The Lord's Supper

1. Introduction:
 - a. Taking a look ahead:
 - 1) Looking at Matthew's account of the Lord's Supper.
2. There is a preparation part for them and us: Matthew 26:17-19
 - a. Where are we observing Passover?
 - 1) Jerusalem is crowded –
 - 2) Amazing how God provided a place and all the necessary elements.
 - 3) Verse 19 – “they made ready the Passover” – what does this mean?
 - 4) There is a preparation for us as well as we come to the Table.
3. Jesus sits down with the 12 to eat: Matthew 26:20-25
 - a. Jesus reveals a traitor.
 - 1) Imagine what is going through their minds at this time.
 - 2) Did they know who Jesus was speaking of?
 - b. Application:
 - 1) How does this happen?
 - 2) Interesting that Judas was seated in a place of honor – to the left of the Lord.
 - c. Judas is guilty of making the decision to betray Jesus. Matthew 26:24-25
 - 1) Did God know this would happen? Absolutely!
 - 2) Did Judas have a choice? Absolutely!
4. Jesus institutes the Lord's Supper:
 - a. The Bread: Matthew 26:26-30
 - 1) Jesus picks up the bread – “Take, eat, this is my body.”
 - 2) Jesus picks up the cup – “Drink ye all of it”
 - b. The Bread – God's Promise – The Perfect Lamb of God.
 - 1) God's Promise is fulfilled – Genesis 3:15
 - 2) Isaiah 53 -
 - c. Jesus, the Perfect Sacrifice:
 - 1) The standard is set very high – God uses their time in Egypt to teach this.
 - 2) Why set the lamb aside?
 - d. The Cup – Jesus' blood. Matthew 26:27
 - 1) Go back to the garden once again –
 - 2) Leviticus 17:11 –
 - 3) Hebrews 9:11-14 –

4) I Peter 1:18-19 –

5) Any theology that ignores or minimizes the blood isn't founded on the Word of God.

6) The blood of Jesus covers all my sin.

5. Do you see it?

a. Jesus is the Promise – the Perfect Lamb of God.

b. Jesus' Blood – The Blood that covers all my sin.
