Experiencing Heaven's Daily Flow

I. Text Scriptures

Deuteronomy 11:8-21 (NKJV) – ⁸“Therefore you shall keep every commandment which I command you today, that you may **be strong, and go in and possess the land** which you cross over to possess, ⁹and that you may **prolong your days in the land which the LORD** swore to give your fathers, to them and their descendants, ‘**a land flowing with milk and honey.**’ ¹⁰For the land which you go to possess is not like the land of Egypt from which you have come, where you sowed your seed and watered it by foot, as a vegetable garden; ¹¹but the land which you cross over to possess is a land of hills and valleys, which **drinks water from the rain of heaven,** ¹²**a land for which the LORD your God cares; the eyes of the LORD your God are always on it, from the beginning of the year to the very end of the year.**

SKIP to vs 18 – ¹⁸“Therefore you shall lay up these words of mine in your heart and in your soul, and bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. ¹⁹You shall teach them to your children, speaking of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up. ²⁰And you shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates, ²¹that your days and the days of your children may be multiplied in the land of which the LORD swore to your fathers to give them, **like the days of the heavens above the earth.**

III. Experiencing Heaven's Daily Flow

A. The flow of heaven is re-established in our life the day we are born again.

B. This is not to be our only experience with heaven's flow of grace. We are to be connected to heaven and experiencing heaven DAILY.

1. The daily flow of heaven is connected to our growth and maturity.
2. The daily flow of heaven is our source of strength for living here.
3. The daily flow of heaven is our source of provision for life.

Matthew 6:33 (KJV) – *But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.*

4. The daily flow of heaven keeps us from the curse and opens the door of covenant blessing over our life.

The curse is in the earth (Deut 28).

Although we are redeemed from the Curse – (Gal 3:13) the curse is always at work in the earth, looking for an opportunity to get on us.

Staying in the DAILY flow of heaven – *drives out the curse – closes the door to the curse – CREATES CURSE FREE LIVING in the life of the believer.*



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C. The Bible speaks of the significance of the daily flow.

1. **Matthew 6:11 (NKJV)** – *Give us this day our daily bread.*

Matthew 6:11 (LSV) – *Give us today our appointed bread.*

Note: God has DAILY bread/resources/supply for us. He says that we should ask/pray for the DAILY supply. This means you must be engaging in DAILY prayer if you are to access TODAY's/DAILY bread.

Failure to access what God has provided for TODAY will leave us lacking in something that God knew we would have need of.

2. **Psalms 68:19 (NKJV)** – *Blessed be the Lord, who daily loads us with benefits, the God of our salvation!*

Psalms 68:19 (DBT) – *Blessed be the Lord: day by day doth he load us [with good], the God who is our salvation.*

Pastor's Note: God has benefits to release DAILY! If you are only coming to Him on a Sunday flow – you are only getting one day's benefits. If you are only coming to him on Christmas and Easter – you are only getting two days benefits and leaving out 363 other days of benefits. YOU ARE COMING UP SHORT OF HEAVENS SUPPLY.

Stay in the DAILY flow.

3. **Lamentations 3:22-23 (KJV)** – ²²*It is of the LORD's mercies that we are not consumed, because his compassions fail not.* ²³*They are new every morning: great is thy faithfulness.*

D. The daily flow of heaven is available to every believer, but not everyone is participating in it.

In position He is close to us, in fellowship He is not!



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1. Pastor's Word from the Lord.

Many of my people are weak and limited because they are failing to access my daily flow that I have made available to them. There is no drought or famine of my provision, just failure to partake. These last days will require a strong daily flow if you are to stay connected to heaven's life flow. Do not fail to partake in the daily flow. It will keep you in heaven's flow and heaven's flow will protect you from the dangers that are coming upon the land.

2. Paul spoke of **Carnal Christians** in Corinthians.

He did not address them as unsaved people but saved people who were still living as they did prior to being saved.

They accessed the BASE LEVEL flow of heaven for salvation, but they were not accessing the DAILY FLOW of heaven that would mature them to spiritual adulthood.

IV. The Benefit of the Daily Flow

A. Psalm 1:1-3 (NKJV) – ¹*Blessed is the man who walks not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor stands in the path of sinners, nor sits in the seat of the scornful;* ²*but his delight is in the law of the LORD, **and in His law he meditates day and night.*** ³*He shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that brings forth its fruit in its season, whose leaf also shall not wither; and whatever he does shall prosper*

Note: A withering leaf indicates that there is no flow of water or nourishment.

The man or woman who is saved but does not stay connected to the fresh waters of heaven and the Word as heaven's bread – WILL WITHER!



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1. **Wither** = become dry and shriveled – droop – fade – dwindle
A result of being **SAPLESS**
Bible Def – Leanness of soul
2. Why? He is not planted - established – connected – abiding – dwelling

B. Jeremiah 17:7-8 (NKJV) – ⁷Blessed is the man who trusts in the LORD, and whose hope is the LORD. ⁸For he shall be like a tree planted by the waters, which spreads out its roots by the river, **and will not fear** when heat comes; **but its leaf will be green, and will not be anxious** in the year of drought, **nor will cease from yielding fruit.**

Notice the benefits of being planted.

C. Psalm 92:13-14 (NKJV) – ¹³Those who are planted in the house of the LORD shall flourish in the courts of our God. ¹⁴They shall still bear fruit in old age; they shall be fresh and flourishing

Psalm 92:13-14 (AMPC) – ¹³Planted in the house of the Lord, they shall flourish in the courts of our God. ¹⁴[Growing in grace] they shall still bring forth fruit in old age; they shall be full of sap [of spiritual vitality] and [rich in the] verdure [of trust, love, and contentment]

D. Spiritual things must be kept stirred up.

Timothy

1 Timothy 1:6-7 (NKJV) – ⁶Therefore I remind you to **stir up the gift of God** which is in you through the laying on of my hands. ⁷For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.

Note: We know from Paul's other statements that Timothy was in a personal battle with fear and intimidation. Paul gives Timothy the remedy for fear – STIR UP THE GIFT!



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1. *Timothy had not been keeping the gift stirred.*
2. *Timothy had neglected the daily flow of heaven that would have kept spiritual things stirred up.*
3. *By neglecting the daily flow of heaven/stirring the things of God up/ - Timothy had opened the door for the enemy to use fear against him.*
4. *When we fail to partake in the daily flow of heaven spiritual things in our life are not stirred up.*
5. *When spiritual things are not stirred up, we leave an opening for the enemy to have access to our life.*

V. Closing

Partake of the daily flow of heaven!

- A. Pray, read, and mediate in God's Word.
- B. Do not be distracted, too busy, or neglectful of spiritual things.
- C. Be sure to keep spiritual things stirred up.
- D. If you slack up, make a course correction quickly and get back in His daily flow.
