the word of our God stands forever."
