 - a. There will be family conflict over faith: Verse 21
 - 1) This describes families who are turning against one another because of one's faith.

- b. The hatred is "of all men": Verse 22
 - 1) This is a problem that exists throughout the world.
 - 2) We know that sin is in the world.
 - 3) "he that endureth to the end shall be saved."
 - a) This is like a promise to believers.
 - b) II Timothy 1:11-12 "for I know whom I have believed..."
- c. Be Ready, you may need to flee to another city: Verse 23
 - 1) The word "persecute" to pursue as one does a fleeing enemy.
 - 2) It is believed that persecution will be very prevalent during this time.
 - 3) "flee ye into another"
 - a) God can still use moments like this. Acts 8:1-4
 - 4) "till the Son of man be come"
