 - a) The Bible calls Esau a "profane" person. Hebrews 12:6
 - 2) The Amalekite were following Esau's lead.
 - a) Could it be that thousands of people were impacted by the ungodliness of one man?
 - 3) Godly leadership does make a difference –
 - c. Is it really believable that Godly leadership could make a difference?
 - 1) Contrast of two men and their descendants:
 - a) Jonathan Edwards and "Max Juke"
 - 2) Without a vision the people perish.
 - 3) Back to the battle Deuteronomy 25:17-19
 - d. Who does that sound like? I Peter 5:8

 - 1) Why is it that influence so important? I Samuel 15:1-3
