I. INTRODUCTION

A. The Blood of Jesus Is Foundational to Our Christian Faith!

1. Scriptures

a. Hebrews 9:22

NKJV “And according to the law almost all things are purified with blood, and without shedding of blood there is no remission.”

AMP “In fact under the Law almost everything is cleansed with blood, and without the shedding of blood there is no forgiveness [neither release from sin and its guilt, nor cancellation of the merited punishment].”

b. Ephesians 1:7

NKJV “In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace.”

GWT “Through the blood of his Son, we are set free from our sins. God forgives our failures because of his overflowing kindness.”

c. Ephesians 2:13

NKJV “But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ.”

d. Colossians 1:13-14

NKJV “He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed *us* into the kingdom of the Son of His love, in whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins.”

B. The Work of the Blood in the Life of the Believer

1. We are cleansed from sin.

a. 1 John 1:7

NKJV “But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin.”

2. We are made righteous.

a. Romans 5:9

HCSB “Much more then, since we have now been declared righteous by His blood, we will be saved through Him from wrath.”

3. We have been given access to God.

a. **Hebrews 10:19-22**

NKJV “Therefore, brethren, having boldness to enter the Holiest **by the blood of Jesus**, by a new and living way which He consecrated for us, through the veil, that is, His flesh, and *having* a High Priest over the house of God, let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.”

TPT “And now we are brothers and sisters in God’s family because of the blood of Jesus, and he welcomes us to come into the most holy sanctuary in the heavenly realm—boldly and without hesitation. For he has dedicated a new, life-giving way for us to approach God. For just as the veil was torn in two, Jesus’ body was torn open to give us free and fresh access to him! And since we now have a magnificent High Priest to welcome us into God’s house, we come closer to God and approach him with an open heart, fully convinced that nothing will keep us at a distance from him. For our hearts have been sprinkled with blood to remove impurity, and we have been freed from an accusing conscience. Now we are clean, unstained, and presentable to God inside and out!”

II. **THE HELP OF THE BLOOD IN THE LIFE OF THE BELIEVER**

The blood was applied once for our redemption, but its power continues to flow. It is not only the means by which we were saved, but the ongoing provision through which God continually supplies every grace and every help the believer needs each day.

A. **Daily Awareness**

1. Every believer should live with a continual consciousness of the blood's ongoing help and provision.
2. When I need help, I start with the awareness of the blood.

3. The blood helps me remain aware of:
 - a. My righteousness
 - b. My forgiveness
 - c. My free access to the Father
 - d. My position in Christ
 - e. My authority
 - f. My rights
 - Whatever rights I have to approach God and to act in His name are all provided through the blood!

B. The Blood Helps Silence the Enemy

1. The blood speaks on my behalf.
2. **Hebrews 12:24**
NKJV “And to Jesus the mediator of the new covenant, and to the blood of sprinkling, that speaketh better things than *that of Abel.*”
 - a. Abel’s blood cried out condemnation and for justice.
 - b. Jesus’ blood cries out for mercy.
3. When my enemy is accusing me, the blood of Jesus cries out for the MERCIES OF GOD on my behalf.

C. The Blood Frees Me from Condemnation and Empowers Me to Approach God with Boldness

1. **Hebrews 10:19** “We have boldness to enter or approach God.”
2. **Ephesians 3:12 NKJV** “...in whom we have boldness and access with confidence through faith in Him.”

D. Rely on the HELP of the Blood

1. Make it your daily practice to place your confidence in the blood of Jesus, not in your performance. Whenever your focus shifts to yourself, redirect it to the blood. The blood is the basis of your confidence.

2. How to practice relying on the blood for help:
 - a. Practice coming boldly to God.
 - b. Practice rejecting condemnation.
 - c. Spend time praising God for the blood.
 - d. Speak “the blood” against accusations of the enemy.
 - e. Declare “I claim the blood” in the assaults of the enemy.

E. Daily Confession

“Today I place my confidence in the blood of Jesus, not in my own performance. His blood has forgiven me, made me righteous, and brought me near to God. I walk free from condemnation, full of peace, boldness, and victory. The blood of Jesus is enough for me today.

In the name of Jesus, I stand under the power of His precious blood. The blood of Jesus speaks on my behalf and silences every accusation of the enemy. Satan has no authority over my life, my family, or my future because I have been redeemed by the blood of the Lamb.”
