 - 1) As a believer, know what to do:
 - a) "Neither give place (ground) to the devil." Ephesians 4:27
 - b) Growing spiritually is like reclaiming and or protecting your ground.
 - c) Be "sober", be "vigilant". Because -
 - 2) This battle for the mind/heart is real. We learned that...
 - a) Thoughts can be embarrassing.
 - b) Thoughts can determine actions.
 - c) Thoughts can be deceiving.
 - 3) The mind is a strategic place to control because the mind is able to control you.
 - a) Proverbs 23:7
 - b) It is impossible for a person to live consistently contrary to their belief system.
 - b. Taking a look ahead:
 - 1) A reminder as we look at the authors of thoughts today.
 - a) Proverbs 23:7 Observations
 - b) Your belief system is who you are therefore to change who you are you must -
 - c) Our lives reflect what we believe, what we believe reflects what we think about, what we think about is the product of the influences we allow.
- 2. Authors of thoughts:
 - a. There are basically 3 authors of thoughts in our life:
 - b. First Ourselves: Proverbs 23:7
 - 1) Matthew 5:28 -
 - 2) Matthew 15:19 -
 - 3) Romans 1:28 –
 - 4) I Cor. 3:3 –
 - 5) Thoughts can range from fleshly to spiritual. Thye reflect the spiritual battle that rages within.
 - 6) We are responsible, accountable to train our minds to:
 - a) Isaiah 26:3 a mind that is "stayed" on the Lord.
 - b) I Samuel 12:24 "...for consider how great things he hath done for you."
 - c) Phil. 4:8 Think on that which is "true", "honest", "just", "pure", "lovely", "good report".
 - c. Second The Spirit of God:
 - 1) Teaching John 14:26 "...he shall teach you all things..."
 - 2) Leading John 16:13 "... he will guide you into all truth..."
 - 3) Conviction John 16:8 "...he will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness..."
 - 4) As you grow you are learning to discern and respond in obedience to the Spirit of God's teaching, leading and conviction.
 - d. satan, our enemy
 - 1) Matthew 16:23 Get thee behind me, satan, thou art an offense unto me; for thou savourest not the things that be of God, but those that be of man."
 - 2) James 1:12-15 "...for God cannot be tempted with evil, neither tempteth he any man."
 - 3) He moves from tempting to accusing very quickly.
