 - 1) Do you see any confusion here?
 - a) Mom is missing money.
 - b) Micah returns it, but why?
 - 2) Mom dedicates the money to the Lord and then gives money to make an idol for Micah.
 - 3) Micah makes an Ephod and Teraphim an appoints his son as his priest.

 - 2) Micah is trying to mix faith and the flesh and live life.
 - 3) Today we understand this as the battle of Spirit versus the flesh. Gal. 5:17

 - b) They were treating God like just another deity.

 - 1) Did you notice what verse 6 said?
