- 1. Introduction:
 - a. Taking a look back:
 - 1) Remember these men are being prepared for their Mission:
 - a) Verses 24-25 Jesus is identifying with them and them with Him.
 - b) Verse 26 "fear them not" unbelievers, governors, kings, etc.
 - c) Verse 27 Speak the truth
 - d) Verse 28 "fear them not" those who can kill the body.
 - e) Verse 29-31 Jesus speaks of their value to Him.
 - b. Taking a look ahead:
 - 1) Jesus turns their attention to a decision they will make many times.
 - 2) They will also witness the decision some will make that will forever separate them from God.
- 2. It is our honor to confess Him before others: Matthew 10:32-33
 - a. Something to think about here:
 - b. What does it mean to "confess Him before men?
 - 1) What if you fail?
 - 2) Believers are blessed by the fact that Jesus is our High Priest and Advocate:
 - a) High Priest Hebrews 4:14-16
 - b) Advocate I John 2:1
 - c. What does it mean to "deny" Him before men?
 - 1) "deny" two Greek words "arneomai" and "aparneomai".
 - a) Often, they are used interchangeably.
 - 2) Context is critical to correctly understand"
 - a) When used in the context of a person making a decision, like that of the Gospel, it speaks of and indicates rejection.
 - b) When used of a believer, someone who is genuinely been born again, this denial speaks of unfaithfulness in their relationship with the Lord and thus breaking their fellowship with the Lord by their denial.
 - 3) Can a believer "deny" Jesus before men?
 - a) In context of a believer remember that -
 - b) An example to consider is Peter. Matthew 26
 - d. To these 12 men:
 - 1) These men will real persecution and real discouragement at times.
 - 2) Do we really believe that what we believe is really real?
 - e. Think of the Disciples versus the Pharisee's: Verse 33
 - 1) The Pharisee's had rejected Jesus as their Messiah.
 - f. Think of the unbeliever here: Verse 33
 - 1) The unbeliever has no relationship with God. Their testimony denies who God is.

- 3. Not peace, but a sword: Matthew 10:34-39
 - a. Is this a contradiction in scripture? Verse 34
 - 1) Suppose someone suggested this verse as a contradiction in scripture to you.
 - 2) Suppose they used as support these verses:
 - a) Luke 2:10-14 -
 - b) Matthew 5:9 -
 - c) John 14:27 -
 - d) Ephesians 6:15 -
 - b. What does Jesus mean? Did the disciples understand?
 - 1) Did Jesus ever carry a physical sword?
 - 2) What sword did Jesus use? Ephesians 6:17
 - a) What does a sword do? Hebrews 4:12 -
 - 3) We know that on the earth since the fall that -
 - 4) Could it be that what Jesus is stating for us here is the EFFECT that His coming to earth would have on people?
