Session 5 – "The Fruit of Patience"

Galatians 5:16-23 (NKJV) – ¹⁶ I say then: Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh. ¹⁷ For the flesh lusts against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; and these are contrary to one another, so that you do not do the things that you wish. ¹⁸ But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law. ¹⁹ Now the works of the flesh are evident, which are: ^[a]adultery, ^[b]fornication, uncleanness, lewdness, ²⁰ idolatry, sorcery, hatred, contentions, jealousies, outbursts of wrath, selfish ambitions, dissensions, heresies, ²¹ envy, ^[c]murders, drunkenness, revelries, and the like; of which I tell you beforehand, just as I also told you in time past, that <u>those who</u> <u>practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God.</u> ²² But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, ²³ [d]</sup>gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law.

II. The Fruit of Patience

- **A.** <u>James 1:4 (KJV)</u> But let patience have her perfect work, that ye may be perfect and entire, wanting nothing.
 - 1. James speaks of patience having an important role in our life.
 - 2. Make patience your friend
 - 3. When patience is developed and has gone FULL TERM you will be mature, whole, lacking nothing

- 4. <u>Hebrews 10:36 (KJV)</u> For ye have need of patience, that, after ye have done the will of God, ye might receive the promise.
- 5. <u>Hebrews 6:12 (NIV)</u> We do not want you to become lazy, but to imitate those who through faith and patience inherit what has been promised.
- 6. Patience is a KEY FACTOR in possessing our inheritance

B. Patience goes against the Flesh

- 1. The flesh doesn't like to WAIT on anyone or anything
- 2. The FRUIT of the SPIRIT is patience
- 3. Impatience is a work of the Flesh
- 4. Developing and following the fruit of patience will keep you out of trouble
- 5. The Kingdom of God doesn't work like a convenience store or a microwave.
- 6. Kingdom things Things from God TAKE TIME
- 7. The FRUIT of PATIENCE keeps us from missing God!
- 8. There are many things that we miss because we are not willing to wait on the Lord.
- C. <u>2 Peter 1:5-6 (KJV)</u> ⁵And beside this, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue; and to virtue knowledge; ⁶And to knowledge temperance; and to temperance patience; and to patience godliness;
 - 1. Faith is our foundation
 - 2. We are to ADD to our foundation
 - 3. Patience is to be added to our faith
 - 4. Faith requires the fruit of patience to get results
 - 5. Faith without patience will fall short prior to seeing the manifestation.
 - a. Healing faith requires patience
 - b. Specific needs being met requires patience
 - c. Open doors require patience
 - d. Promotion requires patience



- 6. Faith and Patience working together see things through until the manifestation comes
- 7. <u>Hebrews 10:23 (KJV)</u> Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; (for he is faithful that promised; HOLD FAST
- 8. Don't let the clock or calendar get involved in your faith! We must get our eyes off o the clock and calendar if we are to receive the promise!

D. Why Patience?

1. Hindrances from Satan

- a. <u>**1 Thessalonians 2:18 (KJV)**</u> Wherefore we would have come unto you, even I Paul, once and again; but Satan hindered us.
- b. <u>Romans 15:22 (KJV)</u> For which cause also I have been much hindered from coming to you.
- c. Satan can't stop us, but he will attempt to hinder us
- d. Satan's #1 way of stopping you is to go after the Word in your heart, IF he can steal the word from your heart, he stops your faith – If he stops your faith – you never receive your manifestation of your faith.
- e. Satan will talk you out of your miracle by pointing out that nothing seems to be happening.
- f. BE PATIENT and refuse to allow Satan to distract you by his lies.
- g. Paul says often We are not moved by the hindrances that have been set before us!
- h. <u>2 Corinthians 2:14 (KJV)</u> Now thanks be unto God, which always causeth us to triumph in Christ, and maketh manifest the savour of his knowledge by us in every place.

2. Hindrances from Circumstances

- a. Paul encountered many circumstances (Storms, imprisonments, etc)
- b. Paul never gave up, but always believed for God's plan to prevail
- c. If circumstances come, Don't quit!
- d. Quitting is not an option.





e. You will need the fruit of patience to deal with the circumstances of life

3. Waiting on God's Perfect Plan and His Timing

- a. Abraham and Sarah created an Ishmael because of a lack of faith and patience
- b. Impatience will cause you to PUSH wrong doors open
- c. Impatience will put you in the WRONG place
- d. Impatience will cause you to miss God's best
- e. The fruit of patience will allow you to wait on God's best
- f. How many of you have missed God because you lacked the fruit of patience?
