1. Introduction:

- a. Taking a look back:
 - 1) A good example from the early church believers to follow.
 - a) We are believers still living our daily lives but because of the change we should be living differently –
 - 2) Based on this story of Peter and John, I asked you, are you alert each day?
 - 3) What we can't see and known is what God is doing in someone else's life until it collides with ours.
 - 4) Peter, led by the Spirit of God, spoke to this man which resulted in his healing.
 - a) If you choose to walk in the flesh, then -
 - b) If you choose to walk in the Spirit, then -
 - 5) My encouragement to each of you, Be Ready! Be Alert! Be Attentive! Be Available! Be Faithful! Be Humble! Be Forgiving! Be Compassionate! Be Understanding! Be Patient! Be JESUS to them!
- b. Taking a look ahead:
 - 1) This miracle has caused many to stop in wonder and amazement and consider what has just happened.
 - 2) What a moment this is.
- 2. The New Testament Church is really a way of life. Acts 3:11
- a. You never know who God may bring your way.
 - 1) Just give them Jesus. That is what Peter does here.
- 3. Here comes the crowd. Acts 3:11
 - a. Who do you think is in the crowd?
 - 1) Pay close attention and you will figure this out.
 - b. Peter, led by the Spirit, is ready. Acts 3:12-16
 - 1) Responding to the leading of the Holy Spirit, Peter doesn't wait for questions.
 - a) "And when Peter saw it, he answered unto the people..."
 - 2) Verse 12 Peter perceived they were looking for an answer.
 - a) Because of the blindness from the enemy -
 - b) "why marvel ye at this? Or why look ye so earnestly on us, as though by our own power of holiness we had made this man walk."
 - 3) Think about this for a moment.
 - a) I think Peter is saying, Praise the Lord!
 - 4) Application.
 - a) "Praise the Lord!" Develop this as a part of your regular vocabulary. Why?
- 4. Peter turned the table very guickly. Verses 13-15
 - a. Verse 13 -
 - 1) "The God of Abraham, and of Isaac, and of Jacob, the God of our fathers..."
 - a) Familiar O.T. way of addressing God.
 - 2) "hath glorified his Son Jesus"
 - a) Jesus is the One "whom ye delivered up."
 - b) He is the One you "denied."
 - 3) Application.
 - a) Peter was bold here and was unashamed of his relationship with Jesus.

- b. Verse 14 -
 - 1) They refused to accept Jesus as the "Holy One."
 - 2) They refused to accept Jesus as the "Just One."
 - 3) The healed beggar was proof that Jesus is Alive!
 - 4) This is the right message at the right time addressed to the right people.
- c. Peter continued his message. Verses 15-18
 - 1) Verse 15
 - a) "Prince of Life" the author of life.
 - 2) Verse 16
 - a) It is by faith in Jesus that this man has been healed. They are witnesses to a miracle because of faith.
 - 3) Verse 17
 - a) Peter met these people right where they were.
 - b) The moment of truth has arrived for each one.
 - 4) Verse 18
 - a) Let me share something here from Warren Weirsbe.
- d. The truth convicts. Acts 3:19
 - 1) This presentation of evidence proves that they are guilty.
 - a) John 16:8 -
- e. Conviction clarified.
 - 1) First, what it is not.
 - a) More than having a guilty conscience.
 - b) More than a sense of fear of punishment.
 - c) More than just a knowledge of right and wrong.
 - 2) What is conviction?
 - a) You sense in your heart and mind a disgust and hatred for your sin.
 - b) Your attitude is to flee temptation and sin.
 - c) You recognize that your sin dishonors God.
 - d) You feel conviction which leads us to repent.
