## Israel is Not The Church

Romans 9:1-5 Mike Butler August 25th, 2024

Romans 9:1-5 - (NKJV) - "1. I tell the truth in Christ, I am not lying, my conscience also bearing me witness in the Holy Spirit, 2. that I have great sorrow and continual grief in my heart. 3. For I could wish that I myself were accursed from Christ for my brethren, my countrymen according to the flesh, 4. who are Israelites, to whom pertain the adoption, the glory, the covenants, the giving of the law, the service of God, and the promises; 5. of whom are the fathers and from whom, according to the flesh, Christ came, who is over all, the eternally blessed God. Amen."

In Genesis 12:2-3 - "I will make you a great nation; I will bless you And make your name great; And you shall be a blessing. 3. I will bless those who bless you, And I will curse him who curses you; And in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed."

Deuteronomy 7:6-8- "6. For you are a holy people to the Lord your God; the Lord your God has chosen you to be a people for Himself, a special treasure above all the peoples on the face of the earth. 7. The Lord did not set His love on you nor choose you because you were more in number than any other people, for you were the least of all peoples; 8. but because the Lord loves you, and because He would keep the oath which He swore to your fathers, the Lord has brought you out with a mighty hand, and redeemed you from the house of bondage, from the hand of Pharaoh king of Egypt."

In 2 Samuel 7:16 – "16. And your house and your kingdom shall be established forever before you. Your throne shall be established forever."

Luke 1:32 - 32. He [Jesus] will be great, and will be called the Son of the Highest; and the Lord God will give Him the throne of His father David"

Isaiah 9:7 - "Of the increase of His government [Jesus] and peace There will be no end, Upon the throne of David and over His kingdom, To order it and establish it with judgment and justice From that time forward, even forever. The zeal of the Lord of hosts will perform this.

Zechariah 12:10 – "10 "And I will pour on the house of David and on the inhabitants of Jerusalem the Spirit of grace and supplication; then they will look on Me whom they pierced. Yes, they will mourn for Him as one mourns for his only son, and grieve for Him as one grieves for a firstborn."

Zechariah 8:23 – "23 "Thus says the Lord of hosts: 'In those days ten men from every language of the nations shall grasp the sleeve of a Jewish man, saying, "Let us go with you, for we have heard that God is with you."

Revelation 21:1-2 – "1. Now I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away. Also there was no more sea. 2. Then I, John, saw the holy city, New Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband."

Revelation 21:12 - "...12. Also she had a great and high wall with twelve gates, and twelve angels at the gates, and names written on them, which are the names of the twelve tribes of the children of Israel:..."

Jeremiah 31:35-36 - "35 Thus says the Lord, Who gives the sun for a light by day, The ordinances of the moon and the stars for a light by night, Who disturbs the sea, And its waves roar (The Lord of hosts is His name): 36. "If those ordinances depart From before Me, says the Lord, Then the seed of Israel shall also cease From being a nation before Me forever."

Galatians 3:28 – "28. There is neither Jew nor Greek [Gentile], there is neither slave nor free, there is neither male nor female; for you are all one in Christ Jesus.

Ephesians 5:32 - "...32. This is a great mystery, but I speak concerning Christ and the church."

2 Corinthians 11:2 – "2 For I am jealous for you with godly jealousy. For I have betrothed you to one husband, that I may present you as a chaste virgin to Christ."

John 3:29 - "29. He who has the bride is the bridegroom; but the friend of the bridegroom, who stands and hears him, rejoices greatly because of the bridegroom's voice. Therefore this joy of mine is fulfilled."

Revelation 19:7 – "7. Let us be glad and rejoice and give Him glory, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and His wife has made herself ready." 8. And to her it was granted to be arrayed in fine linen, clean and bright, for the fine linen is the righteous acts of the saints."

Genesis 22:8 – "8. And Abraham said, "My son, God will provide for Himself the lamb for a burnt offering..."

Genesis 15:6 – "6. And he believed in the LORD, and He accounted it to him for righteousness."

Isaiah 49:6 – "6. Indeed He says, 'It is too small a thing that You should be My Servant To raise up the tribes of Jacob, And to restore the preserved ones of Israel; I will also give You as a light to the Gentiles, That You should be My salvation to the ends of the earth.' "

Luke 2:30-32 – "30. For my eyes have seen Your salvation 31. Which You have prepared before the face of all peoples, 32. A light to bring revelation to the Gentiles, And the glory of Your people Israel."

John 8:12 – "I am the light of the world..."

Matthew 5:14-16 - 14. "You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden. 15. Nor do they light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a lampstand, and it gives light to all who are in the house. 16. Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven."

Romans 9:31-32 – "31. but Israel, pursuing the <u>law</u> of righteousness, has not attained to the law of righteousness. 32. Why? Because they did not seek it by faith, but as it were, by the works of the law. For they stumbled at that stumbling stone."

1 Peter 2:7-8 — "7. Therefore, to you who believe, He is precious; but to those who are disobedient, "The stone which the builders rejected Has become the chief cornerstone," 8. And "A stone of stumbling And a rock of offense." They stumble, being disobedient to the word, to which they also were appointed."

Revelation 14:4 – "...These are the ones who follow the Lamb wherever He goes. These were redeemed from among men, being firstfruits to God and to the Lamb."

Matthew 9:37 – "...37. Then He said to His disciples, "The harvest truly is plentiful, but the laborers are few."

• Romans 11:14 – "...14. if by any means I may provoke to jealousy those who are my flesh [Jews] and save some of them."
