- 1) We learned from the colors of the Inner Curtain that:
  - a) White – God’s purity, holiness
  - b) Blue – God the Creator – “The heavens declare the glory of God.”
  - c) Purple – God as King
  - d) Scarlet – Shed blood
- 2) The Cherubim – guardians of the holiness of God
- 3) The covering of goat’s hair – Christ as our sin offering.
- 4) The covering of ram’s skin dyed red – Christ’s shed blood
- 5) The badger (porpoise) skin – Christ’s humanity.
- 6) The Golden Lampstand – Jesus – the Light of the world.
