

Fruit of the Spirit Session 7 – "Kindness and Goodness"

Galatians 5:16-23 (NKJV) -

¹⁶ I say then: Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh.
¹⁷ For the flesh lusts against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; and these are contrary to one another, so that you do not do the things that you wish.
¹⁸ But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law.

¹⁹ Now the works of the flesh are evident, which are: ^[a]adultery, ^[b]fornication, uncleanness, lewdness, ²⁰ idolatry, sorcery, hatred, contentions, jealousies, outbursts of wrath, selfish ambitions, dissensions, heresies, ²¹ envy, ^[c]murders, drunkenness, revelries, and the like; of which I tell you beforehand, just as I also told *you* in time past, that <u>those who</u> <u>practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God.</u>

²² But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, <u>faithfulness</u>, ²³ ^[d]gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law.

I. REVIEW

A. Previous weeks – The fruit of love, joy, peace, patience and faithfulness

II. The Fruit of Kindness

- A. God flows with ALL of the manifestations of the fruit of the Spirit
 - 1. God flows in love, joy, peace, patience and faithfulness
- B. Examples of the loving kindness of God
 - 1. Psalm 63:3 (KJV) Because thy lovingkindness is better than life, my lips shall praise thee.



- Psalm 117:2 (KJV) For his merciful kindness is great toward us: and the truth of the LORD endureth for ever. Praise ye the LORD.
 - a. The kindness of God is demonstrated in his Mercy
 - b. He his merciful not judgmental.
- 3. Nehemiah 9:17 (KJV) And refused to obey, neither were mindful of thy wonders that thou didst among them; but hardened their necks, and in their rebellion appointed a captain to return to their bondage: but thou art a God ready to pardon, gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness, and forsookest them not
- 4. Luke 6:35 (KJV) But love ye your enemies, and do good, and lend, hoping for nothing again; and your reward shall be great, and ye shall be the children of the Highest: for he is kind unto the unthankful and to the evil.
 - a. Notice God is kind to the unthankful and to those who are evil.
- 5. Jeremiah 31:3 (KJV) The LORD hath appeared of old unto me, saying, Yea, I have loved thee with an everlasting love: therefore with lovingkindness have I drawn thee
 - a. The character of God is revealed in his kindness
 - b. His kindness is a drawing card
 - c. Romans 2:4 (KJV) Or despisest thou the riches of his goodness and forbearance and longsuffering; not knowing that the goodness of God leadeth thee to repentance?
 - d. God demonstrates HIS kindness through US to draw people to himself.
 - e. By YIELDING to the fruit of Kindness, God is able to use us to ATTRACT others
 - f. A lack of YIELDING to the fruit of kindness becomes a stumbling block.
- C. What does the Bible say about the Church being kind?



- 2 Corinthians 6:4-6 (KJV) ⁴But in all things <u>approving</u> <u>ourselves as the ministers of God</u>, in much patience, in afflictions, in necessities, in distresses, ⁵In stripes, in imprisonments, in tumults, in labours, in watchings, in fastings; ⁶By pureness, by knowledge, by longsuffering, by kindness, by the Holy Ghost, by love unfeigned a. Kindness is supposed to be an attribute of ministers of God
- Ephesians 4:32 (KJV) And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you.
 - a. Paul gave this directive to the church BE KIND!
 - b. Others are not built up by being harsh but by being kind.
- **D.** Practice = development of the fruit of kindness
 - 1. The best place to develop kindness is the place where people may be unkind to you
 - 2. Proverbs 15:1 (KJV) A soft answer turneth away wrath: but grievous words stir up anger.
 - **3.** Determine to be kind even when you are tested and pushed to the limit.
 - **4.** To manifest kindness is to manifest Jesus It is always better to manifest Jesus rather than your flesh.
- E. Kindness Definition = fair speech good words gracious and useful
 - 1. Kind words make us useful for the kingdom
 - 2. Harsh, mean, rude words make us less useful to the kingdom

III. The Fruit of Goodness

A. Definition –

- 1. Favor, bountiful, welfare, gracious, the best Old Testament
- 2. Benefit, virtue , benevolence New Testament
- 3. Goodness is the state of being and acts of benevolence that benefit others.



- 4. Kindness is more the attitude and manner in which goodness is demonstrated.
- 5. The fruits of Kindness and Goodness almost always work together

B. Scriptures about the Goodness of God

- Exodus 34:6 (KJV) And the LORD passed by before him, and proclaimed, The LORD, The LORD God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abundant in goodness and truth,
- 2. **Psalm 34:8 (KJV)** O taste and see that the LORD is good: blessed is the man that trusteth in him.
- 3. **Psalm 136:1 (KJV)** O give thanks unto the LORD; for he is good: for his mercy endureth for ever
- 4. Kindness is God's attitude toward people
- 5. Goodness is His acts toward people

C. We need to receive His Goodness

- 1. **Psalm 27:13 (KJV)** I had fainted, unless I had believed to see the goodness of the LORD in the land of the living.
- Psalm 23:6 (KJV) Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life: and I will dwell in the house of the LORD for eve
 All of my days are SENTENCE with GOODNESS not evil

D. We manifest God by ACTS of goodness

- 1. One ACT of goodness manifest all of the various aspects of the fruit of the Spirit
- 2. Eph 2:10 Declares that we are created in HIS workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for GOOD WORKS WORKS OF GOODNESS
- 3. Matthew 5:44-45 (KJV) ⁴⁴But I say unto you, Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you; ⁴⁵That ye may be the children of your Father which is in heaven: for he maketh his sun to rise on the evil and on the good, and sendeth rain on the just and on the unjust
- 4. If you want to make a difference in a bad situation or a bad relationship, DO SOMETHING GOOD!
- 5. Practice ACTS of GOODNESS as the Lord leads you!
