 - a) The Holy Spirit will guide you in all truth.
 - b) The key word RESPOND!
 - c) Walking in the Spirit is a command.
 - d) The war between the Spirit and the flesh is a battle for control.
 - e) Walking in the Spirit benefits me.
 - f) How can you know if you are walking in the Spirit?

 - 2) Acts 3 reveals the story of a man who was lame, and two believers God is working in and through.

 - 1) I think something is going on that they have no clue about.
 - 2) Verse 2 this was likely a regular practice.
 - 3) Verse 3 the beggar noticed Peter and John and not the other way around.
 - a) Could this be an example of what can happen when the "called out ones" are "functioning," because functioning isn't just about what happens here on Sunday's but what is happening every moment of every day in your life.
 - 4) Verse 4 The beggar called out to them.
 - d. "Selah"
