Salvation - Part 4 "A Tool for the Carpenter" March 2023

<u>Ephesians 1:13-14</u>, - "In Him you also trusted, after you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation; in whom also, having believed, <u>you were sealed</u> with the Holy Spirit of <u>promise</u>, who is the <u>guarantee</u> of our <u>inheritance</u> until the redemption of the <u>purchased possession</u>, to the praise of His glory."

Romans chapter 6:12-13 - "Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body, that you should obey it in its lusts. And do not present your members as <u>instruments of unrighteousness to sin</u>, but present yourselves to God as being alive from the dead, and your members as <u>instruments of righteousness to God</u>.

Romans chapter 6:23, - "For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord."

Romans 6:10-11, - "For the death that He died [Jesus], He died to sin once for all; but the life that He lives, He lives to God. Likewise you [believers] also, reckon yourselves to be dead indeed to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus our Lord."

Galatians 2:20 - "I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me..."

<u>Ephesians 4:23-24</u> - "...and be renewed in the spirit of your mind, and that you put on the <u>new man</u> which was created according to God, in true righteousness and holiness."

<u>2 Corinthians 5:17</u>, - "...if anyone is in Christ, he is a <u>new creation</u>; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new."

Acts 9:15 - "...But the Lord said to him [to Ananias], "Go, for he [speaking of Paul] is a chosen vessel of Mine to bear My name before Gentiles, kings, and the children of Israel."

Mark 6:3 - "Is this not the carpenter, the son of Mary..."

<u>1 Peter 2:5</u> - "...you also, as living stones, are <u>being built</u> up a spiritual house, a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ..." (1 Peter 2:5)

<u>Isaiah 64:8</u> - "...O Lord, You are our Father, we are the clay, and <u>You our potter</u>; and all we are the <u>work</u> of Your hand."

Matthew 16:18 - "...on this rock <u>I will build</u> My church, and the gates of Hades shall not prevail against it."

Romans 10:15 - "How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the gospel of peace..."

Matthew 28:19 - "...Go therefore and make disciples..."
