# TAKE YOUR AUTHORITY

Lesson 1 – We're in a Spiritual Battle

#### I. SERIES INTRODUCTION

#### A. Objective

- 1. To gain a biblical understanding of our authority as believers.
- 2. To learn how to recognize who our real enemy is and how to resist and defeat him every time.
- B. WHY DOES THE CHURCH NEED TO BE TAUGHT ABOUT AUTHORITY?
  - 1. Understanding our authority will empower us to have victory in every area of life.
    - a. No knowledge, no power
    - b. God said, "My people are destroyed for the lack of knowledge." Hosea 4:6
  - 2. Satan's number one concern is keeping the church ignorant of who we are, what we have & what we can do.
  - 3. An ignorant church is a powerless church/An ignorant believer is a powerless believer.

## **II. LESSON INTRODUCTION:**

Example: Demon possessed child

# **James 4:7 (AMP)** – So **submit** to [the authority of] God. **Resist the devil** [stand firm against him] and **he will flee from you.**

A. The boy whom the disciples could not heal.

## Matthew 17:14-21 (NKJV)

- 1. Jesus called them faithless
- 2. He rebuked the demon & it came out
- 3. The disciples asked why they couldn't cast it out

- 4. Jesus responded, "Because of your unbelief"
  - a. This kind does not go out except by prayer and fasting

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- b. "This kind" not this kind of devil, this kind of unbelief
- 5. Understanding our AUTHORITY will activate the faith we need to move mountains, cast out demons, and live in victory.

# III. AUTHORITY OVER THE DEVIL BELONGS TO ALL WHO BELIEVE

- A. We received authority when we were born again.
- B. Our authority is backed up by the name of Jesus.
- C. "These signs shall follow them that believe" Mark 16:18
  - a. IN MY NAME THEY SHALL....
  - b. The authority is in His name
  - c. The Word is the weapon that enforces our authority

# IV. WE'RE IN A SPIRITUAL BATTLE (Lesson Title) Ephesians 6:10-18

- A. Our battle is not with flesh and blood
  - 1. Our fight isn't against people, but the spiritual forces that are influencing them.
- B. This is not a physical battle
  - 1. Understanding this will change the way we respond

# V. SATAN USES PEOPLE

Anyone can let themselves be used by the enemy

- A. Jesus asks His disciples, "Who do men say that I am".
  - 1. They answered John the Baptist, Elijah, Jeremiah or one of the great prophets
- B. Jesus asked, "But who do you say I am?"
  - 1. Peter under the influence of God responded:

# "Thou are the Christ, the Son of the Living God" (Matthew 16:16)

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- 2. Jesus affirmed Peter:
- "Blessed art thou Simon Barjona:
- "Thou art Peter and upon this rock (this insight) I will build my church and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it"
- C. Jesus begins to explain about the crucifixion and Peter rebukes him (**Matthew 16:22**)
- D. Jesus recognized it was the enemy speaking through him (<u>Matthew 16:23</u>) "Get thee behind me Satan!"
- E. We need to recognize that Satan as well as God can speak through and use people in our lives

#### VI. IN THIS BATTLE ACTIONS ARE IMPORTANT

Before you act, realize that spiritual forces are at work

- A. When you get angry at someone and you vent anger, frustration, resentment or unforgiveness it affects YOU.
- B. **James 1:20** says, "The wrath of man worketh not the righteousness of God.
  - a. You will never accomplish God's purposes by acting out by getting in the flesh, giving in to anger and losing your temper
- C. **James 3:16** Where envying and strife is, there is confusion and **every evil work.** 
  - a. Envy and Strife open the door wide for the enemy, making you a target for his attack.
  - b. Guard your actions and the way you respond
  - c. Anger, venting, griping and complaining attract the devil like trash draws flies and rats.

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# **VII. SPIRITUAL DYNAMICS**

Dynamics definition – Forces at work You need to learn to recognize the spiritual dynamics happening in your life.

- A. You're either submitting to God and His influence or to Satan and his influence.
- B. Your actions release spiritual power into your life God's power or the devil's.

#### VIII. GOD IS THE GOD OF PEACE, NOT CONFUSION

**<u>1</u>** Corinthians 14:33 God is not the author of confusion, but of peace.

- A. If God is not the author of confusion, who is?
- B. <u>Romans 15:33</u> and 16:20 says he's a God of peace and <u>Galatians 5:22</u> says that peace is the fruit of the spirit Then we should make every effort to walk in peace and keep strife out!
- C. **Strife:** trouble, conflict, discord, contention, fighting, friction Strife is much more deadly than a poisonous snake!
- D. Envy & Strife are inroads that allow the devil access to your life
- E. We've got to wake up and realize that we are in a spiritual battle
  - IT'S TIME FOR US TO KNOW OUR ENEMY
  - KNOW HOW TO DEFEAT HIM
  - KNOW THE AUTHORITY WE HAVE BEEN GIVEN
  - TAKE THAT AUTHORITY
