- I. Opening Scriptures Scriptures relating to our authority.
 - **A.** <u>Psalm 91:13 (NKJV)</u> You shall tread upon the lion and the cobra, the young lion and the serpent you shall trample underfoot.
 - **B.** <u>Luke 10:19 (NKJV)</u> Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you
 - **1.** The lion, cobra, serpent, scorpion all represent the power of Satan.
 - 2. Jesus clarifies by stating "Over all the power of the enemy".
 - **3.** Serpents bite scorpions sting some are damaging some are deadly.
 - **4.** The Word of God is clearly stating YOU ARE GOING TO HAVE A GREATER POWER than that of the enemy.
 - 5. Whatever Satan has stung you with you have power over it.
 - 6. Whatever he has bitten you with you are victorious against it.
 - 7. HE HAS GIVEN US AUTHORITY OVER ALL THE POWER OF THE ENEMY.
- II. We can tread upon all the power of because Jesus already defeated Satan.
 - A. Our victory is not of ourselves. It is freely given to us because of what Jesus did.
 - B. What has Jesus done for us?
 - **1.** <u>Isaiah 10:27 (KJV)</u> And it shall come to pass in that day, that his burden shall be taken away from off thy shoulder, and his yoke from off thy neck, and the yoke shall be destroyed because of the anointing.



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<u>Isaiah 10:27 (NLT)</u> – In that day the LORD will end the bondage of his people. He will break the yoke of slavery and lift it from their shoulders.

- a. This is a type and a shadow of what Jesus will do.
- b. He is the anointing He is the anointed one.
- c. He began his ministry with a declaration.

The spirit of the Lord is upon me...

He has anointed me...

To preach the gospel to the poor...

To Heal the brokenhearted...

To proclaim liberty to the captives...

The recovery of sight to the blind...

To set at liberty those who are oppressed...

To proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord.

2. <u>1 John 3:8 (NKJV)</u> – He who sins is of the devil, for the devil has sinned from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil.

Destroy =

- a. to lose any person tied or fastened to anything
- b. to lose one bound to UNBIND
- c. to release from bonds set free
- d. to discharge to let go
- e. to dissolve anything bound
- f. to Annul
- g. to break to demolish to destroy
- h. TO UNDO
- <u>1 John 3:8 (Weymouth Translation)</u> The Son of God appeared for the purpose of undoing the work of the Devil.
- 3. Jesus came to UNDO everything Satan has done, is doing, is attempting to do or planning to do in our lives.



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- 4. For this to work in our life, we must come to a greater revelation of the things that Satan has done or is doing.
 - a. Too many in the church are confused about this.
 - b. We often blame God for things He has nothing to do with.
 - c. Some have given God credit for sickness, weakness, poverty, tragedy when He had nothing to do with it!
- **5.** <u>Acts 10:38 (NKJV)</u> How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.

<u>Acts 10:38 (Aramaic)</u> – He was traveling and healing those injured by The Evil One, because God was with him.

<u>Acts 10:38 (GWT)</u> – healing everyone who was under the devil's power.

- a. This scriptures attributes sickness to the devil.
- b. Sickness is oppression.
- c. Oppression to exercise dominion or control over.
- d. Sickness controls -
 - controls what you do;
 - where you go;
 - your strength;
 - your joy;
 - your peace;
 - your finances.
- e. <u>JESUS WENT ABOUT UNDOING everything Satan had established</u> and set into motion
- **6.** <u>Luke 13:16 (NKJV)</u> And ought not this woman, being a daughter of Abraham, whom Satan hath bound, lo, these eighteen years, be loosed from this bond on the sabbath day?
 - a. **Jesus makes it clear that Satan was behind her illness.**It was not a blessing from the Lord.
 It was not something God was using to teach her something.



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It was a direct bondage from the devil.

JESUS ONLY Had one response — LOOSE HER!

b. Jesus UNDID what Satan had started 18 years prior in the life of this woman.

He did not question her to see if she did something to bring this upon herself.

He did not exam her to see if she were worthy to receive healing. He simply came to undo what Satan had done in her life.

c. Whatever SICKNESS/BONDAGE is attaching itself to you today – It is not from God -

It is from the Devil.

Jesus only has one response – BE LOOSED – BE FREE! Jesus came to UNDO everything that Satan has done, is doing or attempting to do in your life!

- C. We must tread upon the power of the enemy.
 - 1. We do the treading.

Trample – Tread; Crush with our feet; To advance by setting foot upon; to strike; to smite

- 2. <u>Joshua 1:3-6 (NKJV)</u> ³Every place that the sole of your foot will tread upon I have given you, as I said to Moses. ⁴From the wilderness and this Lebanon as far as the great river, the River Euphrates, all the land of the Hittites, and to the Great Sea toward the going down of the sun, shall be your territory. ⁵No man shall be able to stand before you all the days of your life; as I was with Moses, so I will be with you. I will not leave you nor forsake you. ⁶Be strong and of good courage, for to this people you shall divide as an inheritance the land which I swore to their fathers to give them
 - a. It is given it is potentially yours but you must tread/trample if it is going to be experiential.
 - b. Put your foot down = Put your foot on it!



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III. Closing Thoughts

- A. Through redemption, Jesus has undone the works of Satan.
 - 1. Reversed beaten him foiled his plan

 Jesus brought a devastating setback to Satan's plans.
 - 2. Redemption The action of being saved from evil.

 The action of regaining possession of something by payment or clearing of a debt.
 - a. Jesus cleared the sin debt.
 - b. Jesus paid the price to for the Father to regain possession of the human race.
 - c. He paid a debt He did not owe I owed a debt, I could not pay I needed someone to wash my sins away and now I sing a brandnew song AMAZING grace all day long Christ Jesus paid a debt that I could never pay.
- B. We must possess what has been provided.
 - 1. Faith
 - 2. Action Trampling on the power of the enemy.
 - a. Action showing up to gain knowledge.
 - b. Participation when prayer is offered.
 - c. Resistance to everything the enemy is attempting to place upon you.
 - d. Standing in faith to receive vs being moved by the conditions.
